The year 1913 was one of general financial and commercial depression throughout the world, which conditions became more accentuated during the closing months of that period. Your Directors therefore deemed it advisable to enforce a policy of conservatism without interfering with the requirements of legitimate borrowers.

The funds of the Bank were fully and profitably employed throughout the twelve months under review, resulting in a further increase in the net earnings, the disposition of which is dealt with in detail in the accompanying Report. A bonus of 2 per cent. was again distributed, in addition to the regular dividend of 12 per cent.

Following the announcement made in the last Annual Report, an issue of \$1,000,000 of new Capital Stock was made to Shareholders of record of the 15th of February, 1913. The whole of this issue was taken up, and although the final payments thereon are not due until June, 1914—\$811,344 of the amount had been paid up on the 31st of December last. The total Paid-Up Capital of the Bank was, on that date, \$5,811,344.

To meet the requirements of Section 56, Subsection 6, of the new Bank Act, you are now asked to elect Auditors to serve until the next Annual General Meeting, and two written nominations have already been received in this connection.

You are also requested to sanction the passing of new By-laws, necessitated by changes in the Bank Act and the advisability of having them more fully meet present circumstances.

Branches of the Bank were opened in 1913, as follows: New Westminster, B.C.; Fairview, Vancouver, B.C.; Fernwood, Victoria, B.C.; Medicine Hat, Alberta; Arlington Street, Winnipeg, Man.; Walkerville, Ontario; Danforth Avenue, Toronto, and Eglinton Avenue, Toronto.

The offices at North Vancouver, B.C., and Guernsey, Sask., were closed, as existing conditions did not warrant their continuance.

Very satisfactory progress is being made in the erection of the new Head Office Building at the corner of King and Yonge Streets, Toronto, and it is confidently expected that the premises will be ready for occupation before the end of this year.

The customary thorough Inspections of the Head Office and Branches have been made, including the verification by your Directors of the Balance Sheet now presented.

All the Assets of the Bank have been carefully scrutinized by the Directors and officials, and its Investment Securities are carried on the Books at conservative values.

## GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

After reading the Annual Report, the General Manager spoke as follows:—

“I will draw your attention for a few moments to some of the more important Headings in the Statement which I have just read, although there are this year no outstanding features of particular import.

As the President has stated, the year 1913 was one of general financial depression—it was necessary for the Directors of the Bank and the Executive Staff to devote more than ordinary attention and time to the supervision of its affairs, and we feel that the figures which are laid before you have been computed on a very conservative basis, and after due allowance had been made for all accounts of a doubtful character.

The net profits show a satisfactory increase—about \$50,000 greater than for the year 1912—accounted for wholly by the steady demand for banking accommodation during the whole twelve months under review.

Respecting the Bank's liabilities to the public, you will observe that the Deposits have increased \$450,000, a creditable feature considering the monetary stringency and the attractive rates that were offered for funds, from all directions.

Our Savings Department, to which we pay particular attention, shows a marked development, and the number of customers increased by 10,000 during the year. Interest bearing Deposits expanded \$1,407,000.

The Circulation, compared with the 31st of December, 1912, has decreased \$600,000, clearly indicative of a slowing up of trade generally.

You will observe two new Headings in the Statement—“Bills Payable” \$184,747, and “Acceptances under Letter of Credit” \$931,914—which are of no special significance, and relate to the ordinary commercial business of the Bank—these Headings are necessary to conform with the new provisions of the Canadian Banking Act, and have hitherto been included under other liabilities.

As is customary and prudent, the Bank's Cash and quickly available Assets are large, the former being nearly 24 per cent. of total liabilities to the public, and the latter 41 per cent.

Investment Securities—\$6,237,500—are of a generally high-class and readily marketable character.

Current Loans and Discounts show an increase during the year, of \$2,000,000, which is one of the most important features in the Statement, showing our desire even during a period such as that through which we are now passing, to do our full share in meeting the reasonable demands of borrowers.

It was distinctly to the advantage of the whole community that the products of the country be marketed as speedily as possible during the closing months of 1913, and the customers of The Dominion Bank, as in former years, handled a very large proportion of the Western grain exports. Our loans against grain and other products were unusually high at the end of the year, and of a desirable and liquid character.

Under the Heading of “Mortgages on Real Estate Sold” it will be noticed that on the 31st of December, 1912, an amount of \$978,000 was shown as against \$37,000 in December last. This decrease is wholly accounted for by a large cash payment on account of land at the North East corner of King and Yonge Streets, Toronto, formerly owned by the Bank and sold—current short-dated obligations being given for the balance.

In conclusion, while I do not share the views of those who are of the opinion that the commercial outlook has no immediately encouraging features, neither do I think that all undesirable elements have been eliminated. It is quite probable that had not most of the Canadian Banks taken a very strong stand as far back as two or three years ago, and declined to entertain applications for advances based on real estate, and discouraged unwarranted and extravagant commercial expansion, the situation would have been much more serious. As it is, it is quite likely that the proportion of commercial failures in 1914 will reach an unusually high percentage. This in itself will not be barren of good results—many of the weak Concerns which have been existing on too much borrowed capital, and through unsound financing, may have to disappear; but it is probable that at the expiration of another twelve months there will be a distinct change for the better, and the development of the country will continue on a sounder and more rational basis.

In so far as The Dominion Bank is concerned, we feel that its business is in a prosperous and healthy condition, and we are well equipped to continue our policy of reasonable expansion when future events justify it."

#### ADDRESS BY THE PRESIDENT.

In moving the adoption of the Report, the President, Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P., made the following remarks:—

"The General Manager has said practically all that is necessary—as you know, we do not usually address our Shareholders at any great length on these occasions—the year's results speak for themselves.

'The profits for the year were \$950,000—\$49,000 more than in 1912 and \$246,000 greater than in 1911. Dividends and a bonus totalling in all 14 per cent. have been paid, which must be gratifying to you. Since the commencement of the Bank \$9,500,000 has been distributed to the Shareholders out of earnings.

As Mr. Bogert has remarked, last year was a trying one for Canadian Banks; curtailment was necessary to some extent, but I do not think that any Dominion Bank customer was unduly hampered in his legitimate business by our refusing him accommodation.

The expansion in Deposits is certainly very satisfactory, as is also the increase in the net profits, which, with the \$811,000 premium on new stock and the balance brought forward from 1912, amounted to \$2,449,000. This sum has been disposed of as follows: Dividends and Bonus, \$765,000, contribution to the Pension Fund—which I am sure you will approve—\$25,000, transferred to Reserve Fund \$811,000, transferred to Investment Accounts \$200,000, and carried forward \$647,688.

Our Shareholders, I believe, have received a larger percentage in Dividends on their stock since the inception of the Bank than the Shareholders of any other Bank in Canada, and I think it only right and proper that from time to time, as large earnings are made, they should, to some extent, be distributed to the Stockholders, always maintaining—which I consider is essential—a very large Reserve Fund, because the Reserve adds greatly to the strength and earning power of the Bank.

We have, as the Statement shows, about \$6,000,000 in Government and Municipal Securities, Railway and other Bonds, Debentures and Stocks. During the past year there has been a very large depreciation in the value of Securities generally, and while our holdings are shown considerably below the market price, we thought it wise to write them down \$200,000, as we want to afford protection against any further decline.

A re-valuation of the Bank's premises has been made, in many cases by outside valuers, and the amount set down on the Books is well under the commercial value of the properties owned.

The Directors are gratified, and I am sure the Shareholders must be, with the splendid progress that has been made in the erection of our new Head Office Building. It will, I think, be a credit to the architects and the contractors; no building of its kind in Canada has been so rapidly constructed, and we hope that it will be completed within the set time, which is very unusual.

The Revenue from the several stories to be rented will enable the Bank to occupy its own offices on a very reasonable basis. The rentals paid for the Head Office and Toronto Branch temporary premises are heavy, and for the time being we are getting no return from our own property.

\$1,000,000 of new Capital issued a year ago was taken up in a most gratifying manner; comparatively few shares—just a fraction—were left over, and these were sold on the open market; so that the whole amount has been subscribed, and, as you will notice, \$811,000 has been paid up—certainly a very high tribute to the confidence which the Shareholders place in the Institution.

As far as the Directors can judge after having the loaning accounts carefully scrutinized by the Inspectors, we believe that full provision has been made for all bad and doubtful debts.

I look forward with some anxiety to the year 1914. We have had a stoppage in the expenditure for railway building—there has been a cessation in the enormous outlays that have been made during the past few years in building up our Western towns, and business will undoubtedly be restricted during the next twelve months.

I have no doubt, however, as to the future of Canada. We have had a set-back, and in a measure we have deserved it because of the wild speculation which has taken place, especially in real estate, and this is bound to have its effect and be reflected in the general business of the country. One result of the curtailment in trade will, I think, be cheaper money, and the Banks may experience difficulty in employing their funds profitably—the earnings of the Bank may thus be affected to some extent.

The General Manager and Officials of the Bank have had a particularly trying year; they have worked late and early and loyally in the interests of the Institution—I think the Shareholders are to be congratulated on having such officials in charge of the Bank's affairs.

I have very much pleasure in moving the adoption of the Report.”

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#### REMARKS BY THE VICE-PRESIDENT.

Mr. W. D. Matthews, the Vice-President, in seconding the adoption of the Report, said:—

“So many important and disquieting events have happened during the past year that it is no wonder that conditions have caused anxiety and called for more than ordinary care in the administration of the affairs of the Bank.

The changes in Tariffs and System of Banking in the United States, the Balkan War and the disturbances in Mexico, together with political troubles and labor unrest, any one of which in ordinary times would need careful watching, have all contributed to general unsettlement, and it is no great cause for surprise that all financial and commercial interests were glad to see the end of 1913.

Early in the year the outlook appeared to demand a cautious, conservative course on the part of all engaged in business, and I think it was most fortunate that our monetary Institutions promptly adopted this policy, and the country will in the end feel grateful for it, as it prevented greater complications and difficulties.

The results of the year, however, to those engaged in business, have been more or less satisfactory. The difficulty of borrowing money affected the security market more par-

ticularly, and the decline in stocks may be taken—as is usually the case—as a barometer, in forecasting future conditions.

1914 must, I think, be a year of house-cleaning, and calls for conservatism, for it must not be expected that we can recover from the reaction at once, and while a smaller volume of trade will naturally make money more abundant, it will need some practical improvement to place us again on a firm basis and give us a return of profitable activity in business generally, and this I hope will come as the prospects of a bountiful harvest develop.

We experienced most favorable weather conditions last Fall, and our farmers were enabled to get their land in excellent shape for seeding, which of course is the foundation for the making of a good harvest.

I do not believe there is anything in the situation—so far as Canada is concerned—that warrants any change in our profound belief in the strength and elasticity of the country, and I anticipate that with the development of our natural resources we will return to even greater prosperity than we have already enjoyed.

There are some features in connection with the outlook on the other side of the line which I wish to speak of, as we always get a reflection of affairs in the United States. There is not the least doubt in my mind that many of the troubles which have attended their business undertakings have come from too much Government control. There now appears, however, to be an abatement in popular criticism of financial interests, and less advice is offered by theorists as to how far drastic actions against existing commercial enterprises should be carried. I am pleased to notice this change for the better, and the policy of the politicians particularly is more in favor of letting business affairs take care of themselves.

The President and General Manager have gone into the figures relative to the Annual Statement as fully as is necessary, and therefore it is hardly advisable that I should repeat what they have said.

The issue of new Capital seems to have been a policy that not only has resulted favorably for the Bank, but has placed us during the year in a position to accomplish what the General Manager has told you we have done—namely,

move a large quantity of the natural products of the West to foreign markets, and I think we made no mistake in what we did in this respect.

I consider that the Bank's business is on such a basis that we can look for continued prosperity, and I assure the President that I join with him in believing that we will be able to carry through the year 1914—even with the trying experience that he anticipates—with success for the Shareholders.

I have much pleasure in seconding the adoption of the Report.”—Carried.

Mr. John T. Small, K.C.: “In connection with the appointment of Auditors as called for under the new Bank Act, I have much pleasure in moving that Mr. G. T. Clarkson and Mr. Robert J. Dilworth be, and they are hereby appointed Auditors, to hold office until the next Annual Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$5,000.

I have for some years past been an advocate of outside auditing for Banks, although I have always been careful to say that in the case of a Bank like this, with men at the head whom we have known the greater part of our lives in the business world, and whose standing and integrity are of the highest order, the question was not of great moment to us. I feel, however, that had this system been in force years ago, a number of heavy losses suffered by the people of this country through the failures of Banks would never have occurred.”

The resolution was seconded by Mr. F. E. Dingle.

The President: “Mr. J. T. Small and Mr. William Crocker have, in compliance with the Act, sent in proper nominations for the appointment of these two gentlemen—Mr. G. T. Clarkson and Mr. Robert J. Dilworth, and the Resolution is now before you.”—Carried.

Hon. J. J. Foy, K.C., M.L.A.: “Under section 18 of the new Bank Act, you have authority to regulate certain matters incident to the management and administration of the affairs of the Bank, and I now beg to move the following Resolution:—

THAT all existing By-laws of the Bank on any matter referred to in Section 18 of the Bank Act be, and the same

are hereby repealed, and that the following By-laws be, and they are hereby enacted in substitution thereof:

1. The Annual General Meeting of the Shareholders of the Bank shall be held on the last Wednesday in the month of January in each year, unless such day shall be a legal holiday, when the meeting shall be held upon the following day.

2. Proxies may be in any form purporting to name and appoint the holders thereof as the attorneys and proxies of shareholders signing the same for the purpose of any Annual or General Meeting of the Shareholders of the Bank; but no holder of a proxy shall be entitled to vote at any such meeting unless such proxy shall have been deposited for record with the Secretary of the Bank at least three days prior to the date of such meeting.

The Secretary of the Bank shall record all proxies deposited in accordance with the provisions of this By-law and shall produce at every General Meeting of the Shareholders a list of all holders of proxies.

3. The number of the Directors of the Bank shall be eleven, of whom three shall form a quorum.

4. Vacancies in the Board of Directors, whenever the same shall occur in any year, shall be filled by resolution of the Board.

5. In case for any reason the Board of Directors shall not be duly elected upon the day appointed for holding the Annual Meeting of the Shareholders of the Bank in any year, such election may take place at any time and place to which such Annual Meeting may be adjourned by resolutions passed at such meeting or any adjournment thereof, and if such election shall not then take place, then at a special General Meeting of Shareholders to be called by the Board.

6. The remuneration of the President, Vice-President and Directors of the Bank is hereby fixed at the total amount of \$18,000 per annum.

7. (1) The Directors are hereby authorized to contribute, out of the profits of each year, to the funds of the Pension Fund Society of The Dominion Bank, such sum as they may deem proper; not exceeding in any one year the sum of \$30,000.

(2) In addition to the contribution hereinbefore authorized, the Directors are also authorized to pay the pensions of all of those officers and employees of the Bank who were, on the first day of June, 1911, over the age of 35 years, and whose claims have become or shall become chargeable on the Pension Fund prior to the first day of June, 1916."

Mr. G. N. Reynolds: "I have pleasure in seconding this Resolution."—Carried.

Mr. L. H. Baldwin: "I have much pleasure in moving that the thanks of this Meeting be given to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their services during the year.

It gives me great pleasure personally to do this, and I am sure that it is a motion that will appeal to you generally. We appreciate very much the good work which the directors of The Dominion Bank have done."

The Resolution was seconded by Mr. W. C. Crowther and carried.

Mr. H. W. Hutchinson responded as follows: "As a Westerner and one of the two new Directors whom you elected a year ago, and speaking on behalf of the Board, I desire to express to you our appreciation of the very hearty vote of thanks accorded us. If we are fortunate enough to be re-elected for the ensuing year, I shall promise you our best co-operation, along with the officers of the Bank, in making the year's business profitable."

Mr. F. L. Fowke: "I beg to move that the thanks of this meeting be given to the General Manager and other officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties.

A tribute on the part of the Shareholders has just been paid to the Directorate of the Bank, and while in a sense the services of the General Manager, Mr. Bogert, and his assistants throughout the entire Institution may be supplementary to that of the Directors, no one here will doubt for a moment that, after all, the great burden of responsibility falls upon the Executive Staff—the Statement which has been presented to-day and adopted bears ample testimony to their efficiency."

Mr. D'Arcy Martin, K.C.: "I have much pleasure in seconding this motion."—Carried.

Mr. C. A. Bogert: "I wish to thank Mr. Fowke, Mr. Martin and the Shareholders for the very kind expressions of confidence in myself and the Staff of The Dominion Bank. A few years ago a delusion existed, and I am afraid still exists in the minds of some people, that the duties of employees of Canadian Banks are not arduous. I can assure you from my experience that such is not the case, and I do not believe there is any body of men in Canada in commercial life who work harder than those in our Banks. In so far as our own Staff is concerned, I have pleasure in assuring you that they still continue to perform their duties to you faithfully and earnestly, and I know they will very much appreciate the Resolution you have just adopted."

Mr. C. S. Wilcox: "I beg to submit the following Resolution—That the poll be now opened for the election of eleven Directors, and that the same be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon, or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without any vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll."

Mr. J. Harry Paterson: "I have much pleasure in seconding the motion."—Carried.

The Scrutineers reported that the following gentlemen were elected Directors for the ensuing year:

Messrs. A. W. Austin, W. R. Brock, James Carruthers, R. J. Christie, J. C. Eaton, J. J. Foy, K.C., M.L.A., E. W. Hamber, H. W. Hutchinson, W. D. Matthews, A. M. Nanton and Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P.

At a subsequent meeting of the Directors Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P., was elected President and Mr. W. D. Matthews Vice-President for the ensuing term.
