WE REPORT TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF THE DOMINION BANK:

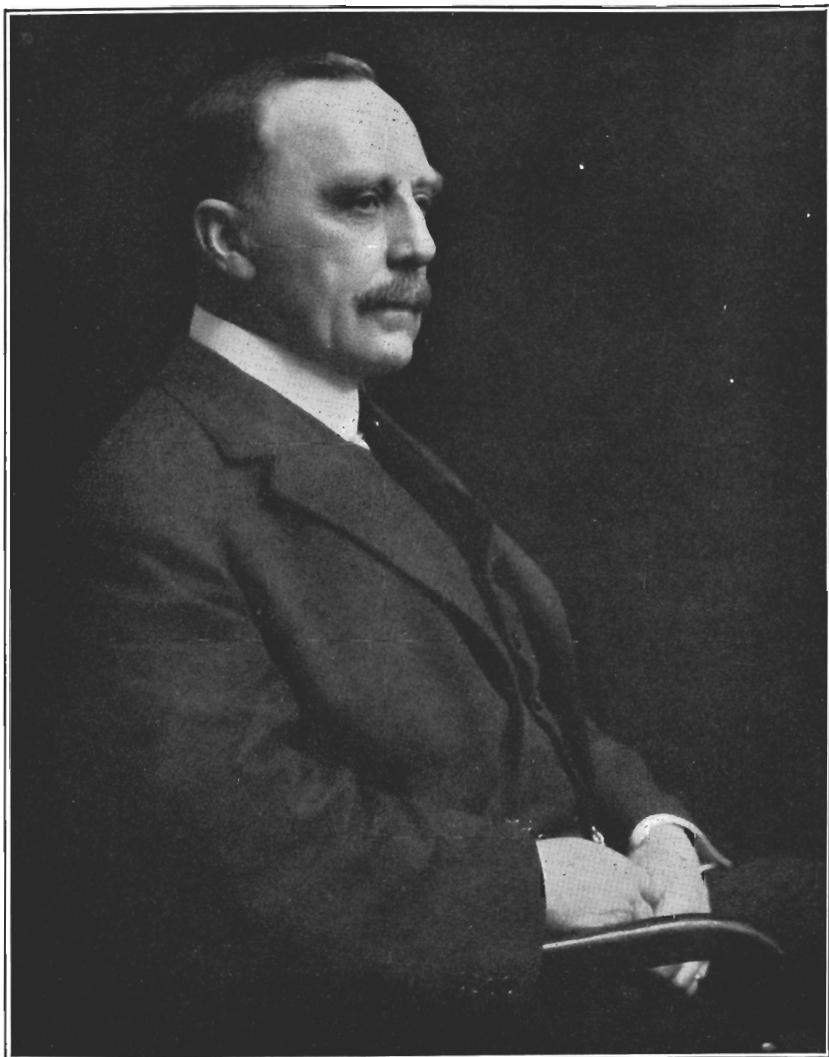

On motion of Messrs. C. S. Blackwell and F. Gordon Osler the chair was taken by the President, Sir Augustus Nanton, and Mr. W. K. Pearce was appointed Secretary of the Meeting.

It was moved by Mr. J. J. Cook, seconded by Mr. W. C. Crowther, and resolved that Messrs. R. M. Gray and E. H. Baines be appointed Scrutineers.

Sir Augustus Nanton—Gentlemen: You must all share with me the feeling that there is something wanting in this gathering to-day. Two of those whom we have been accustomed to see at annual 'meetings' for 'so many years past, are not with us. Sir Edmund Osler, who was your President for twenty-three years, and who was interested in the Bank from its inception, died on the 4th of August last. His great ability, integrity and unflinching attachment to The Dominion Bank in its every activity, are too well

known to require any comment from me. Up to the last Sir Edmund gave of his best to this institution, and his death has been mourned by every member of the Board and by all the officers of the Bank.

I entered his office on the 11th of December, 1875, and therefore served under him for nearly forty-nine years. On the fortieth anniversary I telegraphed him, reminding him of the occasion, and received an answer reading "forty years of unbroken friendship without a single misunderstanding or dispute." Mr. F. Gordon Osler, Sir Edmund's eldest son, has been elected to the Board.

It is also my sad duty to refer to the death of Mr. James Carruthers, for many years a valued Director of the Bank, whose loss the Board greatly deplores.

I will now call upon the Secretary of the Meeting to read the Director's Report, after which Mr. Bogert, the General Manager, will make his comments on the statement.

The report of the Directors to the Shareholders and the Annual Statement of the affairs of the Bank for the year ended December 31st, 1924, were then read by the Secretary.

With deep regret we have to record the death of Sir Edmund Osler, which took place on the 4th of August last. He had been associated with the Bank since its foundation, was elected a Director in 1882, and for the past twenty-three years occupied the Presidential Chair. Sir Augustus M. Nanton was elected to succeed him as President.

We also have to record with great regret the death of Mr. James Carruthers, which occurred on the 19th of September. He had been a member of the Board since 1907. Mr. F. Gordon Osler was elected to the Directorate in November.

The Head Office and Branches of the Bank have been inspected during the year, and the cash and securities at Head Office as of date the 31st December, have been verified by a Committee of your Directors.

The Shareholders' Auditors, Messrs. A. B. Shepherd and Percy C. Baxter, appointed at the last Annual Meeting, have made a very thorough investigation of the Bank's affairs and their report is attached to the Balance Sheet.

COMMENTS BY MR. C. A. BOGERT, GENERAL MANAGER.

The report in the hands of our Shareholders, indicating a moderate expansion in earnings, deposits and total assets, will, we trust, meet with your approval. The profits for the year 1924 are better by some \$15,000 in the face of conditions not wholly favourable, such as lesser requirements from our ordinary commercial borrowers during the middle of the year, lower rates than for some time past on our loans on call in London and New York, and smaller yields from our investment securities, notwithstanding which we have been able to keep the Bank's funds fairly well employed through the period under review. In a banking institution it is more difficult to effect economies during lean years than in other lines of industry. It must be remembered that in bad times as in good, in quiet times as in those of greatest activity, little reduction can be made in the overhead charges of a Bank. Our organization must always be maintained at full strength and efficiency and in recent years the bogey of taxation is always confronting us.

In our case, the item of taxation alone for the past year, that is, Dominion and Provincial taxes, totalled almost 3% of our paid-up capital, not taking into consideration business taxes and taxes on property, which accounted for an additional 4%. Total disbursements for taxation in Canada during 1924 amounted to about \$418,000.

Furthermore, during a long period of rising costs of operation, banking charges, to a somewhat exacting public, remain virtually at a pre-war level, or lower, and are quite out of line with those of other organizations giving service to the community.

As has been pointed out to the Shareholders at other meetings, the profits are always reckoned on a most conservative basis and after providing for contingencies of every character as far as it is possible to deal with them. It has always been the policy of The Dominion Bank to err, if anything, on the side of conservatism in making appropriations and there is every indication that as an improvement takes place, amounts previously set aside will be wholly or partially recovered—in fact, this has already been our experience.

As the Secretary of the Meeting has informed you, the profits for the year were \$1,144,082, which added to the amount brought forward from the previous year—\$825,375—makes a total of \$1,969,457 to be dealt with.

After distributing \$780,000 to the Shareholders, and disposing of the other amounts mentioned in the statement, we were able to carry forward \$900,125 in Profit and Loss Account—an increase of \$75,000.

It is opportune to remind the Shareholders that this \$900,125, which is 15% of the Bank's paid-up capital of \$6,000,000, is really another line of defence always available in addition to the \$7,000,000 actually in Reserve Account. The creditors and Shareholders are given further protection by certain contingent accounts that are set up to provide for unforeseen shrinkages or losses.

Comparing the Liabilities and Assets of the Bank with those of the previous year, Notes in Circulation were \$600,000 less, which is of no particular significance. Total deposits increased during the twelve months \$2,470,000. Deposits

not bearing interest were less by \$480,000 and deposits bearing interest increased during the year \$3,000,000. There was no great expansion in interest bearing deposits during the earlier months of 1924, but towards the end of the year increases were in evidence at nearly every branch of the Bank. At the conclusion of every calendar year there is a natural automatic expansion in Bank deposits and we are not an exception. Many depositors, whether those in ordinary business or those who accumulate savings, are in receipt of funds from various sources, including the large amount that is put in circulation through the sale of the country's crops.

Advances under the Finance Act, \$4,300,000, as against \$4,000,000 the previous year, reach the highest figures in the case of this Bank in the Autumn and Winter months when loans to dealers in products are large and active. Such loans from the Government are frequently retired during the course of the year.

Letters of Credit Outstanding—\$2,145,000—show little change and largely represent the ordinary activities of the Bank's customers who import goods into Canada.

Under the heading of "Liabilities not included in the foregoing" the amount \$545,000 consists of reservations for taxes and other charges incurred in connection with the 1924 business but not yet disbursed.

Turning to the Assets side—Dominion Government Notes, Gold and Silver Coin, Notes and Cheques on other Banks, and Balances due by Banks and Banking Correspondents elsewhere than in Canada, all of which are the equivalent of cash, amount to approximately \$27,000,000, or 24.8% of the Bank's public liabilities.

Dominion and Provincial Government securities, not exceeding market value, amounting to \$14,500,000, have, you will observe, decreased during the year by about \$2,900,000.

In October and November, 1924, the Dominion Government retired the balance of its obligations to the Canadian Banks incurred during the War, of which amount we received \$4,000,000. Aside from this, our accumulation of addi-

tional Dominion and Provincial Government securities amounted to \$1,100,000.

Canadian Municipal Securities, and British, Foreign and Colonial Public Securities other than Canadian, not exceeding market value, \$4,725,000, increased by \$700,000. Railway and other Bonds, Debentures and Stocks, not exceeding market value, \$2,368,000, remain practically the same.

Call and Short Loans in Canada on Stocks, Debentures and Bonds and other Securities of a sufficient marketable value to cover, at the end of December, 1923, were \$5,278,000, and at the end of December last, \$15,227,000. This increase of \$10,400,000 is accounted for by the inclusion in that total of demand loans against grain and flour, secured by actual marketable documents. Such assets we consider more liquid than any others on our books aside from cash assets and the Bank's actual investments in first-class securities.

The total of our Immediately Available Assets—\$66,560,000—is 61.4% of public liabilities, maintaining our usual standard of liquidity.

Current Loans and Discounts in Canada at the end of the year were \$45,626,000, and about \$2,600,000 more than on the 31st of December, 1923, a favourable feature and largely accounted for by higher prices ruling for grain and its products.

Our commercial loans have been subjected to the most searching scrutiny during the year, both by our own officials and by the Shareholders' Auditors. We believe that all possible contingencies have been provided for, and the figures of these loans, as of all other assets, appearing on the Balance Sheet, are an expression of our best and most conservative judgment of their values.

You will observe that the Bank is carrying a very small amount under the heading of "Real Estate other than Bank Premises"—\$90,000, which represents properties taken over from time to time in partial settlement of debts, and which is a very reasonable valuation of these assets.

Non-Current Loans—\$347,000—which, as you will recollect, replace what were formerly known as Overdue Bills

under the old Bank Act, are moderate in size and fully secured.

The total of Bank Premises Account—\$6,038,000—is \$85,000 less than a year ago after writing off \$75,000 from Profit and Loss Account, already referred to. No expenditures of moment were made during 1924. An amount of \$17,000 was paid for a building and lot in Napance where we have been established for many years and where we hitherto have occupied rented premises, and \$11,000 was used to complete a new building on the Bank's property at the corner of Dundas St. and Runnymede Road, Toronto.

In recent years, and for obvious reasons, Shareholders of Canadian Banks and the public generally, have taken more than a passing interest in the statements that are periodically published. Certain isolated occurrences attracted more than ordinary attention to the affairs of financial institutions. Measures have been taken for the further protection of the depositors and Shareholders of Banks and we may assume that the ill winds of unsound administration have blown good in some directions, if only to remind those who conduct the affairs of Canadian Banks of their great responsibilities. The Banking Act as revised affords every possible safeguard for the public and let us hope that it will stand for a reasonable period without further changes for if unreasonable duties are imposed on Directors or Chief Officials of Banks it is quite likely that difficulties will arise in getting properly qualified men to fill these positions.

There is still room for improvement in general business conditions, although, largely through the higher returns for farm products, many lines are making a better showing.

In the Western Provinces the grain crops were neither generally good nor equally distributed; the total yield of wheat fell below that of 1923 by about 200,000,000 bushels, with other grains in like proportion, and while some districts were especially favoured, others suffered almost total failure.

The unusually high prices obtained, however—in sharp contrast to the low returns of the previous year—more than

offset these conditions, and as a result the general situation, in Western Canada particularly, shows decided improvement. Both farmers and ranchers are obtaining better prices, and in the case of the latter the greater foreign demand for packing house products is encouraging. The Mortgage Companies are able to report substantial payments on mortgage loans, both as to principal and interest, while the Banks also have shared in the general reduction of indebtedness and improved their position in respect to advances based upon agriculture.

The West has received a much needed encouragement, faith in the country is largely restored and the whole morale of the population raised.

A year ago we were feeling the ill effects of a world-wide over-production of wheat. This has now turned into a pronounced shortage, and it seems probable that high prices for grain will continue for a year or two at least, with beneficial results to the whole country.

Generally speaking, our manufacturing industries are suffering from lack of turnover and excessive overhead, with the result that in many cases profits in 1924 were lean, non-existent, or replaced by losses.

We hear complaints that the retail trade of the country in pursuing a course of hand-to-mouth buying is responsible for the operating losses of the manufacturers, but we can not see that any real or lasting benefit would result from overstocking the merchants' shelves far in advance of demand from the consumer.

More harm than good always results from attempting to force business which, in the last analysis, must wait upon the needs and buying capacity of the public, many of whom are now practising a much belated economy.

It should be borne in mind that the remarkable advance in the values of all classes of securities during the year 1924 is by no means an evidence of real prosperity—on the contrary, an accumulation of money always follows dull business, with the result that people seek investments and the

speculative element are attracted by the prospect of easy profits; chiefly for these reasons there has been a steady demand for bonds and stocks of all descriptions.

Insofar as this Bank is concerned, we continue to do our full share in financing the legitimate needs of all classes of business wherever we are established.

In the past we have sometimes been referred to as a "grain Bank," but while we consider there is no safer channel in which to employ our funds, and are proud of our connection with the grain trade, the Bank's business is thoroughly general in character.

It may interest the Shareholders to know that the total of the loans appearing in the Balance Sheet is made up of advances to more than 8,000 borrowers, representing every kind of activity in which our people are engaged.

BRANCH BANKS

The total number of branches operated by the chartered Banks of Canada, which stood at 3,047 at the end of the year 1914, increased steadily throughout the War, reaching 3,446 at the end of 1918. The movement gained impetus after the Armistice and over 1,200 new offices were added in the next two years and in October, 1921, the total number of branch Banks in Canada was 4,717, since when the tendency has been in the opposite direction. At the end of December, 1924, the number had been reduced to 4,028, and there are doubtless many more unproductive branches yet to be eliminated.

This Bank, however, is not at present particularly concerned with these adjustments. The number of our branches remains the same as a year ago and practically all of them justify their continuance. It is unlikely that any important change will take place during the present year.

GENERAL REMARKS

As to the future, I am frank to say that in our view 1925 will be a difficult year in which to find profitable use for banking funds. With capital seeking employment and reduced demand for it, fixed yield investments must naturally rise in price and the returns on money be less. On the

other hand, it is reasonable to expect that the Banks will benefit through diminished losses in the field of commercial loans because we have every reason to believe that business generally has made liberal allowances and created reserves to provide for contingencies.

Already there are distinct evidences of a return of banking confidence and the annual statements that are now being issued indicate a gradual improvement, with an impressive tendency towards strength and liquidity.

There is one thought, I am sure, in the minds of all of us to-day—one of real sorrow that since our meeting of a year ago we have lost our former President, Sir Edmund Osler, who died on August 4th last.

Sir Edmund's career was bound up with that of The Dominion Bank. His connection with it began at its inception, when as a young financial agent in 1869 he took an active part in obtaining subscriptions to the capital stock. He continued for the rest of his life in the closest relationship to the institution, becoming a Director in 1882, Vice-President in 1897 and President in 1901; the last of a distinguished trio who have preceded Sir Augustus Nanton, your present Chairman. Mr. James Austin, Sir Frank Smith, Sir Edmund Osler—all three were intimately associated with the Bank from its earliest beginnings, and so continued until their last days.

I will not attempt to measure the value of Sir Edmund's great services to the Shareholders, but, speaking from personal knowledge, it is sufficient to say that throughout a long and busy life, crowded with heavy responsibilities, the affairs of The Dominion Bank were ever first in his mind and his great abilities were employed unceasingly in its behalf. The institution stands to-day as a monument to his memory.

In selecting Sir Augustus Nanton to succeed Sir Edmund Osler, his fellow Directors could pay no higher compliment to Sir Augustus, who, as you all know, is eminently fitted to administer the affairs of the Bank according to its best traditions.

ADDRESS BY SIR AUGUSTUS NANTON,
PRESIDENT.

Mr. Bogert, having so ably and fully explained in detail the report that you have before you, leaves little or nothing for me to say. I have been one of your directors for some time, but have only very recently been appointed your President. This great honour I much appreciate, and I sincerely trust I may prove capable of filling the position. I would like to publicly thank the Board for the confidence they have placed in me, and especially to thank my very old friend and colleague, Mr. Austin, for so unselfishly nominating me for the presidency. A few years ago Sir Edmund explained at a shareholders' meeting how the Board directed the affairs of this institution. Last year, Mr. Blackwell and Mr. Clarkson, the retiring Auditor, went into the same subject, so that all I have to say is that the policies explained by these gentlemen are strictly followed, and that your directors, together with your General Manager, who has served the Bank so ably in that position during the last nineteen years, are fully conversant with the affairs of the institution. They, together with high officers of the Bank, consider weekly the numerous matters which come before the Board, so that we are able to state that the report now before you shows correctly the Bank's position.

In addition to discussing the report with the General Manager, I personally went into the figures with the Secretary and the Chief Accountant of the Bank, and am satisfied that every provision has been made, and amply made, against any bad or doubtful accounts. The Bank Act provides that if the auditors of a Bank find any loan not adequately secured it is their duty to notify individually the members of the Board of that fact. When speaking to one of your new auditors recently, I remarked that I would be sorry if he ever had to write me in that connection. His reply was "Matters would have to change greatly before you would receive such a letter from me." In other words, your auditors have not found a single bad or doubtful account, or other asset in The Dominion Bank for which sufficient or proper provision has not been made.

The Government has also under last year's amendment to the Act, recently appointed an Inspector General of Banks which will work for the further safeguarding of the share-

holders' interests. The attitude of this Bank has always been that it was for the Government to say what form of outside inspection there should be, but that the success or failure of any system must depend upon the capacity of the officials chosen to conduct it. We feel that their selection, from the standpoint of experience and ability, is a good one, and we believe that the new system—which is now in operation—will prove to be all that is expected of it.

I am not going to speak at any length regarding the state of business generally, but would like to touch upon one or two subjects. I think it can safely be said that the business outlook for 1925 is good, provided that every man does his share in improving conditions, by hard work, careful living and careful buying. For a number of years past, our great commercial concerns have made little or no money, and have often ended a year with heavy losses. This has practically ceased, and if they are given support, will soon become prosperous again, thus benefiting the whole country. During a like period also the farmers have generally failed to make expenses. The pendulum has now swung their way, however, and if their markets are properly protected and their labour supplied from the cities and from immigration, they will again enjoy better times.

To my mind there are several salient points which need to be carried out in order to bring general prosperity to Canada. Taxation, through strict economy of our Governments, must be cut down, so that the taxes in Canada at least do not exceed those levied in the United States. The present heavy taxation, which falls chiefly upon the rich, has stifled enterprise, and therefore reacts on the rank and file, who are eventually the chief sufferers. Immigration for the settlement of our vast areas, now untilled, would increase our markets and give assistance to our farmers and manufacturers. Eastern and Western Canada must be brought into closer touch with one another through a greater knowledge and understanding of their several problems and viewpoints, and through an increased appreciation of the common bond of Canadian citizenship which we all enjoy. Canada must remain united and must draw the bonds of unity tighter than they are to-day, if she will achieve the full measure of that great destiny which awaits her. Our markets should be reasonably protected against the invasion of our friends from the South, who have put up a tariff wall

against our farmers and manufacturers. How can it be expected that we, one to fourteen, should successfully compete, when they can sell to us and we cannot sell to them? My feeling is that we should strongly advocate trading with those who would trade with us on equal terms. We should buy Canadian goods, or British goods, and build up our country and our Empire.

Much is expected from the famous "Dawes Plan" for Reparation Payments by Germany. The actual results of this settlement, of course, remain to be seen through the years ahead; but the two great facts, that it is sponsored by the United States and has been accepted by a responsible German Government, justify the hope that normal economic conditions in the late belligerent countries are at least on the way, though the way may, and doubtless will be a long one. A restored buying power in Europe would mean a great deal for Canadian export trade.

A matter which is of interest to all Bank shareholders is contained in a decision of the Privy Council given in December last, respecting Succession Duties on Bank shares. This, in effect, does away with double taxation for Succession Duty purposes, that is, taxation by more than one Province, on the same shares.

A controversy has continued for some years respecting the claims of the Provinces of Quebec and Nova Scotia, that both should exact Succession Duty on the shares held by a late resident of Nova Scotia in a Bank having its Head Office in Quebec Province—the Privy Council now deciding that as the Bank had a register in Halifax, in which the shares in question appeared, the property was in the Province of Nova Scotia and could be taxed only by that Province.

This Bank has recently established a register in Montreal to which the shares of all holders resident in Quebec Province have been transferred. The effect of this is, therefore, that such shares are now liable for Succession Duties by the Province of Quebec, but not by Ontario.

We have now 2,144 shareholders in The Dominion Bank. This is the largest number in our history, and an increase of more than 100 during 1924.

I now move the adoption of the annual statement as presented.

Mr. A. W. Austin—Under such conditions as existed last year I think our Statement may be considered very satisfactory; it shows an improvement over 1923. We have increased our deposits by about \$2,500,000; have written \$75,000 off Bank Premises Account; have paid the usual 12% Dividend and a Bonus of 1% and added \$75,000 to Profit and Loss Account.

While we shall miss the valuable advice of our late President, it is encouraging to know that in Sir Augustus Nanton we have a most worthy and able successor; one, who as a partner of Sir Edmund Osler, has had a long experience in Western Canada, which will prove of incalculable value to The Dominion Bank.

You must all be familiar with Banking conditions by this time, and it is unnecessary for me to make any further comments. It is with much pleasure that I second the motion for the adoption of the Fifty-fourth Annual Report.

The motion was presented to the Meeting and adopted.

Mr. S. R. Parsons—Mr. Chairman, I beg to move "That Mr. A. B. Shepherd and Mr. Percy C. Baxter, the retiring Auditors, be and they are hereby appointed Auditors to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$10,000."

Mr. Fred Armstrong seconded the motion, which was carried.

Chairman—Before we go on with the next item I would like to explain that all your Directors are here with two exceptions—Mr. McLaughlin and Mr. Hamber. Mr. McLaughlin is in the Southern States. Mr. Hamber intended being here, but telegraphed the General Manager that business engagements made it impossible for him to be present.

Mr. A. Monro Grier, K.C.—In rising to move this resolution I would like to refer briefly to the passing of the late President of the Bank. It has been my pleasure and honour to know three generations of the Osler family, and I desire to add just a word to the extraordinarily fine—because so simple—references already made to Sir Edmund Osler. You all know that in St. Paul's Cathedral there are, in Latin, words which translated mean "If you would seek his monument

look about you." This, of course, is a reference to the architect, the great Sir Christopher Wren. So in every Branch of The Dominion Bank these words might fittingly be inscribed: "If you would seek a monument to Sir Edmund Osler look around you." To-day our hearts are warmed when we contemplate that in his place as President we have one whose association with him must, I think, have been closer than that of a brother.

We are also gratified that again we have the name "Osler" on the Board in the person of Mr. Gordon Osler, and I am sure we wish him no happier future than that he may follow in the footsteps of his distinguished father. I should like to recall to your minds that Sir Edmund was a brother of Sir William Osler, a man of great distinction; of Mr. B. B. Osler, one of the greatest lawyers in Canada, and of the Honourable Featherston Osler, whose name was the synonym of honour, and this can also be said of Sir Edmund by all who have been associated with him in The Dominion Bank.

And now as to the Directorate of the Bank as a whole, I can most sincerely say that it is a matter of the greatest satisfaction to me at every meeting I attend to contemplate that we have realities presented to us, that we are told the actual condition and the facts—in fine, Sir, my feeling as to the various members of the Board is that they have stood for things that are sound and safe and sensible rather than for things sensational.

It is therefore, Sir, with real pleasure that I move "That the thanks of this meeting be given to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their services during the year."

Dr. F. LeM. Grasett—I am not going to attempt to add anything to the eloquent way in which the vote of thanks has been offered to the Directors for the work they have done during the last year; I would merely second the resolution already proposed.

Chairman—You have heard the resolution, is it your pleasure that it be passed? (Carried.)

I will ask Mr. Blackwell to reply on behalf of the Board.

Mr. C. S. Blackwell—Mr. Chairman and Shareholders of The Dominion Bank: We very much appreciate the kind

remarks made by the mover and seconder as to the stewardship rendered by the Directors. My few years of service on the Board of this Bank have taught me that the Directors are thoroughly conscientious in the discharge of their duties, and I am in a position to assure the Shareholders that their interests are at all times receiving our constant attention.

Colonel Henry Brock—Mr. Chairman and Gentlemen: I have been asked to move the following resolution—"That the thanks of this meeting be given to the General Manager and other officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties." I think we have every reason to be satisfied with the attention which the General Manager and other officers of the Bank have given to their duties this year, and I have much pleasure in moving this resolution.

Mr. W. H. Edwards—I have pleasure in seconding this resolution.

The resolution was carried.

Mr. Bogert—I am always glad of this annual opportunity of assuring the Shareholders of The Dominion Bank of the great zeal and loyalty that they receive from all ranks of our staff. It also gives me an opportunity of expressing to the staff, in the presence of a large number of the Shareholders, how very greatly I appreciate their co-operation, without which we could accomplish nothing. I am grateful for the remarks of Colonel Brock, and to the seconder, and wish to thank you very heartily for this resolution. I am going to ask two members of the staff to say something to you also in reply. Mr. Patton, who so ably supervises your affairs in Western Canada, and Mr. Rae, who is your chief representative at New York. I am sure it is a pleasure to all of us to have Mr. Patton with us to-day. Last year, for the first time in many years, he was unavoidably absent through a serious illness. To-day he is with us, fully restored to health, looking, if possible, younger than ever; he is, in fact, the "Peter Pan" of The Dominion Bank. I will now ask Mr. Patton and Mr. Rae to say a word or two in response to this resolution.

Mr. F. L. Patton—Mr. Chairman, I have pleasure in conveying the thanks of the staff for the very kindly resolution that has been passed by the Shareholders approving of their hard work during the past year. From my personal

observation and experience in the past twenty-eight years, I have no hesitation in saying that for loyalty and devotion the staff of The Dominion Bank will compare favourably with any other institution in Canada to-day. I am sure that we are all, both juniors and seniors, proud to be able to work under our General Manager and our Board of Directors and I simply wish to voice the sentiments of the staff and to thank the Shareholders for their confidence in passing the resolution which you have just heard.

Mr. R. Rac—Mr. Chairman and Gentlemen: During the past few years the responsibilities and work of all Bank staffs have been greatly increased and I am sure that the staff of this institution is no exception to the rule—they have worked faithfully in your service and I can assure you that they will continue to serve you efficiently and loyally. I am glad to respond to this resolution of thanks to the staff and to thank you on their behalf.

Mr. Edward Burns—Mr. Chairman, I will move the following resolution: "That the poll be now opened for the election of twelve Directors and that the same be closed at two o'clock in the afternoon, or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without a vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll."

Mr. David Henderson—I beg to second that motion. (Carried.)

After the Ballot was taken the Scrutineers reported that the following had been elected Directors: Messrs. A. W. Austin, C. S. Blackwell, R. J. Christie, R. Y. Eaton, E. W. Hamber, Wilmot L. Matthews, R. S. McLaughlin, Sir Augustus M. Nanton, W. W. Near, F. Gordon Osler, A. T. Reid and H. H. Williams.

At a subsequent meeting of the Directors, Sir Augustus M. Nanton was elected President, and Mr. A. W. Austin, Vice-President, for the ensuing year.

The General Statement, with copy of the Profit and Loss Account and of the Minutes of the Annual Meeting are sent to the Shareholders in accordance with the provisions of Section 54 of the Bank Act.
