Annual Report of the Board of Directors

The Directors have pleasure in presenting their Report, together with Financial Statement and Auditors' Report for the year ended 31st October, 1942.

Profits for the year, after all expenses, depreciation and provision for estimated taxation, amounted to \$1,305,593.57 out of which the following dividends were paid or reserved for payment:

Plant and equipment have been adequately maintained and capital expenditures amounting to \$180,054.06 were made, most of which were attributable to increased war work.

Raw materials for the manufacture of our standard products are increasingly difficult to obtain, as so many of our important supplies came from overseas. In consequence, new processes have had to be developed and substitutes found after extensive chemical research, so that the total output of civilian products has not fallen far below the previous year.

Production of war material has continued to grow in ever-increasing volume and much of our Inlaid Linoleum Department, together with an extension thereto, is devoted to the manufacture of hydro-pressed aluminum aircraft parts. Other departments are largely engaged in the treatment and finishing of Anti-Gas Cloth, Tarpaulin Duck, etc., while a varied assortment of Bits and Pieces for the Military and Naval Services are also being produced.

It is with profound regret that the Directors record the death on Nov. 20, 1942, of Mr. John J. McGill, President of this Company since 1927. Mr. McGill had been an official of this Company since 1881 and his death marks the passing of an outstanding figure in the industry. The loss of his wide experience and judgment will be keenly felt.

The vacancies occasioned by Mr. McGill's death have been filled by the appointments of Mr. Archie F. Baillie as President, Mr. K. B. Roberton as Vice-President and Mr. G. Blair Gordon as Director.

The Directors feel that special thanks and appreciation should be expressed to the Staff and all employees for their efficient and loyal service during a most difficult year.
