



The Annual General Meeting of the Stockholders of The Bank (being the Sixty-Fourth since the commencement of business) was held, pursuant to the terms of the Charter, at the Banking House of the Institution, corner King and Bay Streets, Toronto, on Wednesday, 14th January, 1920.

In addition to the examination mentioned, the cash and securities at the chief office and certain of the principal branches were checked and verified by me during the year, and found to be in accord with the books of the Bank. All information and explanations required have been given to me, and all transactions of the Bank which have come under my notice have, in my opinion, been within the powers of the Bank.

After the Report had been read, the PRESIDENT addressed the meeting as follows :

GENTLEMEN:—The year which has now closed has been marked by many unusual features. A year ago we were looking forward to an early settlement of the terms of peace, and hoped that the problems of reconstruction would be taken in hand speedily and resolutely. The aftermath of the war, however, has proved more serious than was anticipated. Unsettled conditions continue everywhere, especially in European countries. Anarchy, strikes, rioting, civil war and distress have been widespread, and the energies of the various Governments have been directed to repressive efforts rather than to reconstruction. These prolonged disturbances have thrown the people in some countries into a state of hopeless poverty, and those in power have not been able to grapple successfully with the situation in which they find themselves. The delay in definite settlement of the terms of peace has had a most prejudicial effect, and the whole financial world has been kept in a state of uncertainty in consequence.

Perhaps this country has suffered less than almost any other, but that we have been affected is evidenced by the fluctuation in rates of foreign and New York exchange, sterling exchange having gone to an abnormally low discount, and New York exchange to an equally abnormally high premium. We have also had our share of labor troubles and discontent, caused by the increasing cost of living.

But in spite of these disturbances the year can be looked back upon as one of continued prosperity. Cancellation of orders for munitions and war equipment closed a number of temporary factories and lessened the output of others, but the change has not been attended with serious consequences, our manufacturers having to a great extent adjusted themselves to the situation and having found new openings for their energies.

The harvest in the western provinces was full of promise in the early part of the year. A greatly increased acreage was seeded and a large production looked for. Unfortunately the result did not equal the early promise, the yield in bushels being very slightly in excess of last year and the cost of production in labor and supplies greater. But prices being better, the estimated value of field crops, taking Canada as a whole, will, according to the Bureau of Statistics, amount to \$85,000,000 in excess of last year. The total value of all our exports, as furnished by the same authority, for the twelve months ending 30th November, 1919, amounts to \$1,251,094,840, being only \$49,000,000 less than that of the preceding year.

We referred at our meeting last year to the success which had attended the Victory Loan to which at that time subscriptions had been received for over \$680,000,000. Disbursement of this large sum throughout the year contributed to activity in business. The demands upon the Government have, however, continued to be great. The demobilization of returning soldiers, the care of the wounded, and the different forms of relief have entailed heavy expenditures. Credits were also granted by the Government to some of our Allies to whom manufactured goods, foodstuffs and supplies were exported. The needs of foreign countries are so great that the only limit to increased exports by us is the extent to which we can increase production, find transportation and grant credit to those that require it. We, however, must not forget that there is a limit to our resources, and to the extent to which the Government can with safety undertake to increase foreign credits. To meet all demands, and, if necessary, to extend further credits, the Government called for subscriptions to another Victory Loan in November last. The Loan was largely over-subscribed, and subscriptions were received amounting to \$676,000,000. Nothing could evidence more

clearly the prosperous condition of the country than the response that was made to this last appeal, and the determination thereby expressed by the people that they were prepared to "finish the job."

The indebtedness of the country has now reached an amount that will prove a heavy burden for our present population. So long as the war existed and such tremendous issues were at stake, no sacrifice was too great to be taken in supporting the Government in their defence of the Empire, but the time has come when the best energies of the administration must be directed towards reducing expenditure in every direction. No new indebtedness should be incurred excepting such as will have the direct effect of increasing production, or for such enterprises as will return sufficient revenue to fully justify the expenditure. Every new demand upon the Treasury should be tested by these requirements, and every effort should be made to lessen in every way the country's expenditures.

It is never safe to make predictions as to the future. There are too many uncertainties at present in the general situation to speak with confidence, but it seems reasonable to assume that the business of the country has not yet returned to a normal basis. The prosperity we enjoy is to a large extent based upon the expenditure of borrowed money. Governmental borrowing should not be carried much farther. Therefore, it seems probable that the volume of business as well as the value of what we produce will, in the comparatively near future, be lessened, but if there should be a slowing down, we hope it will only be for a short time.

Emphasis has been placed upon three factors to which special attention should now be given in order to promote the upbuilding of our country. These are immigration, production and exports. I think there is no doubt that when conditions have somewhat settled, we will have a constant flow of immigrants to this land of such great possibilities. During the years of war, though emigration was largely cut off from Great Britain and the Continent, we received each year numbers of settlers from the United States, while during the seven months ending 31st October last, we received 83,346 immigrants, of whom 42,991 came from Great Britain, and 35,949 from the United States, and settlers' effects were brought in of a value of over \$9,000,000. The opportunities here are so great that if a liberal and wisely framed immigration policy is put into active operation, a policy in which quality rather than quantity is considered, we will, in a few years, have an addition to our population such as will greatly increase our production and lessen our burdens.

Production is so largely the result of labor or of machinery operated by labor, that it opens up a very large subject. I do not intend to enter upon the vexed questions that arise out of the relations between employers and employees. Production is largely governed by the extent to which there are harmonious relations existing between these two classes, and it is to be hoped that this harmony can be obtained without a preliminary bitter experience. I desire to emphasize the fact that only through an increase in production can there be a continuance of prosperity. Whether this is to be brought about by a change in our economic system or by closer and more personal relations between the workers both of hand and of brain, I will not discuss, but if we wish to reduce the cost of living, it can be done only by greater production. At the present time the world's production of necessities is very far short of the world's needs. Upon the amount of our production depends the amount and value of our exports, and to the increase of our exports we must look for the means whereby we can comfortably carry the burden of interest on our national debt. There is no country that can look forward with greater hope and confidence than Canada. We have immense

potential resources and the development of them is certain to take place. It may take time, perhaps it is better that we should grow steadily rather than rapidly, but our future is certain to be a bright one.

I am happy to be able to say that the operations of the Bank for this year have been of a satisfactory character. There has been an increase in every department of the Bank's operations. Our resources have increased and they have been profitably employed throughout the year. The prosperity that has been general throughout the country has made the number of known bad debts less than the average. Under these favorable conditions, we have to report profits larger than we have ever presented to you in a statement before. We have paid the increased dividend at the rate of 12% per annum, made the other deductions as shown in our Statement, and have increased substantially the balance at the credit of our Profit and Loss Account.

Before formally moving the adoption of the Report, I will ask the General Manager to deal with the Statement which has been presented to you, pointing out the changes that have taken place.

THE GENERAL MANAGER then made the following remarks:

The statement now submitted for your consideration covers the first twelve months after the signing of the armistice—the first year of peace following over four years of war. It might have been expected that this period would have shown greater changes in the business situation of the country than have actually taken place. The manufacture and export of war material has, of course, ceased, but this business has been largely, if not entirely, replaced by increased business in other lines, both foreign and domestic and by higher prices. Our industries, except purely munition plants, have been kept employed, and our foreign trade shows but small decline.

Enhanced purchasing power of our people, derived from the sale of our products to outside countries at high prices, increased wages and inflation, has marked the business of the year. It is inevitable that foreign countries now destitute of actual necessities must in time become to a greater extent self-supporting and less urgent buyers of our products, but in the meantime general prosperity continues and is reflected in banking figures.

DEPOSITS.—Our deposits, you will notice, show an increase for the year of \$7,673,723. This we consider very fair in the face of heavy withdrawals for investment in the last Government Loan. You may be interested in knowing that subscriptions through this Bank amounted to over thirty millions of dollars, and our deposits were heavily drawn upon by subscribers in this connection.

CIRCULATION.—The Bank's notes in circulation have again shown an increase and now amount to \$8,003,980, an increase over a year ago of \$733,365, and over 1914 of \$3,000,000.

The conditions of the past year have made an increase in the current money necessary—the enlargement of our trade, the increase in prices, higher cost of labor, have all necessitated a larger daily amount of currency to enable transactions to be carried out.

The total circulation of all the Banks in Canada in November, 1914, was \$114,767,200, and in 1919 \$237,547,162. This increase is quite natural, and is in no sense an inflation. The system under which in this country a daily redemption of notes takes place makes it impossible for banks to keep in circulation an amount of notes greater than is required for the daily needs of the country. Should business become less active, and prices of commodities become lower, there will be a corresponding reduction in bank note circulation.

It may be well to say, also, that any increase in the amount of our note circulation in excess of our paid-up capital of \$5,000,000 is not attended with any profit to the Bank, as we are required under The Bank Act to deposit in the Central Gold Reserve an amount equal to our excess circulation or to pay interest upon such excess within the limits provided by the Act.

LIQUID ASSETS.—On the assets side of our statement we show a total immediately available of \$49,911,625.90 represented by cash and securities readily marketable and which amount to over 50% of our total liabilities to the public.

CURRENT LOANS.—Our current loans have increased about \$5,000,000 and now amount to over \$54,000,000. Our first duty is to keep the Bank in a strong and liquid position. Subject to this, it is our policy to give our customers the greatest assistance in carrying on their business. The great function of a bank in Canada is to promote the trade of the country to the fullest legitimate extent, and we believe that during these years of expansion we have been able to give our friends a useful and efficient service.

BANK PREMISES.—The report of the Directors shows that we have opened thirty-two new branches. We have also had to acquire permanent premises in other towns and cities where we have hitherto been tenants, and this has necessitated an increase in our Bank Premises Account of \$216,096.

These are the principal items in our statement, and the results of our operations for the year are summed up in our Profit and Loss account.

Our increased resources have all been continuously and profitably employed—our customers have also been successful, and losses have been below the average, and we have in consequence been able to show profits of \$1,011,359.09, an increase over the figures of last year of \$166,956.93.

We trust that these figures will be considered satisfactory by the shareholders. They are the largest profits that have ever been shown by the Bank, and are only a reflection of the general prosperity of the country.

It is in such times of prosperity that we must be most careful in our scrutiny of our loans, and we need to be well assured that our assets can stand the test when reverses come, and we have therefore thought it right to take a view of them that can be depended upon should there be a change in conditions, and so far as is possible to prepare for unfavorable changes.

I refer with appreciation to the work of the staff during the year. While there is always a certain amount of coming and going amongst the younger men who have not found themselves, I am glad to say that we have a very solid, loyal and capable working force, giving excellent service to the Bank and to the public.

The personnel has been strengthened during the past year by the return of many of those who had enlisted for active service. All who have applied for reinstatement have been satisfactorily placed. A few have chosen other avocations. Some of the brightest and best will not come back. They have made the supreme sacrifice for their country and the ideals which were at issue in the war. A permanent memorial in bronze has been erected on the mezzanine floor of the Head Office building, on which the names of these heroes have been inscribed, together with the honors bestowed upon them for distinguished services and for valor.
