The results shown in the Report submitted to the Shareholders may be considered satisfactory in all respects. During the past twelve months there has been an unusual expansion in the Bank's business, with larger net profits.

At the Annual Meeting in January, 1917, a By-Law was passed by the Shareholders authorizing an increase in the number of Directors from eleven to thirteen—the positions thus created on the Board were subsequently filled by the appointment to the Directorate of Messrs. W. W. Near and R. S. McLaughlin.

Your Directors take this occasion to express their deep regret at the death of Mr. W. R. Brock, who was for more than 21 years an active member of the Board and keenly interested in the progress and welfare of the Bank; Mr. H. H. Williams was elected in his stead.

During 1917 only one new office was established, namely, at Seven Persons, Alta., a sub branch of Medicine Hat.

No expenditures of consequence were made on Bank Premises with the exception of those necessary for alterations to the building at Oshawa and the erection of a new office at the corner of St. Clair Avenue and Yonge Street, Toronto, to provide for the growing business at that point.

Your Directors considered it advisable to make a further substantial reduction in Bank Premises Account from the profits of the year, the policy being to make such appropriations from time to time as are warranted by the Bank's earnings.

Since the last Annual Report the Head Office and Branches of the Bank have undergone the usual thorough inspections, and a complete investigation of the Bank's affairs has been made by your Auditors, Messrs. G. T. Clarkson and R. J. Dilworth, whose certificate is presented with the Balance Sheet.

COMMENTS OF THE GENERAL MANAGER,
MR. C. A. BOGERT

"There are two notable features in the 1917 Report which I think will be viewed with satisfaction by the Shareholders.

The Dominion Bank, when its books were closed on the 31st December last, had reached and passed two important milestones in its financial journey, which commenced in 1871. At the end of the year the Assets of the Bank, for the first time in its history, exceeded \$100,000,000, and the net earnings were in excess of \$1,000,000. It is quite true that these results were largely achieved through what is now styled "war prosperity," but apart from this we feel that your interests have been extended and strengthened in all departments of the Bank's business during the year just ended.

You will observe that the net profits for the period—after the usual careful revaluation of the Bank's Assets, making full provision for doubtful debts and the payment of Dominion and Provincial taxation (these two items amounting to the important sum of \$82,415)—total \$1,005,000, an increase of about \$111,000 over the earnings in 1916 and equivalent to $7\frac{3}{4}$ per cent. on the Shareholders' investments in Capital and Rest Account.

After payment of the usual dividends totalling \$720,000, various patriotic donations, detailed in the Statement—\$30,500—and a contribution of \$25,000 to the Officers' Pension Fund, your Directors were able to write \$200,000 off Bank Premises Account as against \$100,000 in 1916 and still carry forward in Profit and Loss Account \$393,000, leaving the balance in that Account \$30,000 above the total at the commencement of the year.

The increase in earnings is almost wholly attributable to the same conditions which prevailed in 1916 and to which I alluded at the Annual Meeting last year; that is, the employment of the Bank's surplus funds by participation in various Dominion of Canada temporary War Loan issues which were made from time to time and to which I will again refer, and to the remunerative rates which we received from our usual short-term Loans in the London and New York markets.

Relating to the Bank's Liabilities, there were no changes in Capital and Rest Account.

In common with the other Canadian Banks there has been a remarkable expansion in Notes in Circulation; the total amount of this Bank's Notes outstanding at the end of the year was \$9,417,000—an increase of \$2,300,000. The extraordinary increase in Canadian Bank Note Circulation in 1917—amounting to \$44,000,000—while a striking indication of the continued prosperity which the country is enjoying, has been the subject of much conjecture and comment. Were it not for the strong position of the Canadian Banks these heavy liabilities to the public might be viewed with some apprehension—as it is, all demands for redemption could be met without disturbance.

Outside of the fact that the purchasing power of the dollar has steadily decreased for three years and is now only about half what it was at the outbreak of the War, which may in a large measure account for this expansion, people are, unfortunately, still spending more than they should and are actually carrying in their pockets more money than heretofore; we have also many evidences that our foreign population and others are disposed to accumulate their savings in the form of bank notes rather than to place them on deposit in the banks. This situation has been partially created and certainly aggravated by a persistent clamor for what is vaguely styled "conscription of wealth"—a term which very few people understand, even those who advocate it; a feeling of uneasiness has resulted, which it is hoped will gradually disappear—it cannot be conceived that any Government with a proper sense of responsibility would take action directly interfering with the savings of the people.

An important heading in the Statement, and one which did not appear in that of the previous year, will be observed—"Balance due to Dominion Government," \$1,816,000; this is almost wholly made up of first payments made through this Bank to the Victory Loan, which were standing at the credit of the Government at the end of the year.

Deposits not bearing interest amounted to \$15,216,000—an increase of \$1,934,000 for the twelve months; Deposits bearing interest \$66,731,000—an increase of \$9,541,000. The total increase in public deposits for the twelve months, exclusive of the Dominion Government balance, was \$11,475,000; almost equal to the growth in any other two years of the Bank's history.

The total public deposits on 31st December, 1917, were, \$81,948,000.

Five years ago the total public deposits were, \$59,342,000.

Ten years ago the total public deposits were, \$34,242,000.

The other public liabilities—Balances due to Banks in Canada and Abroad, Bills Payable, Acceptances under Letters of Credit—are the usual routine obligations, which continuously expand and contract and are governed by the Bank's activities.

At the end of the year the total Assets were \$109,436,000—an increase of \$16,569,000—and several changes of importance will be noticed, further strengthening the Bank's liquid position and the ratio of quick assets to public liabilities.

The holdings of gold and silver coin were somewhat larger than a year ago.

Dominion Government Notes increased \$4,260,000; Deposits with the Central Gold Reserves—\$4,300,000—were \$2,800,000 higher, caused by the expansion in the Note Circulation already referred to; Notes of other Banks—\$1,027,000—increased \$192,000; Cheques on other Banks—\$4,455,000—were nearly \$1,000,000 greater; Balances due by Banks and Banking Correspondents elsewhere than in Canada decreased from \$2,729,000 to \$2,132,000.

The total Assets, in cash or the equivalent, at the end of the year were \$27,300,000, or 28 per cent. of the public liabilities; Dominion and Provincial Government Securities stood on our books on the 31st December as \$9,400,000—a large expansion caused by the participation in Canadian War issues which I have before mentioned; since the 2nd January, \$3,060,000 of these Government obligations have been retired from the proceeds of the Victory Loan.

Canadian Municipal Securities and British, Foreign and Colonial Public Securities other than Canadian increased \$2,389,000, accounted for by greater holdings of short-dated British Securities, which we acquire from time to time in London.

Since the outbreak of the War in August, 1914, this Bank has participated in Canadian and British War issues to the extent of \$29,800,000, and was carrying at the end of the year \$18,000,000 in such securities.

Railway and other Bonds, Debentures and Stocks decreased \$787,000, caused by liquidation in holdings of certain U. S. securities.

Call and Short Loans in Canada decreased \$338,000, while our Loans abroad—that is, in the New York and London markets—were \$2,400,000 greater.

These comparisons shew that at the end of the year the Bank's immediately available Resources amounted to \$57,660,000 as against \$37,625,000 on the 30th December of the year previous—an increase of \$20,000,000. These quick Assets—not including loans against grain and other staple commodities, \$11,636,000—are 60 per cent. of the Bank's total liabilities to the public. Under ordinary circumstances this state of unusual liquidity might be considered extreme, but under present conditions, having in mind the heavy public liabilities, the uncertainty which will prevail until the conclusion of the War and for some time afterwards and the fact that we cannot as yet determine accurately the permanent effect which the recent Victory Loan will have on our deposits, the strong position is justified.

Current Loans and Discounts—\$45,590,000—decreased \$3,386,000 during the 12 months, caused by the improvement in the affairs of various borrowers whose banking obligations have been reduced or retired, also by the fact that we were not loaning so freely to Western grain customers towards the end of the year, their operations being greatly affected by the purchase of the Canadian wheat crop by the British Government.

Of the other Items in the Assets, Overdue Bills, fully secured, amounted to \$89,000—\$26,000 less than a year ago.

After allowing for the expenditures which have been already referred to, and transferring \$200,000 from the year's profits, Bank Premises Account shows a net decrease of \$165,000.

From a general banking viewpoint 1917 presents three outstanding features:

The extraordinary growth in the Assets of the Canadian Banks;

The remarkable and highly desirable position of liquidity not only maintained but strengthened during the year;

The notable success of the Dominion Government Victory Loan which was issued at the close of 1917 and in which all the Banks are directly concerned.

The total Assets of the Canadian Banks at the end of the year 1917 were \$2,323,000,000—an increase of no less than \$375,000,000 during the 12 months. This growth in Assets is not a normal one nor indeed healthy—it has been largely caused by unusual commercial War activity, special transactions connected with War financing and the temporary benefits that the public generally have derived from the War, resulting in an increase in both deposits and circulation. It cannot be expected that the Assets of the Banks will continue to increase in the same proportion as in the last three years.

It is reassuring to find that the Canadian Banks have not only continued to provide all the money requisite for commercial purposes but have at the same time invested large amounts in Canadian and British issues of Securities for financing the War, and still have greatly strengthened their liquid assets, affording ample protection to depositors and noteholders.

The recent Victory Loan issued by the Dominion Government, as a result of which nearly \$400,000,000 will be allotted to the public, is without doubt the most important transaction with which the Canadian Banks have ever been connected. The greater portion of this immense sum will be withdrawn from the Banks during a few months and placed at the disposal of the Government to be disbursed for War purposes through various channels.

The Banks, quite properly, encouraged and supported the Loan to the utmost, notwithstanding that the results will bring about marked changes in their Balance Sheets. It will surely mean a severe dislocation of Deposits, which will take a long time to adjust, nor can we at the present time forecast what the ultimate reckoning will be. For instance, in the rural districts where deposits accumulate slowly and where the people freely contributed from their savings of many years to the recent Issue, it seems probable that deposits will not reach the high figures of the last year or two for a long period. On the other hand, in the larger centres where War manufacturing and other activities are carried on, involving large payments for wages, etc., deposits are likely to quickly recuperate from the temporary shrinkage.

After-the-War conditions and the means which should be taken to meet them are still the subject of many divergent views and largely a matter of surmise. There can be no

doubt that speculation in commodities and the accumulation of large quantities of unsold goods by manufacturers and merchants should be discouraged to the utmost. All classes of the Canadian people should take heed to a timely note of warning which has recently been sounded by the Finance Minister and which I will briefly summarize:—*Now that Canada is providing her own funds for the prosecution of the War the purchase of foreign securities should be discontinued—indeed present holdings should be liquidated when reasonably possible. What is more important, importations of non-essential articles and the establishment or extension of non-essential industries should cease. Such measures would greatly facilitate the conservation within this country of Canada's financial resources, urgently required for her own pressing War expenditures.*"

ADDRESS BY THE PRESIDENT

In moving the adoption of the Report, the President, Sir Edmund B. Osler, made the following remarks:—

"The General Manager has given you a very clear and concise account of the condition of the Bank as it was at the close of the year and I do not think it is necessary for me to make any special reference to it. The Bank has done very well and its position is very strong. I should like, however, to draw your attention to our contributions to the various Patriotic Funds and to the Officers' Pension Fund.

The various General Managers and Presidents who have officiated at annual meetings of banks during the last two or three months have discussed pretty fully the financial situation and the problems that confront the Country and have offered much good advice as to the conduct of business and the investment of money under War conditions. I was re-reading a little while since a very old friend of mine, "Poor Richard's Almanac," by Benjamin Franklin. It was written more than one hundred and fifty years ago. People began writing almanacs about 1730—it was a habit in those days, both in England and in the American Colonies (they were not the United States then of course, but British terri-

tory.) It was the custom to publish many of these almanacs and in them give advice to the people. Benjamin Franklin was the most successful almanac-maker of that period and his almanacs, published for 25 or 30 years, constituted, next to the Bible, the principal reading in all the families of the farming communities and amongst the poor people in the Colonies. Poor Richard's Almanac, or rather that part of it which I have taken the liberty of appropriating as my speech to-day and handing to the Shareholders, has gone through over 400 editions and has been translated, I believe, into fifteen languages—it seems to me, although it was written in 1757, that it contains matter most appropriate to present-day conditions. I commend you to read the good things Franklin has said in the Preface to his Almanac for 1758, entitled, "The Way to Wealth." He says, in a note to one of the last editions he published, that this Almanac and the advice contained in it had done a great deal to encourage thrift and to mould the character of the people who now occupy the New England States. Read it. There are many little points in it I am sure your wives will be delighted to read and they will probably enjoy a laugh at the expense of their husbands.

Before closing I should like to make reference to the death of our late Director, Mr. W. R. Brock; he was a regular attendant at our Board Meetings for many years, was a very valued confrere and we greatly miss him.

I beg to move the adoption of the report."

REMARKS BY THE VICE-PRESIDENT, MR. W. D. MATTHEWS

"I am sure that you will receive the Report, as the General Manager has said, with as much satisfaction as he has had in explaining it to you, and the Directors in presenting it. The assets of \$109,000,000, represent a very large sum, requiring very close application and the best of judgment to administer, in order to bring about the results which this Bank has been able to accomplish in the past year. Directors and General Managers have had no small task devolving upon them since the outbreak of the War in directing the affairs of the large financial institutions in

Canada, and it leaves them in a little quandary, as time progresses and immense assets are piling up, particularly liquid assets, as to how they are to be managed and as to what the final results are likely to be. The General Manager has gone into the figures of the Bank's statement very completely and for me to say anything more with regard to it would only be to repeat what he has said.

When the War broke out our anxieties were all concerned with the probable effects it would have on our trade generally and caused individuals, mercantile companies, and in fact all financial interests, to adopt a most conservative attitude in the conduct of their affairs.

Very soon orders for war materials appeared in large volume and our manufacturers demonstrated that this Country possessed the necessary enterprise and skill to start new undertakings, particularly in the matter of Munitions. We soon regained confidence and at this date, as a result of satisfactory profits realized, it may be stated that business and financial affairs throughout the Dominion as a whole are on a sound basis. Your Bank has shared in the general prosperity and, in consequence, we are able to present this splendid financial statement to you to-day.

We have hardly recovered from our surprise over the floating of the Victory Loan. Having in mind the previous loans which have been placed on the market, the most optimistic could not have foreseen that the people of Canada would have been able to subscribe such a large amount, for it will be remembered that before the War, when money was required for Government or Municipal purposes and for even moderate amounts, it was necessary latterly to go abroad for it. Therefore, to finance our own requirements for War purposes is really a remarkable achievement.

There is no doubt that when Peace is declared it will find us with difficult problems to face and it is not right that we should wait for that time before we begin to prepare for changes.

Ours is essentially a Country of Natural Products and all the prosperity that we achieved previous to the War is attributed to the development of these resources. Since the War broke out there has been an increasing demand for all these products and at much higher prices than usual, so that farmers, as well as many manufacturers, find themselves in a most prosperous condition.

There is every reason to believe that after Peace is declared the demand for the products of our farms, forests and mines and of the sea will continue, so I think we may consider with some certainty that in these resources we have the foundation for a continued degree of prosperity.

If there is not too much hampering of industry by unwise legislation or too heavy taxation, new enterprises will promptly be established and with good prospects of success. Already we hear of the preparation of enlarged facilities for the manufacture of articles to supply our export demand and some Companies are making ready to launch out as soon as opportunity offers itself, while as to our Natural Resources, we feel confident that our Wheat, Flour, Lumber and Metals will all find a ready market at full prices which will mean business for our Railways, Banks and Shipping. Shipbuilding has every promise of becoming an industry of large proportions and will no doubt be a source of employment for labor for years to come.

I beg to second the adoption of the report."

Carried.

It was moved by Mr. Wm. Mulock, Jr., seconded by Mr. W. J. Barr and unanimously resolved, that Messrs. Geoffrey T. Clarkson and Robert J. Dilworth, the retiring Auditors, be and they are hereby appointed Auditors to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$5,000.

Dr. F. Le M. Grasett: "I have pleasure in moving the following resolution. Resolved that the thanks of the Shareholders be given to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their services during the year.

I would say, in moving this resolution, that in my opinion the Shareholders ought to be well satisfied, first of all with the statement which has been placed in their hands, and secondly with the information afforded by the General Manager.

I am sure we should all be pleased with the dividends which we are receiving and it is a satisfaction to me personally to see the contributions to the various Patriotic Funds. There is another Patriotic Institution, which I should like to suggest be remembered in the appropriations

next year—I refer to the Maple Leaf Club which is doing excellent work for our soldiers particularly in London where the Club receives our men on their return from the Front and provides them with the many comforts which they need so much."

Judge McIntyre: "Mr. President and Gentlemen, it affords me very great satisfaction to second this resolution. I have for some years back watched the career of The Dominion Bank and I came to the conclusion some time ago that the policy of the Bank was conservative. It has been progressive and its management has been tempered with prudence and good judgment; the result of its operations for the past twelve months is the excellent statement presented to us by the Board of Directors to-day." Carried.

The President: "On behalf of the other Directors and myself I wish to thank you heartily for the resolution which has just been passed and for the very kindly manner in which the proposer and seconder have referred to it. I shall ask two of the younger Members of the Board, Mr. Carruthers and Mr. Hutchinson, to respond to it."

Mr. James Carruthers: "I wish to thank you for the resolution which you have just passed and I should like to be permitted to say that I think the Shareholders of this Bank are fortunate in having such a representative Board of Directors. Your Managers come in contact with all classes of customers and, as I understand it, the policy of The Dominion Bank is to endeavor as far as possible to place on the Board gentlemen who are connected with different businesses and who can, therefore, aid the General Manager in dealing with credits of diversified character. We are fortunate in having at the head of our Institution our worthy President, Sir Edmund Osler, who has occupied that position for, I think, seventeen years, and my old colleague and friend, Mr. W. D. Matthews, the Vice-President, two gentlemen whose advice is sought by financial men all over this Dominion. I might also mention that I think the gentlemen who have recently been added to the Board are in the same category and are men whose assistance will be of great value to the Bank.

May I be permitted to congratulate Sir Edmund on the happy idea of, instead of making a lengthy speech, giving us something to consider in 'Poor Richard's Almanac.'

Mr. Bogert's report was a short and concise statement of what the Bank has done in the past year and clearly indicates its position and that is what we want. No man can tell what is going to happen six months hence; we are all trying to do our bit and we must hope for the best."

Mr. H. W. Hutchinson: "I had hoped Sir Augustus Nanton and Mr. E. W. Hamber, the two other Western Directors, would have been with us but they are unavoidably absent. At the request of the President I am to speak a little to you about the West—my remarks to-day, as they have been heretofore, are entirely impromptu. I want to say that in the good Statement which has been presented, the Western Branches can claim a part. Conditions in the West during the past year have been, and I think are to-day, quite above the average. There is plenty of money in circulation, deposits have increased very largely and conditions as a whole are extremely satisfactory. There are several elements which have contributed to that state of affairs; one is the practical cessation of real estate speculation, resulting in closer application to business; another, economy, both in respect to our own personal affairs and in the business in which we are engaged; and above all, the magnificent crops we have had in Western Canada and the high prices prevailing. With the application of economy, supplemented by the wherewithal to liquidate obligations, a wonderful change in the West has taken place. I think the General Manager said that the deposits of the Bank in the past year had increased about \$11,000,000, and I am glad to say that the West has contributed no small percentage of that increase—this result has been brought about to a great extent by the fact that many former borrowers are now large depositors.

Now, I look to the future with optimism; with a Country of such broad expanse, capable of producing grain—millions of bushels of wheat—with its agriculture, which is really the basis of wealth you might say, supported by people who are optimistic and have faith in the future of the Country and who will closely apply themselves to production, with the mines producing wealth all the time, and our forests which are unparalleled in any part of the World, with our industries growing and developing rapidly and with the demand for their products from Overseas, I look to the future with great hope and I think the West will hereafter be even a bigger factor in the earnings of The

Dominion Bank than it has been heretofore. Our Branches in the West are under the supervision of capable Managers and we, who are associated as Directors, will assist in every possible way."

Mr. L. H. Baldwin: "I beg to move that the thanks of this meeting be given to the General Manager and the other Officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties. I do not think, Sir, that a speech is required at this juncture—we know the times are strenuous and the work has been most ably done."

Mr. D'Arcy Martin, K.C.: "I second this resolution with much pleasure." Carried.

Mr. C. A. Bogert: "Of all matters relating to the Bank's organization there is none at the present time of more importance nor that causes us more concern than the maintenance and welfare of the Staff.

At the end of the year we had 833 members—533 men and 300 women. 377 of our Staff have enlisted since the outbreak of the War and our ranks will be further depleted through Conscription measures; we are willingly meeting these disturbances to our organization, although it is only with the greatest difficulty that we are able to satisfactorily maintain a reasonable standard of efficiency.

Foremost in our minds is our deep interest in the careers of those on active service, whose movements and achievements we endeavor to follow closely; unfortunately, as the War continues more of them are included in the heavy toll which is being exacted; up to the end of 1917, 37 of our former members had lost their lives on active service, 38 had been wounded and 4 were prisoners of war; of the 38 wounded 7 have returned to their duties with the Bank.

We are proud to state that a number of our former officers have received distinction for their gallant deeds at the Front.

We heard with great regret that Major Kenneth L. Campbell and Captain A. S. Trimmer, both of whom were awarded the Military Cross in 1916, and to whom I made reference at the last Annual Meeting, were killed in action in April, 1917.

Lieut. J. T. Lownsborough and Lieut. C. B. Hill, who enlisted in the ranks early in the War, were awarded the Military Cross in 1917 for gallantry in action—these two men had previously been wounded and had returned to the Front.

Lieut. S. J. Reeves enlisted in January, 1916, was awarded the Military Cross in April, 1917, and lost his life in August last.

Lance-Corporal J. M. Kirkwood of our London (England) Branch and Sergeant R. B. Leeper of our Winnipeg Branch have received honourable mention in despatches.

We feel sure that you will share our pride in the records of these men, and join us in sympathizing with the relatives of those who will not return.

Speaking for myself and for the whole Staff of the Bank I wish to thank Messrs. Baldwin and Martin and the other Shareholders for the Resolution which has just been passed and to assure you of our appreciation of it.

I am glad of the opportunity to again testify to the loyalty, integrity and industry of the Staff of all ranks who, under steadily increasing complications, continue to work to the utmost in the interests of the Shareholders.

The Directors of the Bank at the close of 1917 again granted a substantial Bonus to the Staff, which was well merited and thoroughly appreciated; this distribution was, very opportunely, made in the form of Victory Bonds."

Mr. J. H. Paterson: "I beg to move that the poll be now opened for the election of thirteen Directors and that the same be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without any vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll."

The Resolution was seconded by Dr. Charles O'Reilly, and carried.

The Scrutineers declared the following gentlemen duly elected Directors for the ensuing year:—

Messrs. A. W. Austin, James Carruthers, Major R. J. Christie, Sir John C. Eaton, E. W. Hamber, H. W. Hutchinson, W. D. Matthews, R. S. McLaughlin, Sir Augustus M. Nanton, W. W. Near, Sir Edmund B. Osler, A. T. Reid and H. H. Williams.

At a subsequent meeting of the Directors, Sir Edmund B. Osler, was elected President and Mr. W. D. Matthews Vice-President for the ensuing term.
