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

#### One Hundred and First Annual Report

Montreal, February 9th, 1948

To the Shareholders.

Gentlemen,

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the one hundred and first Annual Report of the affairs of the Bank with the result of its operations for the year ending December 31, 1947.

The net profits for the year were \$462,825.61, and the balance brought forward from last year's Undivided Profits Account was \$261,627.46, making a total of \$724,453.07. From this amount, the usual quarterly dividends have been paid to the Shareholders and—apart from the sum of \$9,875.00, interest on the Charity Donation Fund, which was allotted as usual—the Bank distributed \$17,300.00 to various charitable and philanthropic institutions; \$250,000.00 has been transferred to the Reserve Fund, bringing the latter to \$4,000,000.00, leaving a balance at the credit of Undivided Profits Account of \$177,153.07.

To meet the needs of our steadily increasing clientele, your Directors deemed it advisable, during the year, to open two new branches: one at the corner of Verdun and Woodland Avenues, in the city of Verdun, and the other at the corner of Bélanger and Christopher-Columbus Streets. The results already obtaining fully justify the undertaking.

As usual, a frequent and thorough inspection of the books and assets of the Bank has been made during the year.

The report of the Auditors and the Balance Sheet are herewith submitted.
