








Directors' Report

YOUR Directors are pleased to submit to the Shareholders their Annual Report of the operations of the Company for the year ending 31st of December, 1916.

The Sales for the year amounted to \$5,840,127.46, an increase of \$1,097,212.78 as compared with 1915.

The Profits for the year were \$864,779.83 inclusive of all expenses of administration, and after providing for Bond Interest, Bad Debts written off and Machinery Scrapped, the Net Profit amounts to \$738,753.00, appropriated as follows,—

The Surplus of Liquid Assets over Liabilities has been increased during the year by \$360,037.28, the active surplus now amounting to \$1,985,121.98.

You will also notice that our Reserve Account now stands at \$1,500,000, and the amount at credit of Profit and Loss Account \$672,492.78.

As usual, our various Plants have been kept in good condition, the cost of repairs charged against earnings.

It is with deep regret that we record the death, during the year, of Mr. David Morrice, a member of your Board since March, 1915.

The Books and accounts of the Company have been audited during the year by Mr. C. S. Scott, F. C. A., Hamilton, and his report is presented herewith.






