



PROCEEDINGS OF THE

FORTY-SEVENTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

WEDNESDAY, 14TH JANUARY, 1903



The Annual General Meeting of the Stockholders of The Bank of Toronto (being the forty-seventh since the commencement of business) was held, in pursuance of the terms of the Charter, at the Banking House of the Institution in Toronto, on Wednesday, 14th January, 1903.

On motion, William H. Beatty, Esq., was called to the Chair, and Mr. Coulson was requested to act as Secretary.

Moved by CHARLES S. HYMAN, Esq., M.P., seconded by JOHN J. LONG, Esq., and

Resolved—That Messrs. George W. Lewis and Edward M. Chadwick be appointed Scrutineers of the election of Directors for the year, and that they report the result to the General Manager.

By request of the Chairman, the Secretary then read the following

REPORT

The Directors of The Bank of Toronto have pleasure in presenting their Forty-seventh Annual Statement of the affairs of the Bank, and desire to call attention to the fact that the Profit and Loss statement covers the operations of the Bank for the period of six months only.

The business of the country continues to grow steadily, and the abundant harvest, large immigration, and increased development of the resources of the Dominion give every indication of a continuance of its present prosperous condition.

The Directors have still power to allot \$500,000 additional Stock under the authority given by the Shareholders on 19th June, 1901, but in view of the increasing business of the country, the Directors desire to recommend to the Stockholders that the authorized Capital of the Bank be increased to \$4,000,000, and they propose to submit a By-law for this purpose.

Since the last Annual Meeting branches of the Bank have been opened at Gaspé Basin, P.Q., Creemore, Thornbury, Millbrook, Sudbury and Oakville, and a Sub-agency at Elmvale, Ont.

The Directors desire to express their regret at the loss by death of their esteemed colleague, George J. Cook, Esq., who rendered valuable service as a Director for many years. In view of the growing importance of our interests in the western portion of this Province, the Directors have filled the vacancy thus caused by the election to the Board of C. S. Hyman, Esq., M.P., of London, Ontario.

Resolved—That the Report now read be adopted and printed for distribution amongst the Stockholders.

Moved by GEORGE W. LEWIS, Esq., seconded by ALBERT E. GOODERHAM, Esq., and

Resolved—That the thanks of the Stockholders be tendered to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their careful attention to the business of the Bank.

On motion of HENRY CAWTHRA, Esq., seconded by JOHN WALDIE, Esq., the following By-law was passed :

BY-LAW No. 35

WHEREAS the Capital Stock of The Bank of Toronto is now \$3,000,000, of which the sum of \$500,000 has not yet been allotted, and WHEREAS it is expedient that the Capital Stock should be increased :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Shareholders of the Bank assembled at the Annual General Meeting, held at the Head Office of The Bank of Toronto, the fourteenth day of January, 1903 :

(1) That the said Capital Stock of The Bank of Toronto of \$3,000,000 be and the same is hereby increased by the sum of \$1,000,000 divided into 10,000 shares of \$100 each ;

(2) That the Directors be requested to allot from time to time, and when they shall so determine, such proportions of the said increased Capital to the then Shareholders of the Bank *pro rata* at such rate as is fixed by the Directors, such allotment or allotments to be subject in all respects to the provisions of the Bank Act.

Moved by JOHN J. LONG, Esq., seconded by CHARLES S. HYMAN, Esq., M.P., and

Resolved—That voting for the election of Directors of the Bank for the year now commence, and that the poll be closed at two o'clock, or at any earlier time that five minutes shall elapse wherein no vote is tendered.
