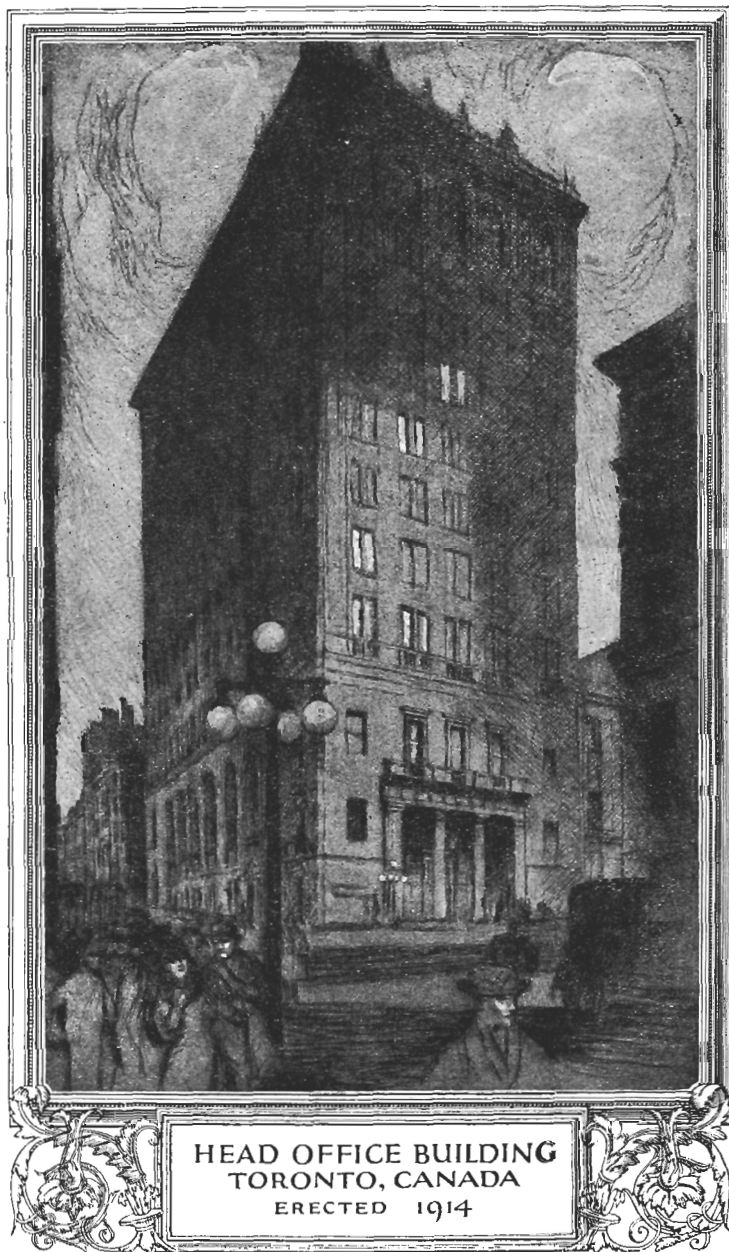

On the motion of Mr. W. W. Near, seconded by Mr. C. S. Blackwell, Sir Edmund B. Osler occupied the Chair and Mr. W. K. Pearce acted as Secretary.

It was moved by Mr. R. J. Christie, seconded by Sir John C. Eaton, and resolved that Messrs. Graham Campbell and R. M. Gray be appointed Scrutineers.

The Secretary read the Report of the Directors to the Shareholders and submitted the Annual Statement of the affairs of the Bank.

The year just closed has been a trying one to business interests throughout the world and your Directors feel that you will look upon the Statement submitted as being satisfactory in view of all the circumstances.

The Head Office and Branches have been inspected by the Bank's Inspectors during the year.

The Bank's Auditors, Messrs. G. T. Clarkson and R. J. Dilworth, have made a thorough examination of its affairs and their certificate is appended to the Balance Sheet.

It was not considered advisable on account of existing conditions to expand to any great extent during 1921 in the way of establishing new Branches. The following were opened:

In Ontario: Long Branch, Kenora, Rosseau. Toronto—Davenport Road and Uxbridge Avenue, East Danforth Avenue. In Quebec: Montreal—St. Etienne, Westmount. Three Branches were closed: In Ontario—Ameliasburg (sub to Belleville), Harrow. In Saskatchewan—Estlin (sub to Regina). Branch buildings were completed and occupied at the following points: Brantford, Ontario; Long Branch, Ontario. Toronto—Bloor St. and Runnymede Road, Dufferin Street and Lappin Avenue.

At the last Annual Meeting authority was given to increase the number of Directors—Mr. C. S. Blackwell was elected to the Board in September last.

COMMENTS BY MR. C. A. BOGERT,
GENERAL MANAGER.

“The statement which is submitted for your approval to-day indicates a continuance of the period of deflation and contraction which has been in progress for the past year and a half, and to which special references were made at the last meeting of the Shareholders. We have passed through the most difficult year in the history of Canadian banking with results which, I think, may be considered satisfactory. In nearly every department of the Bank the totals shown and the net results are less than a year ago, but they are quite in proportion to diminished activity and have been compiled on a very conservative basis. In valu-

ing the Bank's assets we have, if possible, been more rigorous than usual in our scrutiny and in making allowances not only for actual depreciations ascertained, but for loans of a doubtful character. You will doubtless hear with satisfaction that the appropriations considered necessary by the Officials of the Bank, and subsequently approved by the Directors and Auditors, have not been of great importance.

The net profits for the year 1920, before business depression had reached the acute stage, were the largest in the Bank's history—\$1,188,511. Last year, after making allowances for every possible shrinkage in the value of assets, and the payment of \$108,919 Government Taxes, they amounted to \$1,016,000.

From the profits shown, the usual dividends of 12% per annum have been paid, together with a bonus of 1%, making a total distribution to the Shareholders of \$780,000, the same as for the past three years; a contribution of \$40,000 made to the Pension Fund, \$150,000 written off Bank Premises Account, and Profit and Loss Account increased \$46,000, making the total \$715,000, the greatest surplus in this Account ever carried forward.

THE BANK'S ASSETS.

Reverting to the Assets of the Bank, the total cash or its equivalent amounts to \$30,421,000—25.92 per cent. of the liabilities to the public. Dominion and Provincial Government securities—\$13,371,000—have increased \$8,000,000 during the year, chiefly investment of surplus funds in Dominion of Canada and Provincial Bonds; Canadian Municipal Securities and British Foreign and Colonial Public Securities other than Canadian—\$4,168,000—have decreased \$5,700,000, wholly caused by the further payments on account of our proportion of advances made to the British Government during the War period—the entire balance of The Dominion Bank's share—\$1,394,000—will be retired under an arrangement made with the British Treasury by the 1st of April of this year, thus completing probably the most unique and momentous transac-

tion ever consummated by the Canadian Banks in which they loaned the British Government during a time of great stress the large sum of \$220,000,000, which, as I have just stated, will be wholly repaid in a few weeks. Call and Short Loans in Canada on Bonds, Debentures and Stocks are \$6,561,000 as compared with \$7,646,000, and these consist of loans to responsible borrowers which could be liquidated in full within a very short space of time. Call and Short Loans Elsewhere than in Canada, nearly \$4,000,000, are day-to-day advances made in New York, and London, England, against the best class of securities and are actually repayable on demand. I wish to make it clear to the Shareholders just how easily controllable and safe are the Bank's funds invested in this manner. If we instruct our New York Office early in the day to call in a demand loan in that market, the funds are in our hands within three hours; similarly, by cabling our London, England, Branch in the evening a loan on the London market is retired the following morning and the amount placed to our credit with the Bank of England or our other London Bankers.

Total Immediately Available Assets are \$60,109,000—51.20 per cent. of the Bank's liabilities to the public, practically the same as in 1920.

For many years The Dominion Bank has employed a large amount of its earning power in advances to elevator companies, exporters and other dealers in grain and to milling companies, which class of business we have always found of a safe and profitable character. Such advances—which are included in the total of \$63,700,000 shown in the statement—are, practically without exception, fully retired at some period during the year. Loans to manufacturers and dealers in other classes of commodities, although subject to fluctuations, are not always wholly paid every twelve months. It is seldom expedient, and not always wise, for a merchant or manufacturer to withdraw sufficient of the funds employed in his business each year to pay his banking indebtedness, but it remains for the Banker to see, through proper investigation, that the

funds are safely employed. On the 31st of December advances to dealers in grain and flour, included in the Bank's commercial loans, were \$14,000,000. If this total is added to \$60,100,000 of other liquid assets, it means that \$74,100,000, or 63.13 per cent. of the Bank's liabilities to the public are in a liquid and easily collectible form.

The balance of the Bank's Current Loans and Discounts in Canada have, I desire to emphasize, been entered on the Balance Sheet only after the most thorough re-valuation and after making such appropriations as are considered necessary. It must be obvious to you that practically every class of industry in Canada has suffered losses, more or less severe, during the past year, due to a further rapid fall in the value of commodities, accentuated by a continued lack of purchasing power. Borrowers from The Dominion Bank have, as a rule, conducted their affairs satisfactorily through this unfavourable period, and we have not hesitated to give them a full measure of support where support was justified. It is certain that business depression will not continue indefinitely and in the meantime, not only in their own interests but for the preservation of credit and confidence throughout Canada, it should be the policy of every Canadian Bank—a policy that I am sure will be approved by the Shareholders of The Dominion Bank—to assist to the utmost the owners of business concerns whose integrity is unquestioned, whose ability has been proved and whose affairs are only temporarily disarranged.

Bank Premises Account, after writing off \$150,000, totals \$5,830,000. As stated in the Directors' report, during the year certain buildings which were in the course of completion at the end of 1920 have been finished and expenditures incurred amounting to a total of \$287,000, only because they were considered necessary and for the safeguarding of the Bank's interests at these points where, after reasonable trial, permanent investments in land and buildings were justified. We acquired, with a moderate outlay, the following sites in the City of Toronto on which suitable buildings will be erected when conditions warrant:

South-East Corner Davenport Road and Laughton Avenue.

South-East Corner Eglinton Avenue and Forest Hill Road.

South-West Corner Keele Street and Eglinton Avenue.

Turning to the Bank's Liabilities, Notes in Circulation, \$7,326,000, were \$1,833,000 less than a year ago, attributable entirely to the decrease in trade activity. Our indebtedness to the Dominion Government was \$8,552,000, exclusive of Government deposits, at the end of the year and is wholly of a temporary character. Deposits Not Bearing Interest, \$18,018,000, are \$2,033,000 less than a year ago. Deposits Bearing Interest, \$80,786,000, show a decrease of \$4,103,000, but, on the whole, have been well maintained. Investigation shows that the decrease in Interest Bearing Deposits is entirely caused through investments by the public in Government and other securities and the necessity for wage earners drawing on their savings for subsistence during the period of unemployment.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF DIRECTORS, OFFICIALS AND AUDITORS.

At the present time the attention of the public is attracted to the affairs of Canadian Banks, and it is opportune that at this meeting the Shareholders of The Dominion Bank be more clearly informed of the methods employed in the administration of the Bank's affairs, not only for the protection of your own interests, but those of the large number of people who entrust their banking business to this Institution. The responsibility of all who supervise the many important affairs and transactions of a Bank has always been very great but never more so than at this time. This responsibility is, or should be, shared by three groups—the Directors of a Bank, the Officials of a Bank and the Auditors.

The Directors of a Bank are responsible to the Shareholders for the welfare of the Bank, but they have even a greater responsibility towards the public

who, from one end of the country to the other, make our Banks depositories for their savings and show their confidence in many other ways. One of the chief responsibilities of a Board of Directors is the selection of the chief Officials of a Bank who should be, in their opinion, capable of honestly and efficiently administering and supervising the Bank's business.

The views of your own Directors on these matters will doubtless be conveyed to you by the Directors themselves, but I say without hesitation that, in my opinion, no body of Directors of any important financial institution in Canada is more thoroughly informed on its affairs and better able to give the Officials of the Bank the benefit of their knowledge, experience and judgment than are your Directors. Those of the Shareholders who are in the habit of attending our Annual Meetings may recollect that I have referred to these matters before, but, for obvious reasons, I wish particularly to speak of them to-day. I also wish to state that the Directors of The Dominion Bank at regular meetings of the Board each week, have placed before them all matters of importance relating to the Bank's affairs, including applications for every loan of \$25,000 and upwards, particulars concerning the Bank's investments and questions of policy and administration. I desire to state further, that when there are indications of an account or transaction becoming troublesome, I consider it my duty—indeed my privilege—to consult with the Directors of the Bank—in other words, the Shareholders of The Dominion Bank have Directors who direct and fully assume their responsibilities to the Shareholders and the public.

Respecting the duties and responsibilities of the Auditors of the Canadian Banks, who are primarily nominated by The Canadian Bankers' Association under a provision of the Canadian Banking Act, each Bank subsequently appoints its own Auditors and their selection should undoubtedly be determined to a great extent by their known ability and intention to closely associate themselves with that Bank and to properly investigate its affairs and its position before

affixing their signature to an Annual Statement. I wholly disagree with any contention or suggestion that their duties are in any way of a perfunctory character—aside from a thorough inspection of the Bank's actual cash holdings, investments and assets of that nature, Auditors should have a real knowledge of the Bank's most important loans, for in such business the great danger of a Bank's losses lies. The Auditors of The Dominion Bank have access to all the Bank's books, its cash, investments, records and particulars of advances at any time during the year and at any branch. They come and go as they please, freely interrogate our Officials and Managers respecting any loan or transaction when they desire information, and are familiar with all the Bank's most important borrowing accounts. In so far as the Auditors of The Dominion Bank are concerned—and you will be asked by resolution to re-appoint them to-day—I state without hesitation that I consider them unquestionably thoroughly qualified for the important duties which they perform, and in my opinion and that of the other Officials of this Bank, they are Auditors who audit.

GENERAL REMARKS.

Respecting the future, we cannot expect any marked improvement until we harvest another crop—with a more abundant yield than in 1921—until we are better able to distribute our products with fair returns and until we can improve our foreign export markets which have been greatly affected during the past year by adverse legislation by the United States. On the other hand, since January, 1921, a vast liquidation has taken place and we can reasonably assume that stocks of commodities are now on a sound level, or nearly so. That we shall successfully pass through this trying period no one can doubt. In the meantime, hard work, efficiency and economy should be our aim until we emerge eventually to a new era of prosperity on a better basis greatly benefited by our unpleasant experiences and better able to cope with the further development which will undoubtedly be Canada's portion. When that period arrives there will be no lack of funds

for desirable business — there is no credit stringency in sight in this country. Finally, I express the conviction that The Dominion Bank is in a position to cope with any complications that may arise and to lend a full measure of support to its customers until the turn for the better takes place. In the meantime, we should “hasten slowly” so that when the revival in business does come, with connections firmly established in Canada and Abroad, and with an excellent earning power, the result of many years of progress, we can continue the policy of sound expansion that has been successful in the past.”

ADDRESS BY THE PRESIDENT.

In moving the adoption of the Report, the President, Sir Edmund B. Osler, addressed the Shareholders as follows:

“Gentlemen, I am sure you have listened with satisfaction to the report which the General Manager has just read, and that there has been much to interest you in his explanation of the various items in the statement submitted and his comments regarding business conditions generally. I agree with his assertion that the affairs of the Bank are thoroughly known to the Directors, and I shall endeavor to outline briefly the procedure adopted by the Board in directing the affairs of the Institution.

The Bank’s investments, which on the 31st of December, 1921, amounted to over \$19,000,000, are of the highest class and consist almost entirely of Dominion, Provincial and British Government and Canadian Municipal securities. All purchases and sales of investments are reported to a special Committee of the Directors for their approval. All applications for Lines of Credit of \$25,000 and upwards are submitted to the Directors. Credits of \$25,000 and upwards, from Western Branches of the Bank, are passed upon each week by a special Western Committee, consisting of two Western Directors and three Western Officials of the Bank. These applications are afterwards reviewed and criticized by the Head Office Officials before being presented at the regular weekly meetings of the

Board of Directors in Toronto. A weekly statement of all loans, including new advances, renewals, etc., from every branch of the Bank, is presented to the Board each week. A statement in detail of all the Bank’s Call Loans against stocks and bonds in Canada, New York and London, Eng., is submitted to the Directors quarterly, including the names of borrowers, amounts, full particulars of securities held, market prices, etc.

Each half year a statement of every borrowing account in the Bank with an authorized credit of \$100,000 or over is submitted to the Directors with full particulars of the position of the account, security, etc. Each half year also a statement of every known doubtful or slow advance of \$20,000 or over is presented to the Board for discussion, accompanied by the recommendations of the Officials of the Bank for liquidation or protection. Every half year the Bank’s Officials prepare a detailed statement of every doubtful or slow account on the books of the Bank, no matter how small, at every Branch, accompanied by their recommendations for appropriations where necessary. These reports are prepared with the greatest care by the Managers at the Bank’s Branches and are scrutinized by several of the Chief Officials of the Bank at Toronto and Winnipeg and revised when necessary. Each year a complete statement is submitted to the Directors with an analysis of all the Bank’s loans, showing the advances under their various trade classifications and recording all changes of \$100,000 or over in any individual account. Aside from these various reports and statements, any account requiring special attention is frequently brought to the attention of the Directors by the General Manager for discussion and necessary action.

I would like to refer briefly to the subject of Government Banking. The agitation for Government Banking and loaning facilities in Canada, including the taking of deposits from the public, cannot be regarded as a justified economic movement. The following facts are obvious: To the extent that deposits are diverted from the Banks and are loaned upon long-dated mort-

gage security, credit to legitimate business, including agriculture as well as commerce, must necessarily be curtailed, as the Banks will certainly have that much less money to lend their customers, who include farmers, merchants, manufacturers and other dealers and producers throughout the Dominion. If a Government thinks it necessary to make loans to the farming community for the purpose of improving farm property, purchasing equipment or to enable the purchase of additional land, funds for such purposes should be obtained by issuing long-term debentures which may be met at maturity, if necessary, by re-funding. Owing to the heavy debt of the Dominion of Canada and the steadily increasing liabilities of provinces, cities, towns and other municipalities, the banks will undoubtedly be called upon to assist in unusually large financial operations in the near future, and it is of the utmost importance that they should be in funds to do so—any material reduction in their deposits will seriously interfere with their ability to take part in such financing. The considerations mentioned apply equally to the policy of the Government taking deposits from the public and devoting the proceeds to public purposes such as municipal works or projects. Funds for these purposes should undoubtedly be raised through the sale of long-term securities. To impose heavy taxes on the Banks and then establish Government opposition, paying unhealthy rates for deposits and operating the machinery in a manner which makes it possible to draw on the public pocket-book to cover deficits, is both unfair and unsound. It should also be borne in mind that if the movement spreads and the Banks, for the protection of their legitimate earning power, are compelled to raise the rate of interest on deposits to compete with Governments, the inevitable result will be that borrowing rates will have to be increased, as well as other charges for banking services. Such necessary measures would be a real detriment and drawback to all business enterprise.

In conclusion, I should like to say that I think it would be very hard to find a group of men who are more assiduous in their duties than are the Officials

of The Dominion Bank. I have absolute confidence in their ability and their integrity and their loyal service to the Institution.”

REMARKS BY VICE-PRESIDENT MR. A. W. AUSTIN.

“In view of the generally unsatisfactory state of business during the year just concluded, I think our Shareholders have every reason to be pleased with the statement presented. We have not only paid our regular dividend and a bonus, but have contributed to the Pension Fund, written off a considerable sum from Bank Premises Account, and added to the credit balance of Profit and Loss.

A large proportion of the Bank's business is carried on in Ontario, and while last season's crops in this Province were not all that could be desired, still I think we have come through better than most of the Provinces. Prices for farm products have declined considerably, but not as much as in some parts of the middle Western States, where the farmers have found it to their advantage to burn their corn for fuel rather than buy coal. The poor prices received for produce make it impossible, in many cases, to pay the wages demanded by laborers, consequently many of the farms have been neglected, especially the orchards, where much disease prevails. For instance, there is no better apple than the Ontario apple, particularly the Northern Spy, but we see purchased in preference apples from the State of Oregon and elsewhere, thousands of miles away, because greater care is shown in fighting these fruit diseases, also in the packing and shipping. Last year the Niagara Peninsula Growers' Association was formed to encourage care in growing and packing, as well as to find profitable markets, and it is expected that the fruit industry will be much benefited thereby.

A great deal of unemployment still prevails, but as our local Government has decided to extend its railroad from Cochrane towards James Bay shortly, this condition will be somewhat relieved, and the road when completed will doubtless add considerably to the commerce of the country. On completion of the new Wel-

land Canal, and the St. Lawrence River project, there will not only arise a greater shipping business, but it will be possible then to offer very attractive rates for electric power, and a great manufacturing community is likely to spring up in the Niagara Peninsula.

Australia is making a determined effort this year to secure immigrants from Great Britain, and is meeting with much success, it is said, because the climate more nearly approximates that of Britain than does that of other colonies. Surely the climate of Ontario should be equally attractive to British settlers.

Thrift and honest toil must reassert their power, if the future of our Country is to be assured. Personal economy should now be practised by everyone, and this applies as well to governmental and municipal bodies.

I have not spoken of matters particularly pertaining to other provinces, but as we have with us one of our Western directors, some remarks from him will doubtless be of interest. I beg to second the motion for the adoption of the fifty-first Annual Report."

The report was adopted.

It was moved by Mr. William Crocker, seconded by Mr. George W. Allan, K.C., and unanimously resolved: "That Mr. Geoffrey T. Clarkson and Mr. Robert J. Dilworth, the retiring Auditors, be and they are hereby appointed Auditors to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$6,000."

Rev. Dr. H. J. Cody, M.A.—"Gentlemen, I have much pleasure in presenting the following resolution: "That the thanks of this meeting be given to the President, Vice-Presidents and Directors for their services during the year. I am sure a resolution of this kind at this time should be no perfunctory resolution, it should mean something. This Bank has reached its fifty-first year without ever having had to reduce its capital, without ever having made any serious loss and without ever failing to give a reasonable distribution of profits to its Shareholders. That is an extraordinary record and evidences the combination of successful efforts on the part of the Directors and the Officials of the Bank. Cir-

cumstances in the financial world of Canada of late have turned public attention upon Bank Directors, and surely everyone, the public included, immediately interested in banks, has the right to expect that the Directors will, as the General Manager has said, really direct. I think we are all very fortunate in this Bank in having the splendid traditions of past Directors fully maintained in the present Board. We have a Directorate the members of which are men markedly successful in their own businesses, men who have an intimate knowledge of business conditions in the country, men of business acumen and men who are directly interested in the week by week undertakings of the Bank. They have general business knowledge and specific financial knowledge to make their services of value to the Bank. I am sure I express, sir, the opinion of all the Shareholders when I say that we most heartily appreciate the signal services, marked by knowledge and interest, that characterize the Directors of The Dominion Bank. I have very great pleasure in moving the resolution."

Mr. Leighton McCarthy, K.C.—"Mr. President and gentlemen, I esteem it an honor to be permitted to second this resolution. As a Shareholder of some considerable time I have always appreciated the Board of Directors headed by the President in their direction of the Bank's affairs. They not only have questions of policy to determine, but they have other very important matters to decide incidental to credit, and during this last year they must have experienced considerable difficulty in doing their duty to the Shareholders, whose capital they have in hand, to the depositors for whom they are trustees, and at the same time to the borrowers who must have required an unusual degree of support. I feel that we can most heartily express our appreciation of their efforts and that we as Shareholders may consider ourselves fortunate in the personnel of our Board. The President is a man who began his business career in a Bank, and therefore, has had practical banking experience. He is a man of vast experience in finance and in public affairs, noted for his business sense and integrity, and the attention

which he has devoted to our interests has well merited the confidence which has been reposed in him as President, by the Shareholders for the last twenty-one years. Results speak louder than any words. During his regime the assets in this Bank have increased from \$25,000,000 to \$130,000,000; the deposits have increased from \$18,000,000 to approximately \$100,000,000, and the net annual profits of the Bank from \$275,000 per year to upwards of \$1,000,000 per year. We have also two Vice-Presidents, one from the West and one in the East, both men of outstanding ability, men who have occupied high positions of trust in various channels of business. The other members of the Board are also men of wide experience in finance and industry in whom we may feel at ease as to their careful and judicious control. At this time when the tranquillity of finance is somewhat disturbed it is well that we should have such a feeling of security in the men who are at the helm, and I say with perfect confidence, that we may rest assured that in so far as a Board can protect its Shareholders we could not be in better hands. May I add, Mr. President, that I am sure the Shareholders appreciate to the full the efficient and capable General Manager and other Officials of the Bank, for after all a Board of Directors simply reflects the organization which it represents, and to attain successful results it must have an organization of men of force and character and ability, both at the Head Office and in the Branches. I take great pleasure in seconding this resolution."

The motion was carried unanimously.

Sir Edmund B. Osler—"I may just say one word in thanking these gentlemen for their kind remarks, and that is that it was my privilege to be associated for many years with the first President of this Bank, James Austin, not only in banking, but in other institutions, and in all my experience with Directors I never met a man who was so absolutely devoted to any company of which he was a Director."

Mr. H. W. Hutchinson—"Gentlemen, on behalf of the Directors, I assure you we appreciate very much the

vote of thanks tendered and so ably supported by the very complimentary remarks of the proposer and seconder. We have always endeavored to "direct" and shall continue that policy hereafter.

It might not be amiss, if I were to here state briefly the method adopted in passing upon Western credits. Applications for loans to customers of the various Western Branches are sent to the Western Inspector at Winnipeg, accompanied by a financial statement of the applicant and a letter from the Branch Manager, giving particulars relating to the applicant's integrity, ability and habits, and advising for what purpose the funds are required, together with his recommendations. These applications, with all the accompanying data, are carefully gone over by the Western Inspector and then submitted once a week to Sir Augustus Nanton and myself and the Western Assistant General Manager, Mr. Patton, who carefully consider same. Desirable loans up to \$25,000, if satisfactorily secured, are granted and the undesirable are declined. The Western Directors are not empowered to grant loans in excess of \$25,000; all such are referred to Head Office with our recommendations. Sir Augustus Nanton, Mr. Patton and myself have all resided in Winnipeg for approximately forty years, and with our varied interests I believe we have a fairly good knowledge of Western conditions. In granting credits, we, at all times, endeavor to fully safe-guard the Shareholders' interests. All credits granted by the Western Directors are reported weekly to Head Office and are referred to the Board of Directors at its next meeting. If they do not approve of an application it is their privilege to cancel the credit.

Mr. Austin has stated that I would make reference to Western conditions. I regret to say conditions in the West just now are not conducive to buoyancy, but they might be worse, and while the farmers are disappointed, they are not disheartened. With the prices of all farm products reduced one-half within the past twelve months, the liquidating and purchasing power of the farmer has been seriously impaired and business stagnation has been pretty general. Western

Canada is basically an agricultural country, and upon the farmers' prosperity or adversity largely depends the success or failure of those engaged in commercial pursuits. The West, of course, has been a large producer and exporter of wheat and live stock to foreign nations. The Fordney tariff, so recently instituted, has seriously curtailed exports of the above commodities to the States, who were good customers, and owing to the financial position of devastated Europe, many nations formerly good customers of Canada have been unable to finance the purchase of our Canadian wheat to the same extent as in the past. These facts, coupled with marked price declines in farm products, have caused great disappointment to the Western farmer, and we are not surprised at it. Crop conditions were most promising right up to about the 20th of June, after which a continued period of drought reduced the yield in many districts much below the average; nevertheless, the West harvested the second largest crop in its history, but due to reduced grades resulting from a prolonged period of inclement weather during the harvesting and threshing season, the value of 1921 crop was approximately \$132,000,000 less than the crop of 1920. The acreage in crop was 30,185,000 acres, an increase of 1,000,000 over 1920. The yield of all cereals was 613,375,000 bushels, an increase of 29,000,000 bushels over 1920. Unfortunately the value of the larger 1921 crop was only \$423,755,000, compared with \$555,625,800 for 1920 crop.

I have been asked why the farmers are not meeting their obligations. You must remember the 1921 crop was the most expensive one ever produced in the West. Many had good crops and are meeting their obligations, but in districts where the crop was light and the grade reduced by inclement weather, the net returns to the farmer were less than the cost of production. The cash price for No. 1 Northern wheat in store Fort William in September, 1920, was \$2.81 and September, 1921, \$1.35, the price to-day being \$1.14. The price of oats in September, 1920, was 93c. and September, 1921, 45c. Farmers who were fortunate enough to have a good yield per acre of all No. 1

Northern wheat realized probably sufficient to pay the cost of production, but no more, and those who only had from five to ten bushels per acre of low grade wheat went in the hole in their operations, as the low grade wheat only netted the farmer about two-thirds the price of No. 1 Northern. I stated that the prices were in store Fort William, and from these prices we must deduct the transportation charges from the shipping point to Fort William, which is 25c. per bushel from Alberta points, 20c. per bushel from Saskatchewan points, and 14c. per bushel from Manitoba points. In the case of oats, the market price of which is 45c. in store Fort William, the farmer has to pay 23c. per bushel freight from Alberta, and from 12c. to 18c. per bushel for threshing and had practically nothing left for his labor. You will, therefore, understand the Western farmers' predicament, and as I stated before, while the farmer is disappointed, he is not disheartened. He has prepared a large acreage for crop in 1922—he is not looking for sympathy, but he is looking for, and is deserving of, co-operation and consideration from those to whom he is indebted, if he is to emerge from his present unfortunate position. I have heard some ill-advised and unwarranted criticisms of the West, and I want to say to you that Canada has a grand heritage in the Western Provinces, a heritage that as Canadian citizens we have cause to feel proud of. This very West produced in the four years, 1917 to 1920, cereals having a market value of \$2,362,025,000, a sum almost sufficient to retire Canada's national debt as of December 31st, 1921, which amounted to \$2,366,861,752, and in the eight years, 1914 to 1921, inclusive, the market value of the Western cereal crop was \$3,988,000,000. Now, I contend that any country that can produce cereals of this value is a country to be proud of and to have faith in. Give the West a good crop, with fair prices, and you will be surprised at the reversal of conditions. The 1922 crop will be a much less expensive one to produce than that of 1921, as the price of seed is lower, wages are lower, the prices of farm implements are lower, and with a reduction in freight rates, which the West is pressing

for, and must have, these conditions will all tend to lower the cost of production, and the wheels in the Eastern industries will start revolving again and employment will be given to many now idle."

Mr. H. C. Scholfield—"I have much pleasure in proposing the following motion, 'That the thanks of this meeting be given to the General Manager and Officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties.' In order that the policy of the Directors may be faithfully carried out, a loyal and efficient Staff is essential. As an old Dominion Bank employee, I may say that from the Chief Officials down to the junior clerks there is a feeling of loyalty towards the Institution, and with such faithful co-operation always in evidence I am sure the success we have had in the past will be continued."

Colonel Henry Brock—"I have much pleasure in seconding the resolution."

The motion was declared carried.

Mr. C. A. Bogert—"Gentlemen, the Staff of The Dominion Bank has just completed a year in which, it must be obvious to you, their zeal, ability and loyalty have been tested to the utmost, and it is a real pleasure to me to assure you that in every Branch of the Bank and every department of our service, every Official, every Manager, every clerk, has assumed his additional responsibilities cheerfully and has not failed to look after your interests. We are particularly appreciative to-day of the resolution that has been proposed by Mr. Scholfield, who, as he states, was long connected with The Dominion Bank, and to Colonel Brock we are grateful for seconding this resolution, and also to Mr. Leighton McCarthy for his references to the Staff in his remarks.

I am reminded that at the last Annual Meeting of the Shareholders you gave authority to increase the annual grant to the Pension Fund Society to \$50,000. This year the amount actually apportioned was \$40,000, but I am sure that I voice the feelings of our Staff when I say that we are very grateful to the Shareholders for the aid they have given the fund since it

was founded in 1886. The result is that at the present time we have a very valuable and I think well invested fund out of which any member of the Society who is disabled is assured of support for the balance of his life. The widows and dependents of the deceased members of our Staff are looked after, and any member of the Society in good standing who reaches the age of sixty years is entitled to retire on a pension sufficient to support him comfortably for the rest of his days.

Now, the proceedings are drawing to a close. The Statement that has been submitted to the Shareholders appears to have met with your approval. I wish to state that while these resolutions of thanks to the Officials of the Bank are presented each year, coupled with many remarks of commendation, they are really very much appreciated by us all and they inspire us to fresh efforts on your behalf. I will ask Mr. Patton to say a few words before the next resolution is presented."

Mr. F. L. Patton—"Gentlemen, I much appreciate the privilege accorded me of expressing on behalf of the Staff how much we appreciate the remarks that have been made. Mr. Hutchinson has dealt exhaustively with matters in the West, so I do not need to say anything in regard to that, except to remark that you all know of the disabilities of the farmers last year. In fact in every year they have frost or snow or rain or cutworms, or something of that kind, but in all my experience of forty years in the West I never saw them all come in one year. However, it goes without saying that 1921 has been a very trying year not only for the Executive, but for the Managers of all our Branches. They will have many trying problems to solve, but notwithstanding that, I wish to say that their outstanding loyalty and devotion to the service of the Bank is very great, and I think their efforts during the past year have gone a long way towards making it possible to produce the fine report that has been given to-day. I am sure the Staff will make further and greater efforts to continue to build up this grand old institution of ours of which we are all so justly proud."

It was moved by Mr. John Edwards, seconded by Mr. J. C. Moor, and resolved, "That the poll be now opened for the election of fourteen Directors, and that the same be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon, or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without any vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll."

The Scrutineers declared the following gentlemen duly elected Directors for the ensuing year: Messrs. A. W. Austin, C. S. Blackwell, James Carruthers, R. J. Christie, Sir John C. Eaton, E. W. Hamber, H. W. Hutchinson, W. L. Matthews, R. S. McLaughlin, Sir Augustus M. Nanton, W. W. Near, Sir Edmund B. Osler, A. T. Reid and H. H. Williams.

At a subsequent meeting of the Directors, Sir Edmund B. Osler was elected President and Mr. A. W. Austin and Sir Augustus M. Nanton, Vice-Presidents, for the ensuing term.
