

SIXTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

HELD ON

WEDNESDAY, 9TH JANUARY, 1924

The Annual General Meeting of the Stockholders of The Bank (being the Sixty-Eighth since the commencement of business) was held, pursuant to the terms of the Charter, at the Banking House of the Institution, corner King and Bay Streets, Toronto, on Wednesday, 9th January, 1924.

*Resolved*—That Mr. W. G. Gooderham be Chairman of this Meeting, and that Mr. Harvey B. Henwood be requested to act as Secretary.

*Resolved*—That Mr. Duncan Coulson and Mr. E. W. Langley, be appointed Scrutineers, and that after the balloting they report to the Chairman.

Eleven new Branches of the Bank were opened during the year, and four closed, leaving 165 now in operation.

The PRESIDENT then addressed the meeting.

GENTLEMEN :

Our banking year which ended on the 30th of November last has had many disturbing elements. We have not realized the hopes entertained a year ago that a settlement of the amount and mode of payment of reparations would before this have been agreed upon, that progress would have been made in the stabilization of currencies, and the European situation thereby greatly clarified. There has been improvement in some important countries, notably in Austria and Italy, but the general situation is still quite disturbed. Progress is being made very slowly, and the combined purchasing power of Europe is relatively small. As long as these conditions continue the whole world-wide economic situation must suffer, and in looking to our future relations abroad, we cannot expect recovery to be other than very gradual.

In the United States there is a decidedly hopeful feeling, and sound financial authorities are agreed that, on the whole, the outlook for business is good. The foreign trade of that country is necessarily affected by the continued unsettlement in Europe, but they have such a large and steadily growing population within their own borders that their home market renders them less dependent upon exports. They are still, however, not without disturbing elements. Industrial costs are very high and organized labor persistently opposes any reductions. The wheat farmers are not sharing in the prosperity. They are obliged to sell their surplus in the world's markets at the prevailing low prices, while the cost of everything they buy and of the labor they must employ have given a very small return for their year's work. Improvement has, however, been shown in many important branches of trade and the prospects for the immediate future are good. \*

## CONDITIONS IN CANADA.

It is reasonable to say that conditions in Canada have improved during the year. The years of the War, and for a period following, were years of excited inflation which brought inevitably in their train, a reaction as the excitement wore away, and this period was followed by deflation, sinking values, lessened trade and steady liquidation. The past year has been one of a steady, quiet volume of trade. Stocks carried have been light, cleaning up has been general, and if there has not been any spectacular advance, there has been a good undertone and a quiet strengthening of the situation. There has been a sufficient volume of profitable business to give encouragement, and the outlook is for a better year to come.

The total foreign trade figures for the twelve months ending 30th November show an increase of nearly Three Hundred Million Dollars, the value of exports being slightly over One Billion Dollars and our imports slightly more than Nine Hundred Million Dollars, resulting in a favorable trade balance of One Hundred Million Dollars.

The trade returns classify some of these exports under the following headings. I propose to say a few words in connection with each of these.

## AGRICULTURAL AND VEGETABLE PRODUCTS AND ANIMAL PRODUCTS.

The first group of these represents the products of the farm and of the ranch, and the value of our exports from this group shows a total of Five Hundred and Thirty-three Million Dollars. This group continues to hold its place as the largest factor in our exports.

In Ontario, the harvest, while not yielding so much as last year, will give a satisfactory return, and the fact that farmers have so diversified the products of their farms, and have a wider range of marketable articles for sale, enables them to obtain year by year a fairly steady return for their output.

In the Western Provinces conditions have varied somewhat markedly. Manitoba this year has had disappointing results and the yield in that Province is much below normal. Saskatchewan's total return in bushels has held up well, and will be nearly, if not quite up to any previous year, while the crop in Alberta has been surprisingly large and beyond any previous record.

The total Western grain crop, measured in bushels, shows an increase over last year, but the estimated value shows a reduction. While the total yield in these Provinces has been large, in each of them there are sections where the returns have been sadly disappointing, and where this has followed previous lean years, discouragement has resulted.

One of the lessons to be learned from such experiences, is that our Western agriculturists should more generally adopt the policy of mixed farming and have a greater diversity of products, in place of being dependent on purely wheat growing. This change can only be brought about gradually as additional capital is accumulated, and we are glad to note that progress is being made in this direction. Our agricultural exports are such an important factor in the country's welfare that everything should be done to encourage and assist our farmers, and our records show that the Bank of Toronto has always been generous in extending loans and giving aid in developing and sustaining this important industry.

The second largest branch of business contributing to our exports comes from our forests. Only a comparatively short time ago this was confined to exports of square timber and lumber in finished and unfinished forms. Our pulp and paper industries have, however, greatly developed and enlarged their production and are now of very great importance. Our exports under the heading of wood and paper products have amounted this year to Two Hundred and Sixty-six Million Dollars.

A marked increase has also been shown in connection with the manufacture of automobiles. In 1921 we exported 2,624 freight automobiles and 9,774 passenger autos. This year these figures have reached 9,984 freight and 57,033 passenger autos, and, including auto parts, the exports have grown in value from slightly over Eight Million Dollars to an amount of nearly Thirty-seven Million Dollars.

## MINING.

This is another very important industry which has shown an increase in output. Very promising new fields have been opened, former proved mines have been large shippers, and increased employment has been given to workers. Greater attention is now being paid to development in the mineral districts, capital is being attracted as a result of the successful operation of mines now being developed, and engineers' reports are very favorable as to the prospects. We look for a steady increase of interest in Northern Ontario and for an intelligent use of capital in development that will mean much in the future. A large and successful mining district not only requires capital for its development, but it also provides a large field for the employment of labor, and the increased population attracted in this way gives the farming community a home market of great value.

## BANK ACT REVISION.

The Bank Act was again the subject of a very careful scrutiny by the Banking and Commerce Committee at Ottawa during the last Session of Parliament.

The principles of the Act have been left unchanged, but changes were made in the details in the monthly returns that are furnished to the Finance Department. The Act now requires that two auditors be appointed, who must not be members of the same firm, and one of whom must be changed at the end of the second year, thus providing for the audit being made by a constant change in the audit officers. The responsibilities of Directors and Auditors are increased, and the latter may report to each Director, as well as to the General Manager, any specific matter which they consider should be brought to their attention. The intention of these provisions in the Act is no doubt good, and banks do not object to anything that will further protect the interests of depositors and shareholders.

The value of an audit conducted by auditors selected by the shareholders must necessarily depend on the quality and character of the auditors, and in cases where auditors have had the necessary qualifications, and have done their duty intelligently and conscientiously, no additional benefit will accrue from the change, and the only result will be that we must pay two auditors instead of one.

We are sorry that changes in the Act will cause the loss to us of the services of our present Auditor, who, during the years he has acted in that capacity, has been of very real service to the shareholders, and whose scrutiny of the Bank's affairs has been thorough and his judgment eminently sound and conservative.

There will be submitted to you the names of the following to act as Auditors representing the shareholders for this year:

Mr. D. K. McClelland of the firm of Price-Waterhouse & Company, a firm of the highest standing in London, England, and in New York, and Mr. John J. Robson, of the firm of Robson & Ritchie of Montreal, whose ability and knowledge of Canadian affairs will doubtless commend him to you.

Recent events have led to an expressed desire in many directions that the Government should undertake the yearly inspection and audit of banks, and to this there should be no objection by the banks if the Government is willing to accept the responsibility that would necessarily follow such action. A satisfactory report of the condition of a bank as the result of an inspection made by efficient officers of the Government would doubtless strengthen confidence, and it would be difficult for Governmental responsibility to be avoided. So far as this Bank is concerned, no inspection could be more thorough than that made by our own inspecting officers, and the conservative estimate placed upon our assets by the management, and concurred in by our Auditor, would, we are certain, not be disturbed by the most exacting officials.

## TAXATION.

I feel that I should also call your attention to the fact that the growth of the indebtedness of the country is proceeding at a much greater ratio than the population. Not only is the Federal Government adding yearly to the

total debt, but Provinces and Municipalities are increasing liabilities at a rate that, if continued, will give cause for great concern. We have each only to look back for a few years and compare our personal tax bills to find that what seemed a high per capita tax rate a few years ago has in many cases been more than doubled without any corresponding increase in the services rendered.

Turning now from the consideration of these general questions to the report presented to you, your Directors are gratified that in spite of many unfavorable conditions, the unrest created by recent unfortunate occurrences, increased cost of doing business and added taxation, the profits for the year show a very satisfactory increase. We believe that this result is due to the conservative policy that this Bank has always followed of building up a large Retained Account out of its surplus profits, thus giving the advantage of increased resources with increased earning power, and also to the active and intelligent care that has been shown by the higher executive officers and by a loyal and efficient staff. I can say confidently that the position and standing of the Bank was never better than it is today.

Before formally moving the adoption of this Report, I would ask the General Manager to address you, giving more particular information with regard to the figures in the statement which is being presented.

## GENERAL MANAGER'S ADDRESS:

We are meeting today after an eventful year in Canadian banking, including the revision of The Bank Act after a long and somewhat acrimonious discussion, the merging of one banking institution, and the failure of another.

It is not surprising that some uneasiness should have developed, resulting in a restricted market for bank shares and loss of deposits, even runs in some cases, entirely unwarranted, but reflecting distrust and panic.

We think it a matter of legitimate satisfaction that under these circumstances our business should have remained steady and practically undisturbed, particularly as attention and question has been directed chiefly to banks of moderate size. There is a tendency, very natural perhaps, and human, to associate strength and soundness with size. Big figures are impressive. In banking, however, the important factors are the quality of the business and the percentage of Capital and Reserve—not to liabilities but to current loans, since it is chiefly in this department that losses are made.

I think I should express to both our shareholders and customers the appreciation of the management for their confidence and loyalty during the past year. While corporations may not have souls, they do develop character over a long period of years. The founders of this Bank, and those later associated with them, pioneers in the early business enterprises of this province and city, men of outstanding ability and integrity, established the policy and direction of this institution, and their no less able successors, and particularly the late Duncan Coulson, for so many years General Manager and finally President, carried on the work of building a sound and lasting institution—not all above the ground, but on foundations amply strong to carry the upper structure. To the solid work of these men we attribute the tradition of safety which attaches to this Bank, and which it is the endeavor and policy of the present management to preserve unbroken.

And we have not sacrificed growth. Progress is often so imperceptible that we hardly notice it, year by year, but if we go back twenty years (not a long time) we will find that banking assets in Canada have increased fourfold, and our own assets in the same proportion. Rightly or wrongly, we have not effected amalgamations with other banks, and have therefore not increased to the same extent as some others, but we have maintained our percentage of the total increase.

## CIRCULATION.

The activity of our business, as represented by Circulation, has been maintained, this item showing a small increase of about half a million dollars.

## DEPOSITS.

Deposits have increased by slightly over \$1,000,000. Savings deposits in Canada of all the banks, as reported on the 30th November last, show a small gain of 1.05% for the twelve months. Our own gain equals 5.35%. We are satisfied, under all the conditions, to have held our own and a little better.

We have opened an unusually large number of new savings accounts during the year. Average balances, however, are smaller, this being chiefly due, we believe, to the competition for money by Governments and Municipalities.

## READILY CONVERTIBLE ASSETS.

Turning to the other side of the statement, it will be noted that our Quick Assets, including cash, notes and cheques of other banks, securities and call loans stand at over \$47,000,000. This is an increase of over \$6,344,000., and represents 53.58% of our liabilities to the public. This is the strongest position in this respect in our history. The increase is chiefly in securities, which now amount to \$20,709,953., all of the highest investment class—over 94% Dominion, Provincial and Municipal bonds. Our book values are well under market prices.

While our bond investments are relatively large, these securities are the most readily convertible assets we can hold, apart from actual cash, exchanges and bank balances, and as our purchases were made substantially under the present level of prices, they give a good income return.

Securities held against call loans consist chiefly of Government and Municipal Bonds.

## COMMERCIAL LOANS.

Current loans in Canada of all banks show a decrease for the twelve months of about 4%. Our own figures are practically stationary. Non-current loans is a new classification called for under the revised Bank Act. The amount appearing under this heading is very moderate.

Our loans and advances have again been carefully scrutinized and have been taken into our statement at values approved by our Auditors. It is in this department that losses occur, but our system of providing for actual and possible losses has always proved adequate and safe.

It may interest you to know that at the close of our year we had not a single advance on our books in excess of \$500,000, except advances secured by grain, and we have never lost a dollar in this line of business. We, of

course, often extend credits in excess of half a million dollars, and carry many accounts which at times run higher, but the condition we have mentioned existed at the time our books were closed and we refer to it as an indication of the quality and diversity of our business. We have no large loans against inactive assets.

## PROFITS.

You will note that our profits are a little better than a year ago, but it is becoming increasingly difficult to make satisfactory profits in banking. Bank services are constantly increasing without producing a correspondingly increased revenue. Taxation of various kinds is very heavy, and competition very keen.

In our own case, however, our earning power is assisted by relatively large reserves. It is necessary for us to earn only 5%, even less, on the shareholders' funds in the business—Capital and Reserves—in order to maintain our present dividends.

## RESERVES.

The value behind your shares is increasing year by year. Capital, Rest and Profit and Loss account now amount to \$12,170,000, or a value for each share of over \$242. These figures take no account of contingent funds. It is no secret, and has been previously stated at Annual Meetings, although perhaps in less definite terms than I am using, that what we call Contingent Reserves exist.

Bank receivables, no matter how well selected, and even after provision for the known bad and doubtful, would show some shrinkage on a realizable basis. Our provision for such shrinkage, while not in our opinion excessive, is, we believe, ample to guarantee the value set down in our statement.

A survey of general conditions affecting our business directly and indirectly has been given by the President, and I need only say further that we are going into the new year in very clean position, and with our affairs well in hand; able to sustain quiet times if such are ahead of us, or to share in and assist the further business recovery which we hope and believe will come in due time.

We have good reason to anticipate increased immigration, together with further development of productive activities. If we are sometimes inclined to be a little pessimistic of the future we have only to turn back the pages a few years. The expansion which has taken place and which is illustrated by the increase in banking assets to which I have previously referred, affords the best possible basis for hope and confidence in the future, even if necessary to exercise patience for a time.

I again have pleasure in making honorable mention of the staff. I hardly know what to say of our Superintendents, Inspectors, Managers, and the general staff, both men and women, that will sufficiently acknowledge my own appreciation of their work during the past year. The right spirit exists throughout the service. We have evidence, both from within and without, of enthusiasm and loyalty to the Institution, and we are, on the whole, a happy family. We are glad to be able, this year, to extend reasonable increases and bonuses, which we believe were well received, and fully met the needs of the situation.
