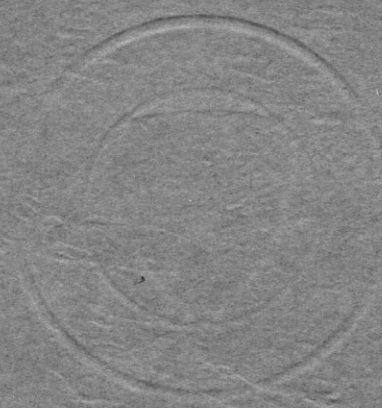

### AUDITORS' REPORT TO SHAREHOLDERS

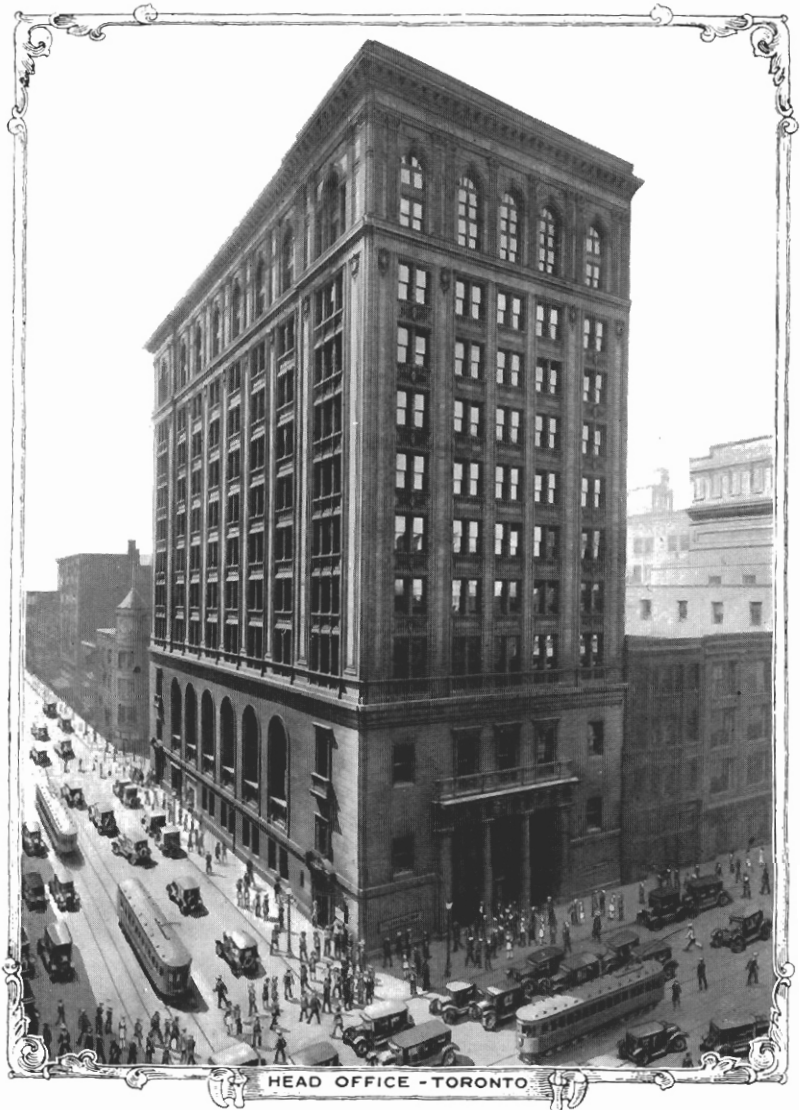
#### WE REPORT TO THE SHAREHOLDERS OF THE DOMINION BANK:

#### ADDRESS BY MR. A. W. AUSTIN, PRESIDENT

Since our last meeting I regret to say we have lost by death two of our Directors. Mr. R. J. Christie served you in this capacity for over twenty years, and at the time of his death in June last was second in seniority among the existing Board. He took an unceasing interest in the Bank's affairs at all times, and his long term was distinguished by an earnest sense of his responsibility both to the shareholders as their representative and to the public.

Mr. A. T. Reid, who died in April, had been one of our number for nine years, and served the Bank with great ability and devotion throughout.

Both these gentlemen filled large places in the hearts of their colleagues and are greatly missed.

Your Directors have recently elected Mr. J. Allan Ross, of Toronto, to a place on the Board. Mr. Ross, as all of you know, takes high rank among the business men of the City and we are very glad to avail ourselves of his ability and wide experience.

Before moving the adoption of the Report, I have a few remarks to make, but as most of the other Banks have held their Annual Meetings and their representatives have made exhaustive comments upon business conditions in Canada, I need not unduly enlarge upon them.

So far as The Dominion Bank is concerned, I think we have every reason to view with satisfaction the statement now before you, for it is one of the best that we have ever issued and shows the Bank to be in a very strong position. Earnings have increased by \$102,000, and after making the usual appropriations for taxation and the Pension Fund, we have distributed amongst our shareholders 13% on their stock holdings, have written off \$200,000 from Bank Premises Account as compared with \$100,000 in 1925, and have increased Profit and Loss Account by \$68,000, the total carried forward being \$1,032,554, the largest amount in the Bank's history.

General agricultural conditions in Canada were not as favourable in 1926 as in the previous year, due to the continuous wet weather during the late Summer and throughout the harvesting period.

The total yield of wheat in the Western Provinces is given as approximately 371,000,000 bushels as compared to 394,000,000 bushels in 1925, and the production of oats, barley and other grains was considerably lower.

Owing to excessive moisture all grains naturally showed a lower percentage of contract grades, but the effect of this to the farmer was largely offset by better average prices, while efficient handling of damp grain under the supervision

of the Board of Grain Commissioners further minimized depreciation in values from this cause.

The general result is surprisingly good; the new wealth created is even greater than in 1925, and the Western farmer, after three generally favourable years, is once again enjoying prosperity.

Further liquidation of past indebtedness has taken place and the benefit of the increased Western purchasing power has been felt throughout the country.

The Banks have shared in this prosperity. Current loans have been well taken care of by borrowers, deposits have moderately increased, and in many cases debts, which had been written off or provided for as beyond recovery, have been wholly or partially paid.

Year by year mixed farming is gaining ground in our Western Provinces—once known almost exclusively as a grain country. Hog-raising and dairying are receiving more attention, and altogether the West seems to have learned that it is unwise to depend entirely upon the production of grain. If an example were needed, it is furnished in the present unfavourable economic position of some of the Southern States through over-production of cotton, virtually their only staple product for more than a century.

The adoption of a constructive crop programme and improved farm practices are a better solution for the problems of the farmer than dependence upon Government aid or price-fixing.

In our Eastern Provinces, while the crops suffered somewhat from wet weather, conditions of agriculture are on the whole satisfactory.

Cattle receipts at our principal stock yards fell slightly below the figure of 1925, and exports to Great Britain were some 25% less. Cattle is shipped to the British market for sale on arrival, which means a considerable risk to the exporter at all times, but in 1926 unprecedented, owing to factors quite beyond Canada's control in the form of a price war in the Argentine and the effect of the English coal strike. Exporters have consequently suffered considerable losses and 1926 was an unprofitable year for this industry.

A general improvement in conditions is reported from the manufacturing centres. Operations have been steadily maintained in most lines and there is a satisfactory volume of unfilled orders ahead that ensures continued activity for some time to come. Our paper mills, sugar refineries, tanneries, textile and knitting mills are working close to capacity. Our boot and shoe factories have had a good year, and the clothing manufacturers have enjoyed better business than in 1925.

The year 1926 has been one of heavy replacement of equipment by the farmers, and the agricultural implement industry has had a profitable year, with an excellent outlook for the coming season.

The improvement in general business is naturally reflected in the traffic returns of our two great Railways, which show largely increased earnings; the better position of the Canadian National is one of the brightest features of the past year.

The record of business failures shows about the same number as in 1925, but the total liabilities involved are substantially less—\$27,400,000 odd as compared to \$35,500,000.

Our foreign commerce in both exports and imports shows important gains. Our grain and newsprint paper chiefly account for the increased exports, and an interesting new item is our heavy shipments of coal to Great Britain, when, owing to the unfortunate and prolonged strike, the familiar paradox of "carrying coals to Newcastle" for once received practical demonstration. Canada benefited by this, and at the same time was able to render valuable assistance to the mother country.

The Atlantic appears to be yielding gradually to the Pacific supremacy of the world's trade routes, an indication of which is seen in Canada's growing commerce with the Orient; Japan and China now ranking next to the United States and Great Britain as her best customers, while the exchange of commodities is growing with Australia as a result of the pact. The development of this business is of the utmost moment to the future of Vancouver, which already occupies an important position among the world's

great sea ports, especially as an alternative outlet for our Western grain.

Our mining industry is attracting more and more the attention of the investor, and development in Ontario, Quebec and Manitoba is going forward on a scale far exceeding any similar movement in the past. New discoveries are constantly being made and as yet the surface of this vast wealth has scarcely been touched. There is every reason for saying that a new era in Canadian mining is at hand, the extent of which we cannot begin to foretell.

We also have in our water powers the source of immense wealth. An English authority remarked recently that the economic welfare of the United States is based upon the intelligent use of their abundant cheap electric energy—generated largely from water power—more than upon any other factor. We should realize the great potential value of this asset and safeguard our inheritance.

Immigration figures for 1926 show a substantial increase over those of the previous year and are the best since 1915. A large number of additional settlers of a desirable class are expected from the United States this year, as well as from Great Britain and European countries, and we are especially pleased to note that many of our own people who emigrated from their Canadian homes during the recent times of depression are returning to Canada. All will be welcome, for immigration is our greatest need, and when this problem has been solved all others will have solved themselves.

It is always a pleasure to me to record my hearty appreciation of the services of the chief officials and the Staff, through whose loyal co-operation much of the credit is due for the results attained.

The past few years have been especially arduous ones for bankers, and the demands upon their time and judgment have been unceasing. We trust, however, that improved conditions of business will permit their load of care to be lightened in 1927.

I now move the adoption of the Report and will call upon our Vice-President and General Manager to second the motion.



ADDRESS BY MR. C. A. BOGERT,  
VICE-PRESIDENT AND GENERAL MANAGER

The Statement which is before you to-day presents features of perhaps greater interest and importance to the Shareholders than any Report for many years past.

Let me remind you that, beginning in 1913, the affairs of Canadian Banks were administered for twelve years under conditions wholly abnormal and without precedent in the banking history of this country. The threatened depression of 1913-1914 was followed by four years of conflict—two years of over-production and speculation; then four years of drastic deflation, which swept away War profits and brought adverse features into many Balance Sheets. We have now had two years of gradual improvement and can say, with confidence, that Canada has passed out of the period of unsettlement that existed for a third of a generation.

As the President has pointed out, the profits for 1926 were very satisfactory—the second highest in the history of the Bank and \$102,436.22 more than the previous year. They are computed after making the fullest provision for depreciation on every kind of asset that the Bank possesses. The balance carried forward in Profit and Loss Account has reached a substantial total, \$1,032,554.92.

Respecting the chief features of the Assets and Liabilities, Circulation expanded more than \$300,000; total deposits have increased by over \$2,600,000; interest-bearing deposits were up \$3,500,000, and there was a decrease of approximately \$900,000 in deposits not bearing interest—occasioned by the increasing requirements of customers for their various activities.

The latest available figures—for the twelve months ended the 30th of November last—show a decrease of \$50,000,000 in the total deposits of all Banks in Canada. During the same period, The Dominion Bank's deposits showed a moderate increase, considerably augmented during the month of December. We occupy—as we have for many years—second place amongst all Canadian Banks in the ratio of total deposits to number of branches.

One of the changes wrought by the War is the disposition of Bank depositors to look for a higher return than it is

possible to allow on Savings Bank accounts. Prior to 1914 investment securities were known to a relatively few people, but the wide-spread sale of War Bonds converted Canada into a nation of investors—seventy to seventy-five per cent. of our Dominion Government Bonds alone are known to be in the hands of our own people, which is a very sound situation, but one result seems to be that Savings deposits are not likely to increase in the same ratio as they have done at intervals in the past.

Letters of Credit Outstanding were \$2,500,000 less when we closed our books than on the 31st of December of the previous year. It happened that the activities of some of the Bank's largest exporting customers were not prominent towards the close of 1926—there is no special significance in this.

Liabilities not included under the foregoing heads—\$690,000—is an accumulation of various reserves for the protection of your assets.

Cash Assets amounted to \$24,600,000—22.34% of Public Liabilities—and Total Quick Assets \$60,000,000—54.53% of Public Liabilities. (This is a little lower percentage than in 1925, but a portion of the Bank's more liquid assets were diverted to the channel of "Other Current Loans and Discounts in Canada.")

The Bank's total investments at the end of the year were \$22,900,000. We disposed of \$2,300,000 securities during 1926 and the funds were absorbed in commercial advances. During the same period, and for the same reason, the investments of all Canadian Banks decreased by \$69,000,000.

Call Loans in Canada show an apparent decrease of over \$6,000,000, but in 1925 we included in this total advances against grain and flour aggregating \$7,377,599. We have fallen in line with the procedure of other Banks and included advances of this nature in Current Loans and Discounts. Call Loans in Canada actually increased \$900,000.

Allowing for grain and flour advances, commercial loans increased by over \$6,000,000 during 1926. This does not indicate an expansion in credits for any particular kind of business, but a gradual demand for funds for nearly every form of commercial activity and from practically every district which we serve. During 1926 the total

commercial loans of all Banks in Canada increased by \$83,140,000, or 9.20%—our percentage of increase was 12.50%. This is a gratifying aid to the earning power of the Bank and largely accounts for the better profits reported.

The discounting of bills and the lending of money to carry on the country's business are amongst the chief functions of a Bank, and "Current Loans and Discounts" is one of the most important headings in our Balance Sheet.

Our commercial loans are made up of the obligations of thousands of borrowers and practically every business and occupation known in Canada is represented in the total. The trade and prosperity of this country rest upon its primary products—therefore a substantial portion of the Bank's loaning business is with such basic industries as agriculture, lumbering and fishing, but we also assist the various trades engaged in the preparation and marketing of food products, including, of course, the grain trade, flour milling and meat packing, manufacturing of all kinds and wholesalers. We also help to finance many other borrowers not directly identified with any of the main groups, but fulfilling useful functions in the community.

Non-current Loans, \$267,000, show a decrease of \$12,000.

Real Estate, other than Bank Premises, \$36,000, and Mortgages on Real Estate Sold, \$39,000, are unusually small totals and very low in proportion to the Bank's Assets.

Bank Premises Account decreased during the year by \$213,000, almost entirely accounted for by the appropriation of \$200,000 from Profit and Loss Account. Total Bank Premises Account has been reduced from a high point of \$6,306,529 in 1922, to \$5,724,241 on the 31st of December, 1926. There were no important expenditures during the year. \$15,000 was used to purchase the land at the corner of Broadview Ave. and Queen St., Toronto, formerly occupied under lease, and \$9,500 was expended on remodelling the building owned by the Bank at Napanee, Ont., one of our oldest Branches. While your Directors consider that Bank Premises are entered on the Statement at very conservative figures, they feel it a prudent policy to write off reasonable amounts from year to year as natural depreciation has always to be reckoned with and re-valuations are sometimes justified.

During the past five years the Canadian Banks have closed about one thousand branches, through amalgamations and for reasons of economy. This has brought about a plethora of bank properties in Canada, but you are somewhat fortunate in that any that this Bank holds not at present required for our own purposes are quite unimportant and involve a very moderate amount.

In the Annual Report of December 31st, 1922, the Shareholders were informed of the purchase by the Bank of a property at the corner of Bleury and St. Catherine Sts., Montreal, which prior to that time had been occupied under lease. This site is a very valuable one—fairly comparable to the corner of Yonge and Queen Sts., or Yonge and Bloor Sts., Toronto. The business of this Branch has developed to such an extent that to provide for present needs and future expansion, it has been decided to erect a modern and larger building during the present year, plans of which are now being prepared—your Directors have satisfied themselves that this outlay is necessary and urgent.

When general conditions are encouraging and we have what we consider a satisfactory Statement to submit to the Shareholders, there is less reason for those who address you at the Annual Meeting to make lengthy remarks. There are, however, two or three subjects that might be touched on briefly.

A year ago I ventured an opinion in regard to instalment selling or—as it is sometimes called—“consumers’ credit,” and so much has been said and written during the past twelve months that it seems almost superfluous to speak further on this matter, but it is one of such importance to the community in general, and to Bankers in particular, that a word or two of comment may be opportune. The practice is not a new one, but it has grown so rapidly in recent years that some apprehension is felt that the future income of the people is being mortgaged to such an extent as to constitute a grave danger in the event of industrial depression. It does not seem, however, that such fears are justified. We find that the annual total instalment sales of merchandise in the United States (including automobiles, which account for about one-third) are about \$6,000,000,000, or 9% of the total national income of \$70,000,000,000. Of the sales, \$2,600,000,000, or only 4% of the national income, is outstanding at any one time, which is not excessive. Instal-

ment sales have increased heavily during the past five years, but Savings Bank deposits and total Life Insurance have increased in far greater degree in the same period, which does not indicate that the instalment system is preventing the people from saving. These figures, dealing only with the United States, are reassuring, and although the custom is not so general in Canada, we may assume that the situation cannot be less favourable here than there. In any case, it would seem that instalment selling has come to stay, and it remains for business men and bankers to deal with it as a permanency.

It is said that the system has a legitimate place in the sale of certain articles of necessity, but not of luxury; who, however, is to distinguish between the two? In a primitive society where the only real necessities are food and shelter, all else are luxuries, but civilized standards of living are constantly adopting new things. At present a large section of mankind is resolved to move about rapidly on wheels, uses more expensive food and clothing and spends a considerable portion of its means on modern amusements of one kind and another. Undoubtedly there is some extravagance and abuse of the instalment system, but there is no absolute rule of safety for dealing with this or any other form of credit; experience alone will distinguish between the sound and the unsound, and the subject has surely been sufficiently ventilated on all sides to place the business and financial worlds on guard.

Notwithstanding the continued agitation from some sources for district or local Banks in this country, the Canadian Banks continue, without any strain upon their resources, to supply all legitimate credit requirements of the business and farming community. The criticism used frequently to be heard, especially in times of money stringency, that the branch system is unsuited to the needs of agriculture because of an inclination on the part of Head Offices to favour the requirements of business in the large cities to the detriment of the country districts—an entirely erroneous impression. In the case of this Bank—and doubtless the same applies to others—farmer customers are numerically our largest single class of borrowers, although the advances in total are relatively small.

Comparison unfavourable to Canadian Banks is sometimes made with the unit Bank system of the United States,

and it is, therefore, interesting to note the opinion recently expressed by a leading New York authority that the American "banking system in the agricultural sections is archaic. Small local Banks lending farmers' money to farmers is a violation of every principle of the most elementary economics"; also, "The first principle of sound banking is diversification of the branches of trade served." The question of branch banking has become a very live one in the United States in recent years and advocates of the system are increasing.

The surplus in last year's Government receipts over expenditures made possible a gratifying reduction in the rate of income tax; also, we are all pleased to note an apparent decrease of about \$30,000,000 in the National debt, which will mean a substantial saving in interest hereafter. It has been intimated that a further cut in the tax rate will be considered this year, which, if it eventuates, will be welcome.

The allocation of surplus between debt retirement and tax reduction is a task which calls for, and no doubt receives, the best judgment of our Government, but let us hope that payments on principal will continue. The idea of lighter taxation contains the more popular appeal, but we should realize more generally than perhaps is the case, that Canada's borrowings have to be repaid some time and every effort should be made to retire a portion of each maturity—lower taxation should logically follow a reduction in interest charges.

An event of first importance, although all but unnoticed by the public, was Canada's return to the gold basis on July first last, nearly eight years after the conclusion of the great War—an achievement of which we may feel well satisfied, remembering the magnitude of our War undertakings. As a matter of fact, this action might have been taken several years earlier without the slightest danger. Canada has not lost, but gained gold since July. Our credit stands higher than ever before in the money markets of the United States, and the obligations of the Dominion Government, all of our Provinces, and a number of our leading Cities, command better prices than those of any other foreign Bonds quoted on the New York Board.

One favourable feature of 1926 is that the price level of commodities appears to be fairly well stabilized at about fifty per cent. above that of 1913, and while the present tendency is slightly downward, there is no reason to anticipate a sharp movement in either direction in the near future. The steadiness of prices indicates that a fair balance has at last been struck between supply and demand—hand-to-mouth buying has become more or less standard and is a check on over-production; as inventories are kept in low figures, the demoralizing evil of price-cutting has largely disappeared. In short, business has emerged from the confusion of recent years, has adjusted itself to new conditions and is once more making a profit.

I mentioned at our last meeting that The Dominion Bank was in a strong position to take care of the expansion in business that we felt was due and the substantial increase in our commercial loans—to which I have already referred—is an indication not only that we have done our part in providing for the greater requirements of our customers during the year, but that our attitude of moderate optimism, then expressed, has been well justified by the steady progress recorded in 1926. We confidently believe that conditions point to a continuance of this movement during 1927 and are prepared, as always, to fulfil our function as a financial ally of legitimate business.

Gentlemen: I have pleasure in seconding the adoption of the Report.

The motion was presented to the Meeting and adopted.

Mr. J. G. Ramsey—I move “That Mr. A. B. Shepherd, C.A., of Peat, Marwick, Mitchell and Company, and Mr. D. McK. McLelland, F.C.A., of Price, Waterhouse and Company, be appointed auditors to hold office until the next Annual General Meeting, and that their remuneration be fixed at a sum not to exceed \$10,000.”

Mr. Campbell Reaves seconded the motion, which was carried.

Mr. Wm. Mulock, K.C.—Mr. President and Gentlemen: I have much pleasure in moving, That the thanks of this Meeting be given to the President, Vice-President and Directors for their services during the year.



I am sure, Mr. President, I voice the view of all of the Shareholders when I say that we congratulate you sincerely on this excellent Report—the second best in the history of the Bank, showing, as it does, profits of 21% on the capital, and liquid assets in a very strong position. The whole Report is a telling tribute to the ability, hard work, prudence and care of the General Manager and the Directors.

We welcome Mr. Ross as a member of the Board. The Dominion Bank is most fortunate in having as its Directors men who have already made a great success in their own businesses—men of the highest honour and integrity and in whom we may place unbounded confidence.

Let me in conclusion assure you again that the Shareholders are most appreciative of your splendid Report.

Mr. W. T. Kernahan—Mr. President: I desire to have the privilege of seconding the motion that has been proposed by Mr. Mulock. May I say at the outset, Sir, that the Shareholders share with the Directors the profound regret expressed by them in the loss of two of their number, both distinguished business men of Toronto—Mr. R. J. Christie and Mr. A. T. Reid; I also congratulate you, as Mr. Mulock has done, on securing the services of Mr. J. Allan Ross, whose reputation as one of the leading business men of Toronto is well established.

The Directors have done fine work for the Bank and we are grateful to them for the time they have given in assisting the chief executives in looking after its affairs. It is always a great pleasure to attend the meetings of The Dominion Bank and to hear the business-like reports that are presented. I second the vote of thanks proposed by Mr. Mulock with very hearty sincerity.

Chairman—I can assure you, Gentlemen, that it is most helpful to have on the Board such men as you see before you; I will ask Mr. Blackwell, the Chairman of the Board, to say a few words.

Mr. C. S. Blackwell—Mr. President and Shareholders of the Bank: On behalf of the Board I thank the Shareholders for this expression of confidence in their Directors. I assure you that it is a pleasure to serve in that capacity, and it is particularly so to listen to the kind things that have been said by the mover and seconder of the resolution, for I

consider that the Report submitted to-day is the best that has been presented since I have been a member of the Board.

We live in a wonderful country, a land of fine promise, and when we keep in mind our enormous field crops (which in 1926 were valued, I think, at more than One Billion Dollars), our mining industries, our forests, and our many other rich resources, one would have to be a pessimist in the extreme not to appreciate that ours is one of the greatest countries in the world. Canada has passed through a stormy period but is in a fair sea again, and I am satisfied that 1927 will be an even better year both for the whole country, and for The Dominion Bank, than 1926.

Chairman—I am sure you would all like to meet your new Director, and I am going to call upon Mr. Ross.

Mr. J. Allan Ross—Mr. President and Gentlemen: I am going to be very brief. There isn't very much more that could be added to what your President, General Manager and Chairman of the Board have told you. I feel deeply conscious of the honour of being asked to join the Board, for in my opinion The Dominion Bank has shown outstanding service in the history of Canada. I think we are living in the country of greatest promise in the world to-day, and I therefore feel it is a privilege to be asked to join, in my small way, in further developing this Bank in its service to Canada.

Mr. George W. Allan, K.C.—Mr. President: I deem it a very gracious courtesy that I should be accorded the pleasure and privilege of moving the following resolution, which never is, and never should be, in any manner or form perfunctory: "That the thanks of this meeting be given to the General Manager and other officers of the Bank for the efficient performance of their respective duties." Where thanks are thoroughly and pre-eminently deserved those thanks should be recorded in a sincere and heartfelt manner, and I believe that there is a recognition on the part of the Shareholders that they have been and are being well served, with ability, vigour, and conservatism by the Staff.

I feel certain that I voice the sentiment of the meeting that the results brought before you to-day could not have been achieved without a thorough co-operation extending

from your General Manager, through your Assistant General Managers, down to the Manager of the smallest branch, and all the Staff, and our sincere thanks are overwhelmingly due to them.

Residing as I have in the West for many years, I have had the opportunity of watching the progress of your Western branches under safe but aggressive management, and I value highly the friendships I have made among the personnel.

Before closing I wish to say that it is a matter of regret to me that indisposition has prevented the presence here of Mr. F. L. Patton. His sound judgment has sustained itself in bad season and in good, and we in the West are proud to see him active and so well able to carry the large responsibilities which are placed upon him.

Mr. A. W. Laver—Mr. President: In rising to second this motion I find that the mover has so thoroughly covered the ground that it leaves me very little to say, but I would be neglecting my opportunity if I didn't add my views to what he has already stated.

In our business we find ourselves privileged and able to take advantage of the services of the Head Office and several of the branches, and without exception, I am very glad to say, we find the officials efficient, courteous and able, and it gives me great pleasure to second this motion. (Carried.)

Mr. Bogert—The President in his earlier remarks made some references to the unusually arduous duties that the Staffs of Canadian Banks have had to perform in recent years and expressed the hope that their responsibilities might be somewhat lightened in the years to come. I am sure that all the members of the Staff of The Dominion Bank will heartily agree with what he has said.

The Shareholders have been good enough to-day to express their appreciation of our efforts in the resolution that has been so kindly moved by Mr. Allan and seconded by Mr. Laver. I would like to say that whatever has been accomplished has not been through the effort of any individual, but through the ability and energy of a very loyal and efficient Staff in all branches of the service.

I am sure we all share Mr. Allan's regret that Mr. Patton is absent from the Meeting to-day—I think only the second

time in nearly twenty-five years—but you will be glad to hear that his indisposition is only temporary and in a few days he will be quite recovered.

It is very appropriate that Mr. Allan should propose this resolution, which in his case is certainly not a perfunctory one; as our chief legal adviser in the West ever since our Winnipeg Branch was established in 1897, during good times and bad, he has been a very loyal supporter of The Dominion Bank.

On behalf of the Staff, and for myself, I wish to extend to you our very hearty thanks for this resolution, and I am going to ask two of our senior officials—our “tide-water” representatives—Mr. Atkinson, our Manager in Vancouver, and Mr. Fisher, our Manager at St. John, N.B., to add a word or two.

Mr. A. A. Atkinson—Mr. President and Gentlemen: I am very glad to have the opportunity to reply to this resolution. In Vancouver we are a long way from Head Office and there is a feeling of isolation which makes this annual expression of appreciation of the Shareholders very welcome. I would like, therefore, to thank you on behalf of the whole Staff and to express the special appreciation of those who are carrying on the work of the Bank in Vancouver.

Mr. W. A. Fisher—Mr. President and Gentlemen: It is a very great pleasure to me to attend the Annual Meeting—also to be associated with my Pacific Coast colleague, Mr. Atkinson, in expressing on behalf of the Staff our appreciation for the resolution just passed. My experience covers a period of over twenty-five years, during which time I have been stationed at points in Ontario, Quebec and New Brunswick, and can truly say that the esprit de corps in this institution is second to none. I thank you sincerely on behalf of the Staff for the resolution.

Mr. J. D. Warde—I beg to move “That the poll be now opened for the election of eleven Directors, and that the same be closed at two o’clock in the afternoon, or so soon before that hour as five minutes shall elapse without any vote being polled, and that the Scrutineers, on the close of the poll, do hand to the Chairman a certificate of the result of the poll.”

Mr. G. N. Reynolds—I have much pleasure in seconding that motion. (Carried.)

After the Ballot was taken the Scrutineers reported that the following had been elected Directors: Messrs. A. W. Austin, C. S. Blackwell, C. A. Bogert, R. Y. Eaton, E. W. Hamber, Wilmot L. Matthews, R. S. McLaughlin, W. W. Near, F. Gordon Osler, J. Allan Ross and H. H. Williams.

Chairman—Gentlemen: I wish to thank you for your attendance at this meeting—it is always a pleasure for the Directors to meet the Shareholders.

The meeting then adjourned.

At a subsequent meeting of the Directors, Mr. Austin was elected President, Mr. Bogert Vice-President, and Mr. Blackwell Chairman of the Board, for the ensuing year.
