Since the Shareholders of the Bank last met, another war period of twelve months has elapsed, and, although early in 1915 there were indications of improved conditions, your Directors considered it prudent to continue a policy of conservatism, maintaining a large portion of the Bank's Assets in liquid form, in which circumstances they feel that the Report now submitted will be found satisfactory.

Following the course adopted by the Directors some time ago of discontinuing unremunerative Branches where

the outlook was not promising, the undermentioned Offices were closed during the year:—

Swift Current, Sask.
First St. Branch, Edmonton, Alta.
Norwood Branch, Edmonton, Alta.
Edmonton South Branch, Edmonton, Alta.
By-Ward Market Branch, Ottawa, Ont.
Tilbury, Ont.

One Branch only was opened in 1915, namely: at the corner of Queen and John Streets, Toronto.

No expenditures of importance have been made on Bank Premises Account, with the following exceptions:—

In Vancouver the Bank was able to acquire, for a reasonable amount, the premises in which our Office has been located for some years.

At West Toronto, anticipating the immediate expiry of the lease of the Office which we formerly occupied, a suitable building was erected on land already owned by the Bank.

The affairs of the Bank have been thoroughly investigated by your Auditors, Messrs. G. T. Clarkson and R. J. Dilworth, whose certificate accompanies the Statement. In addition, your Directors have given continuous attention to the business of the Bank, including a close scrutiny of the loans and investments.

All Branches of the Bank have undergone the customary inspections.

GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

After reading the Annual Report, the General Manager, Mr. Bogert, spoke as follows:—

“At the Annual General Meeting in 1915 the remarks made were of a generally hopeful character, although at that time it was impossible to speak with certainty of what the year would bring forth or what important changes would take place in commercial and financial matters.

Since then developments in Canada have, on the whole, been favorable, and are reflected in the various bank statements now being issued; that of the Dominion Bank is no exception, and it is gratifying to be able to submit a Report that indicates an unusually strong position and a notable expansion in many respects.

The earnings have been affected to a moderate extent, and show a decrease, largely occasioned by a marked contraction in the ordinary commercial loans during the greater portion of the year. Such advances were reduced more than \$6,000,000, the natural result of a falling off in business. Dominion Government war taxation on our circulation, and taxation by the Provincial Governments, also made important inroads in our Profit and Loss Account—these two items alone amounting to nearly \$66,000, or more than one per cent. on the Bank's capital.

Early in 1915 the remainder of the previous year's crop was marketed, and no assistance was required by dealers in produce; low and unremunerative rates prevailed in New York and London, where we, as a rule, employ our surplus funds, resulting in a very large amount of the Bank's money being either unemployed or earning but little for the greater portion of the year. During the closing weeks of 1915 there was an expansion in the loans, caused entirely by the movement of new Western grain.

I wish to direct your attention to some of the more important features of the Statement: Concerning the Bank's public liabilities, you will observe that the Deposits show an increase of \$8,200,000 during the twelve months under review—the largest in the Bank's history, and more than double that of any previous year. This amount is about equally divided between deposits bearing interest and those not bearing interest—approximately, \$4,000,000 each. These results may reasonably be taken as an evidence of continued confidence in the Bank by the public. While some of the

Deposits carried at the end of the year were, as is usually the case, of a temporary nature, there has been a general increase in those of a permanent character at practically all of our Branches.

Notes in Circulation increased in 1915 by \$852,626, but unfortunately the issuing of Bank Notes does not carry with it the same advantages as heretofore, Government war taxation, to which I have referred, making the practice more a matter of general convenience to the public for trading purposes than a source of revenue to the banks.

Turning to the Assets, on the 31st of December last we carried in our vaults \$12,600,000 of gold and silver coin and Dominion of Canada notes; adding to this notes of other banks, cheques on other banks, and balances due by our banking correspondents—all of which are the equivalent of cash—the total is nearly \$20,000,00, or 27 per cent. of our public liabilities. The Bank's investments and advances on call and at short dates amount to \$12,735,775, making quick Assets of \$32,660,000, or 47 per cent. of the liabilities to the public.

It has been brought to your attention on other occasions that it has always been the policy of the Bank to encourage increased production in Canada and to assist in the marketing of our products by making liberal advances to those engaged in this class of business; loans of this character at the end of the year reached a large total, and are included in the Current Loans and Discounts—\$47,000,000.

The significance of the figures which I have just mentioned is that on the 31st of December, 1915, the Bank's Assets were in such a condition that, including loans against produce, which are practically repayable on call, a very large proportion of the liabilities to the public could be liquidated within a short space of time. It is a source of satisfaction to those who control the affairs of the Bank to know that this is the case, as it probably will be to the shareholders, although this position is not conducive to large profits.

In the Report of the Directors to the Shareholders, which I have just read, reference is made to the careful investigation of the Bank's affairs by your Auditors, Messrs. G. T. Clarkson and R. J. Dilworth, and the fact that the members of the Board have also given more than usual attention to the Bank's business and its Assets. The Presi-

dent will make some reference thereto in moving the adoption of the Report.

The twelve months through which we have passed have not been free from difficulties arising from war conditions— unquestionably unusual situations requiring unusual measures will continue to develop until the cessation of the struggle in Europe and afterwards.

In August, 1914, when war was declared, every financial centre was shaken to its foundations, but, happily, confidence was soon restored. The immediate co-operation by the Dominion Government with the Canadian Banks resulted in an alleviation of any temporary uneasiness that prevailed in this country in the minds of the public. Further serious complications would undoubtedly have arisen were it not for two fortunate circumstances—one of a providential nature, and the other of an artificial character—the first of these being the enormous production of cereals in Canada in 1915, for which the farmers obtained good average prices, resulting in an extraordinary liquidation of liabilities; the other, the placing of large war orders in Canada by different Governments, which enabled manufacturing concerns throughout the country, which would otherwise have been adversely affected by lack of demand for their output, to keep their plants in operation, to furnish work for their employees and to return satisfactory profits to their shareholders.

I am of the opinion that owing to these fortuitous circumstances Canada has, during the last year and a half, successfully, and, in a measure, unconsciously passed through one of the most serious financial periods in her history. At present we find the country in a sound position, and the Banks possessing large and liquid resources which should enable them to cope with any reasonable contingencies that may arise.

What will happen when the war is over no one can foretell, for none of us has ever had such experiences to deal with before; that a period of commercial disturbance and economic readjustment will occur is inevitable. It seems of paramount importance that the Banks should continue to keep a large percentage of their Assets quickly available, and, therefore, be in a position to successfully meet any emergency that may confront them.”

ADDRESS BY THE PRESIDENT.

In moving the adoption of the Report, the President, Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P., made the following remarks:

“The General Manager has given you a very concise statement of the affairs of the Bank as they stood at the end of the year, and it is unnecessary for me to comment particularly on the Report which has been submitted.

The Directors felt that 1915 was an unusually critical year, and paid special attention to the Bank’s business—they inspected the Returns from the various Branches, and scrutinized practically every loan of importance.

Last year when I addressed you, I said that the Directors were very pleased to be able to declare the usual bonus, notwithstanding the unsettled period we had passed through. At the same time, I made it clear that the bonus which had been paid for three years previously should not be looked upon as a permanent distribution.

As you all know, in 1915 there was an enormous contraction in the manufacturing and mercantile business of the country, although to a considerable extent this was replaced by orders for munitions—the phenomenal harvest also further assisted the recovery of trade. The necessity for practising economy has been impressed on all of us, but I am afraid that so far there is very little evidence that the advice has been taken seriously, either by individuals or municipalities—restrictions in expenditures must be, I think, brought about in both cases.

Now let us look matters squarely in the face. The crop of last year in the West was the result of planting every available acre with grain, and, fortunately, the season turned out extremely favorable. In the autumn of 1915, however, very little plowing was done, and very little new land broken, as the farmers were busy with harvesting operations; at the best, therefore, we can only expect this year an average yield; there is no question about that.

When the war is over I do not think we shall see an immediate return to anything like the former prosperous times. On the stoppage of the manufacture of munitions, it will be very hard to find work for our factories and our men. Expenditures on railways and on large public works have practically ceased in Canada for a very considerable time, and we can only look forward to an average development of our timber, our agriculture, mines and various

natural resources until the return of prosperity, which will undoubtedly be slower in coming than most people think.

We see, every now and then, the statement that Canada will have from ten to thirteen million of a population within three or four years. Now, if we were to have an increase of five hundred thousand people next year through immigration, we have absolutely no way of taking care of them. They cannot go on the land without a reasonable amount of capital, and they are assuredly not required at present in the towns and cities. Without proper preparation it will be a misfortune to the immigrants themselves, and to the present population to some extent, if they come. We cannot have increased immigration unless we have an organization to take care of it. The Dominion Government, the Provincial Governments, the railways, banks and other important institutions, will have to put their heads together and devise some means of taking care of new settlers as they arrive, otherwise they will not be of use to this country for very many years.

The men who return from the war will be the men who to the greatest extent will develop Canada. They will have had an unusual experience, their views will have broadened, and they will not be satisfied to lead a quiet and sedentary life. If you look at what occurred after the close of the civil war in the United States, you will find that the men who had gone through the struggle with the armies of either the North or the South became the leading politicians, lawyers, mechanics, manufacturers, bankers, etc. These are the men who, with their energy, developed the United States. I think that our returned soldiers will be the ones who will give this country a great impetus, but it will take some time for them to accomplish any important results.

The General Manager has referred to the Bank Premises Account, and I am glad to be able to tell the shareholders that, with the exception of perhaps two or three rooms, all the space in our splendid Head Office building is rented.

Relating to the Bank's investments, during the two years previous to 1915 considerable amounts were written off the Securities that are among the Bank's Assets, and it was not necessary to make further allowances for depreciation last year—these Securities stand on our books at figures considerably below their market values.

You will observe that the usual contribution of \$25,000 has been made to the Pension Fund Society of the Bank, and during the present month a subscription of \$25,000 was given to the Toronto and York County Patriotic Fund. I am sure that you will with pleasure assent to these disbursements.

The General Manager will give you the number of the Staff who are serving their country, and I do not think that in any business in Canada so many young men have volunteered as from the banks. So much so has this been the case, that it is with the greatest difficulty that we can obtain efficient clerical service. The members of our Staff are practically working night and day, and I cannot close without giving my testimony to their loyalty and efficiency. They have cheerfully taken on all the extra work involved.

I have great pleasure in moving the adoption of the Report."

REMARKS BY THE VICE-PRESIDENT.

Mr. W. D. Matthews, the Vice-President, in seconding the adoption of the Report, said:—

"I think the year's financial achievements in banking, as well as in other lines of business, have agreeably surprised those directly interested, and the public generally.

It has become quite the usual thing to contrast conditions as they existed at the beginning of 1915 and the general opinion of the probable results, with the actual state of affairs at the present time, and the prospects for the year 1916. Twelve months ago the feeling of anxiety prevailing everywhere was so acute in the United States that financial experts visited that country to endeavour to arrange matters and place international financial affairs upon a sound basis.

Fortunately, our Government rose to the occasion, and, as you will remember, moratorium laws were enacted which postponed the payment of certain debts, reassuring the public and preventing the spread of the panicky feeling that appeared to prevail in all countries. This action also had the effect of driving home the necessity for conservative methods in the conduct of business, and more particularly of drawing attention to the positive need for strict economy in public and private expenditures.

You will recollect that at the time war was declared a period of depression had set in which we attributed in part

to the effect of over-speculation in real estate, and many of our factories were idle or working on short time. A year ago attention was being directed to war orders, and it is with much satisfaction and pride that we refer to the enterprise and skill with which our manufacturing interests took up the making of new lines, about which little was known, and I am sure many people thought it would be difficult to successfully fill the requirements and make the operations profitable.

It is estimated that the war orders received by the various mills and factories throughout Canada will aggregate as much as \$500,000,000, providing employment to everyone able and willing to work; added to this, our farmers have had the good fortune to reap for the year 1915 the most bountiful crop ever harvested in Canada, prices for farm products have ruled much above the average, and a larger amount of money has been set in circulation in the Dominion of Canada than ever before.

At the present time the financial outlook is favourable, as the Governments, banks, and most manufacturers are in a strong position, so that we begin 1916 with great confidence and in marked contrast to 1915. We shall no doubt prosper while the war lasts, but we must not shut our eyes to the certainty that when peace is declared it will mean a sudden change in all classes of business and a drastic readjustment must surely begin. It does not do to be too optimistic at a time when we face conditions such as exist to-day, and I do not want you to misunderstand me or to think I am over sanguine as to the results that are likely to follow; at the same time, I cannot see where dire calamity may possibly come to us, even after the stoppage of the war—ours is a country of natural products, what reputation we have and what success we have achieved in Canada up to the present time has come almost entirely from the development of these resources. The prosperity of our farming community during this past year of depression is going to be our greatest advertisement for immigration when the tide sets in again and will attract attention to Canada. While we probably will not have a very large influx of population from the Old Country and the Continent for some time, we have to the south of us a Republic that has been and still is very prosperous, and from which the largest percentage of our immigration in the past few years has come. Our factories have been able to run full time, making many things entirely

new to this country, and this procedure will, I think, be continued after the war is over. I refer more particularly to everything connected with the metal business—there are many kinds of metal being turned out now, and by-products from these metals, which were not thought of in Canada before. Zinc, lead material, brass and such things, previously imported from the United States or from Europe, are now being made in Canada to such an extent that it will mean the development of new industries and possibly not only provide more labour but enable us to supply our home manufacturing plants in a way that we have never done before.

I quite agree with the President's statement that the most important question we have to deal with to-day, and to which the Governments should devote their whole attention, is that of immigration. This matter should not be left to haphazard, it should be taken up actively and preparation made to attract settlers and to arrange for them to be properly placed in the district to which they are best suited. I have a great deal of confidence that if this is done we will have our full share of the movement of the labour element of the world when the war is ended.

While we are prosperous and are likely to continue so during the period of the war, we are all praying earnestly that peace may come at an early date. This patriotism that has been brought out to such an extent, not only in the enlistment of our boys who are going away to the other side to fight the battles of the Empire, but in the spirit of the people demonstrated throughout the land and in our own city in the magnificent amounts subscribed for patriotic purposes, is all counted to our good and will make better men of us, better men of those who come back and better men in the generations that follow. I think we are going to be a new people after this war—we won't know ourselves, but we all want peace and we want it quickly.

The President and General Manager have dealt at length with the figures of the statement, and I shall not say anything on that score. I have much pleasure in seconding the adoption of the Report." Carried.

Mr. J. T. Small, K.C.: "I have much pleasure in moving that Mr. Geoffrey T. Clarkson and Mr. Robert J. Dilworth, the retiring Auditors, be and they are hereby appointed Auditors to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$5,000."

The Resolution was seconded by Mr. S. Samuel and carried.

Lt.-Col. H. J. Grasett, C.M.G.: "It affords me much pleasure to move that the thanks of this Meeting be given to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their services during the year. I fancy that this Resolution is a somewhat formal matter, but in these times I do feel that the Shareholders of the Bank should be deeply grateful to the Directors and Management for the care of the Institution and the fact that full dividends were received last year, although not the bonus. We must recollect that the President intimated at the Annual Meeting in 1915 that it was unlikely that the bonus would be distributed that year. As the General Manager has said, the officials of the Bank have met with conditions that were outside the experience of even men who manage banks, and we can only wonder that they have done as well as they have."

Mr. William McLeish seconded the motion, which was carried.

Sir Edmund B. Osler: "On behalf of the Directors, I thank you for the resolution which you have proposed, and which has been adopted by the Shareholders. The Directors at this time, I think, more than at any other period of the Bank's existence, appreciate such a resolution. It is no light matter, no light task, to be a Bank Director under present conditions, and if I were to begin life over again I would perhaps look to a lessening of such responsibilities."

Mr. E. W. Hamber, Vancouver, and Mr. H. W. Hutchinson, Winnipeg, Western Directors of the Bank, briefly addressed the Shareholders:—

Mr. Hamber stated that while a policy of retrenchment had been followed in British Columbia during the past two years, the residents of that Province were proud of the natural resources of the country, and plans were being carried out for further development of them, particularly fishing, mining and lumbering interests. An encouraging feature is that during the past six months an excellent market has arisen for lumber, notably in the export trade, and prices have increased from \$2.00 to \$4.00 per thousand. Mr. Hamber spoke in an optimistic strain of the future of the Province.

Mr. Hutchinson, who has resided for thirty-three years in Western Canada, gave an interesting resume of conditions in the Prairie Provinces. He said that caution is the watchword throughout the West, although the inhabitants

of that district are greatly encouraged by the bountiful crop harvested in 1915 and the excellent results therefrom. He remarked that it could not be expected that the 1916 crop would approach that of last year, and that labour difficulties might have to be faced owing to the absence of many of the younger men on active service. He was hopeful of increased immigration, particularly from the United States, providing settlers are not too heavily handicapped by excessive taxation after the war is over.

Mr. Wm. Crocker: "I beg to move that the thanks of this Meeting be given to the General Manager and other Officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties. I may say that I have great pleasure in moving this resolution. I think the Officials and Staff generally have worked hard and performed their duties well. I know that they have been working under unusual disadvantages, notwithstanding which they have given us a good Report."

Mr. D'Arcy Martin, K.C., in seconding the Resolution, referred to the unusual amount of work that devolved upon the Bank Staffs at the present time, and expressed the hope that their labours would be considered by the Board in a liberal manner.

Mr. C. A. Bogert: "I am particularly glad this year of the opportunity of responding to the Resolution which you have just heard, for Staff matters are now engaging a great deal of attention from the Canadian banks, and we are all working under many unusual difficulties.

First we must pay the highest tribute to those members who have unselfishly responded to the call of duty and are now on active service. We have on our Roll of Honour 235, of which number I have to state, with very great regret, that nine have been killed in action or died of wounds or disease, eight have been wounded and temporarily invalided home, two are prisoners of war in Germany, and two have received honorable discharges and returned to the Bank. The absence of these men has naturally resulted in greatly increased labours for those of all ranks who remain at their posts, but the additional duties involved have been undertaken willingly and cheerfully. I desire to express to such members my appreciation of their co-operation and assistance during the past year, and to thank the Shareholders on behalf of the whole Staff for the Resolution which has just been carried.

It is, perhaps, an opportune time to comment on criticisms which have been unjustly made, through the Press and otherwise, to the effect that the banks have not encouraged recruiting to the extent that they should have done. Far from this being the case, the Canadian banks have, I think, done more towards filling the ranks of our regiments than any other employers of clerical labour in the community. In most cases more than 30 per cent. of the bank staffs are on active service, and we find it extremely difficult to safely and properly carry on the necessary banking routine—particularly important at this juncture, when our financial institutions are assisting to the utmost in marketing the crops, making advances to manufacturers of munitions and other war materials, and generally conducting the business of the country.

I think the Government should devise measures for some form of discrimination in selecting recruits for active service, choosing primarily those who are out of employment and those who can best be spared from their duties, whatever they may be, in preference to those who are engaged in some form of work that is directly or indirectly conducive to the carrying on of the war and bringing it to a successful termination."

Mr. William Mulock, Jr.: "I beg to move that the poll be now opened for the election of eleven Directors, and that the same be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon, or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without any vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll."

The Resolution was seconded by Mr. W. W. Near, and carried.

The Scrutineers reported that the following gentlemen were elected Directors for the ensuing year:—

Messrs. A. W. Austin, W. R. Brock, James Carruthers, R. J. Christie, Sir John C. Eaton, Hon. J. J. Foy, K.C., M.L.A., E. W. Hamber, H. W. Hutchinson, W. D. Matthews, A. M. Nanton and Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P.

At a subsequent Meeting of the Directors, Sir Edmund B. Osler, M.P., was elected President and Mr. W. D. Matthews Vice-President for the ensuing term.
