The Directors' Report and the Annual Statement were read by the Secretary as follows:—

THE REPORT.

The Directors have pleasure in submitting to the Shareholders the 43rd Annual Report and Balance Sheet of the affairs of the Bank, as on 30th April, 1918, accompanied by statement of Profit and Loss Account, showing the result of the operations for the fiscal year:

The balance at credit of Profit and Loss Account carried forward from last year was . . \$1,164,876.20

The net profits for the year after deducting the cost of management, paying the Auditors' fees, the interest due to depositors, and after making provision for bad and doubtful debts and for rebate on bills under discount, amounted to 1,185,066.71

Making a total at credit of Profit and Loss of \$2,349,942.91

This amount has been applied as follows:

The Head Office and Branches of the Bank, now numbering 126, were inspected during the year. The Auditors appointed by the Shareholders have also made their examinations as required by the Bank Act, and their report and certificate is attached to the Balance Sheet.

A further subscription of \$25,000 (being the fourth for a similar amount) has been made to the Canadian Patriotic Fund, the payment of which will be made during the course of the coming year.

It is with deep regret that your Directors have to report the loss of their Co-Director, Honorable Richard Turner, of Quebec, whose death occurred on December 22nd, 1917. He occupied a seat on the Board since May, 1906. His place has been filled by the election of Mr. E. Hay.

The Directors testify with pleasure to the loyalty, zeal and faithfulness of the Staff, which under the present conditions is labouring under a heavy strain. It is the intention to ask your authority to contribute substantial sums to the Pension Fund of the Staff.

All of which is respectfully submitted.

In rising to move the adoption of the Report which you have just heard, in accordance with previous custom, I shall make a few remarks:—

THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS.

It is again my privilege to present to you on behalf of the Directors the annual report of the Bank. It is one that gives us considerable satisfaction, showing as it does increased earnings with the maintenance of a continued strong position.

You will notice that while, as I have stated, profits have increased, we have thought it wise to take out of Profit and Loss Account a further sum to provide for depreciation in the market value of securities, which was foreshadowed last year and which is inevitable as rates of interest increase. Notwithstanding this our Profit and Loss balance carried forward is considerably larger than last year.

It should be noted as an evidence of the expansion of business of the Country and of the growth of the Bank that its Assets have reached well beyond the \$100,000,000 mark, and are now some \$11,000,000 in excess of what they were last year.

It is reasonable to believe that, while activities owing to the war continue, we can count on moderately good profits, though the market for Stocks and Bonds will probably continue to tend downwards and new problems and uncertainties will arise as the war nears its inevitable but long deferred end. Even now restrictions and heavy Dominion and Municipal taxation may adversely affect general business. It is probable that the population of Canada, taking into consideration immigration and the natural increase, is considerably greater than in August, 1914, after deducting those in Military Service. Notwithstanding this it is wonderful that we should continue to feed, clothe and supply in every form the troops which this country is contributing to the great cause, as well as furnish on credit to

Great Britain enormous quantities of munitions of various sorts; a speeding up of the productive powers of the individual as well as the employment of the young and elderly, and of women (who have proved themselves remarkably capable and enthusiastic) is indicated. As the war goes on this burden must increase, and the exertion to carry it increase if we are to get through without serious financial complications, and it would seem to me that every possible encouragement should be given to the production of every exportable thing, particularly such as are required in the United States or neutral countries that we can reach. In this connection, without desiring to indulge in a spirit of criticism, I may say that it is with much regret that I have seen restrictions put upon the freedom of action of some of the industries engaged in preparing for market those commodities which we look upon as particularly our own, feeling as I do that the larger the return that can be obtained from the production of what we are naturally best fitted to produce, the larger will be the effort, the greater the enterprise, and the better our position to face the difficulties which will follow the conclusion of peace. I have never been able to reconcile myself yet to the wisdom of a fixed price even for wheat.

The Annual Reports from our Branches are generally optimistic; most of the towns and cities have begun to increase in population, with the exception perhaps of the interior towns of British Columbia, and while Building Permits have fallen off both West and East, it would seem as if the time was near at hand when something will have to be done in some places to house the people in spite of the extremely high cost of construction.

The crop has gone in this year, in the Northwest, unusually early, and under very favourable conditions, and while there have been recent reports of damage from frost, high winds and lack of moisture, it is not believed that these drawbacks are serious, and it is reasonable to hope for a good crop, and from increased acreage at least in wheat.

In this Province conditions have not been quite so favourable. It is very gratifying to note that taking the country as a whole there is an increase in live stock. Labour conditions are not satisfactory in many industries; as far as farming is concerned this Province seems to be suffering most. In the Northwest they are chiefly apprehensive as to the needs for the harvest. It can readily be understood in districts where munitions are being manufactured extensively and where output is the chief consideration, that labour will be attracted from fields where its cost is a more serious matter.

A rather peculiar position has arisen with reference to gold mining, or at least it strikes one as peculiar though really very natural. As gold is the standard, it is practically the only commodity that has not risen in price, but the cost of mining it, measured in dollars, and which cost has to be paid by the product, has increased enormously so that it is quite within the possibilities that gold mines where the margin is small will have to cease producing, a very undesirable thing in this country where our gold reserves require replenishing and where, though we have an enormous nominal surplus in exports, it is not available owing to credits granted and maintenance expenses of troops abroad. Whether, if things come to a standstill in this industry, some aid should not be given to keep the mines going is a question worthy of careful consideration by those before whom it will come; of course, aid would mean an added burden on the whole people, but might be worth while if thereby affairs could be kept stable.

In the Bank we are experiencing much difficulty from shortage of Staff, and have closed some smaller Branches, and are very likely to be compelled to close others, and this at a time when in many districts in the Northwest it would pay us to establish ourselves; it is one of the sacrifices that you, gentlemen, are making for the prosecution of the war. I do not think there is any branch of business that has furnished a larger proportion of its Staff to the cause than this,

nor any class of men who have been more ready to go to the Front at any sacrifice. Our Bank ranks well with others, and many have suffered death or wounds. The General Manager will no doubt give you particulars. All honour to these men.

You will remember that last year reference was made to the establishment of the Bank's Pension Scheme. During this year consultation has been had with an actuary. While this Bank has been making annual contributions they have been insufficient, and there has been no assessment on the Staff; in consequence, to provide a fund which can be relied upon to make the provisions which the actuary recommends there will be ultimately required perhaps something over \$1,000,000 if his suggestions are carried out; this will have to be supplied gradually by the Bank; in consequence, we are coming to you with a by-law for authority to take \$100,000 from the profits of the Bank towards providing this reserve sum and to charge annually against profits an amount, if required, equal to 5% of the salaries of those members of the Staff who will participate in the benefits of the scheme, so as to provide the necessary income. While, then, the regulations that govern schemes of this kind provide that the Bank's legal liability for pensions does not extend beyond the amount actually in the fund, in considering this by-law it must be borne in mind that once entered into, there is a moral obligation which compels provision by the Bank for the pensions or allowances decided upon, so that it will be necessary for you to count upon the Directors returning to you from time to time as the position of the Bank warrants for further substantial votes until the desired capital sum has been provided. It is hoped then with your sanction to have a scheme established in some form this year. I do not believe myself that the Staff of this Bank requires any arrangement of this kind to attach it more firmly to the service of the Institution, but if as is claimed the Staff thereby will be welded into one Imperial

family with the Bank above all in every legitimate sense the cost to the Institution will be returned many fold.

It is with much regret that I refer to the death of our Director, the Honorable Mr. Turner, of Quebec, who took a deep interest in the Bank's affairs, and was present at our meetings whenever his engagements permitted. His place has been filled by the election of Mr. Edward Hay, which I am sure will meet with your hearty approval.

Mr. Ramsay, though in good health, is unable to be with us, as also is Major (Dr.) Merritt still overseas, attending to his military hospital duties.

Another contribution of \$25,000 has been made to the Patriotic Fund to be paid during 1918. I am sure it will be approved of.

I beg to move that the Report, which has been read, be adopted, printed and circulated amongst the Shareholders.

THE VICE-PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS.

In seconding the adoption of the Report, I would also second the carefully prepared address of the President. The Statement you have before you indicates that the past year has been the most successful in the history of the Bank, and that the Bank can afford to contribute the \$100,000 mentioned to the Pension Fund. In doing this we are not committing the Bank to any definite yearly contribution, but I trust, and I feel confident, that we will be able to set aside for this purpose substantial sums year by year, and that our employees will feel assured that they will receive a reasonable allowance when it becomes necessary for them to retire.

I think no one who knows me regards me as an optimist, but I want to repeat what I have said on other occasions, that I regard Canada as one of the richest, if not the richest, country in the world in natural resources. We have only just begun to learn a little of the vastness of our minerals, and we have an acreage of agricultural lands as yet untilled sufficient to provide easily for one or two hundred million people.

Our country is almost everywhere prosperous at the present time. The amount of money in circulation is greater than ever before. The volume of business is maintained at a high level, and although the production and distribution in non-essentials have been to some extent curtailed, owing to this most regrettable war calamity, with few exceptions those who have been engaged in these industries have been able to divert their facilities to the manufacture and distribution of essentials, so that the volume of business has not really been disturbed.

Shareholders need feel no anxiety about their investment in this Bank giving them a good return, and I trust our excellent staff of officials who have given and are giving us such good service will be further encouraged by future prospects. We want efficient service, and we should always be willing to pay for it.

THE PRESIDENT.—We will now hear from Mr. Hay, the General Manager, with reference to the figures.

GENERAL MANAGER'S REMARKS.

You have before you copy of the Bank's Forty-third Annual Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account for the year ended on 30th April, 1918.

You will note the expansion in the present figures as compared with a year ago. Deposits have increased from \$66,199,000 to \$75,394,000, or over \$9,000,000, which is all the more remarkable when you consider the large amount of deposits withdrawn for investment in War Loan Bonds, etc. The main sources from which payments for War Loan Bonds are provided are Deposits in Chartered Banks and Government Savings Banks, so that the general increase in Deposits with Chartered Banks for the twelve months ended 31st March last, over \$145,000,000, notwithstanding the various War Loan campaigns, is indicative of the economy and thrift now being preached and practised throughout Canada. The increased amount in the Notes of the Bank in Circula-

tion as compared with a year ago, viz., from \$7,657,000 to \$9,908,000, being an increase of over \$2,250,000, is offset by the Deposit in the Central Gold Reserve which has grown from \$1,000,000 last year to the present figure of \$3,500,000. In this connection I might say the amount of Notes of the Bank in Circulation has been considerably larger than at any previous period in the Bank's history, the maximum figure of \$10,484,431 having been reached on 2nd April last. This expansion, however, does not afford the Bank the same benefits as formerly enjoyed owing to the present special taxation on the circulation privilege.

The total increase in Liabilities to the public from \$75,400,000 to \$86,400,000, or \$11,000,000, is almost entirely represented on the other side of the Statement by the increased holdings of Dominion and Imperial Government securities which have risen from \$8,215,000 to \$13,781,000, or \$5,500,000, by increased balances with our Agents (mostly in the U.S.A.) of \$3,226,000, and also by an increase in our holdings of actual cash of over \$4,000,000. This last increase of holdings of gold, specie and deposit with the Central Gold Reserve is worthy of special mention, being over 30% greater than a year ago.

Turning to the other side of the Statement, the total assets have steadily increased and are now over the hundred million dollar mark and are \$11,000,000 in excess of last year's figures. I have already explained that a considerable portion of these increased figures is the direct result of war financing operations and Government balances temporarily on deposit with the Bank. Nevertheless there has been a healthy conservative growth all along the line. Our Net Profits are over \$62,000 in excess of what they were a year ago. Taking up the question of reserves, our first line of defence, such as legals, specie, call loans and balances show 28.55% of our net liabilities to the public as compared with 27.02% last year, and including the second line (bonds, securities, etc.) the result is 62.28% for 1918, as against 55.78% last year.

It might also be interesting to you to compare the present Statement with the figures shown in the Bank's Statement of 30th April, 1914, being immediately prior to the war, when our total assets were \$78,863,000, as against the present figures of \$101,817,000, or an increase of almost \$23,000,000. At that time our deposits were only \$58,238,000, as compared with the present figures of \$75,394,000, being an increase of \$17,155,000. Our Circulation which was then \$4,762,000, and now \$9,908,000, has more than doubled.

BANK PREMISES.—The small addition to our Bank Premises account in the neighborhood of \$150,000 is well represented by necessary purchases for the Bank's own purposes looking to the future as well as to the present. As pointed out last year we occupy very modest premises both here and elsewhere.

SHAREHOLDERS.—Our Shareholders have increased in number from 1,879 to 1,921 during the year.

NEW BRANCHES.—As shown by the President's report the Bank's expansion by way of additional Branches during the past year has been limited to one small office in the West, while at the same time owing to the difficulties which in common with other Canadian Banks we are experiencing in providing necessary Staff we have been obliged to close six small Branches.

THE PRESIDENT.—Are there any remarks to be made before I put the motion? It is moved by myself, seconded by the Vice-President, that the Report which has been read be adopted, printed and circulated among the Shareholders. (Carried.)

The next business is a motion for the appointment of the Auditors.

Moved by Mr. John B. Laidlaw, seconded by Rev. T. W. Paterson: That Mr. G. T. Clarkson, F.C.A., Toronto, and Mr. R. J. Dilworth, F.C.A., Toronto, be appointed Auditors of the Bank for the ensuing year at a remuneration not to exceed a total of \$5,000. (Carried.)

MR. ROBERT CARSWELL.—I beg to move that the thanks of the Shareholders are due and are hereby tendered to the President, Vice-President and Directors of the Bank for their services during the past year, all of which seems very satisfactory.

MR. J. K. FISKEN.—I have very much pleasure in seconding that motion. (Carried.)

THE PRESIDENT.—I think you have heard sufficient from me, but I must say I appreciate very much the vote of thanks. I would ask some of the other Directors to respond to the motion. Perhaps Mr. Hanna would say a few words.

HON. W. J. HANNA.—I have really nothing to say, except it has not been my pleasure to be in very close touch with the work of the Board during the past year. I am greatly pleased, I may say, speaking as a Shareholder, with the splendid report of the work that has been done. It is unnecessary for me, sitting on the Board during the past year, and the year or two before that, to speak of the great satisfaction it is to one so situated to know how conservative the statements of our President and General Manager are, when it comes to telling the Shareholders just what has been done. I think it would stand any 100% test that could be applied to it. (Applause.)

MR. J. W. WOODS.—Mr. President, I think you made an unfortunate selection in asking Mr. Hanna and myself to respond to this motion. Both of us have been absentees. I have been down in New York for the past nine months doing war work, and the Directors gave their consent to my doing that work. All I want to say is that from my knowledge as a Director of the care with which all new accounts and all loans are scrutinized, and the conservative policy which the President and General Manager follow and strictly adhere to, the Shareholders ought to be more than gratified both with the Report and with what Mr. Hanna has said, that it would stand any test that might be applied to it. I am very glad, Mr. President, to acknowledge the vote of confidence. (Applause.)

MR. L. A. HAMILTON.—Mr. President, I have another motion following that one. There is only one thing I would like to say before presenting this resolution of thanks to the General Manager and officers of the Bank, and that is that there is only one attraction, I believe, at this time of the year that would draw me away from the farm, and that is the Annual Meeting of the Imperial Bank. For one reason, if I had any feeling of pessimism with regard to the condition of affairs in the country, I come in here and am presented with a Report such as we have been given to-day, and such as we always receive here, and then I go back with a lively sense that Canada, as far as financial affairs at least are concerned, is keeping its place well to the front. Then I also feel a debt of gratitude, and for that reason I can with my whole heart move this resolution—a debt of gratitude to the General Manager, in as much that on these occasions I always pick up a good old Scotch story that throughout the year I am able to palm off as original. (Laughter.) So he helps me out in that way.

I believe in this case, knowing the wants and needs of the country, that there should be a certain amount of reciprocity, and while I come in here and leave the operations of the farm to take care of themselves, I think I should like to invite the Directors to come out and assume some of the important and necessary work there—(Hear, hear)—and if the Directors of this Bank are able to perform one of the duties of the farm so successfully in the matter of “making hay”—(laughter)—then I think there is a great purpose they could serve, a very useful purpose, in the country. In this case I am not quite clear, however, whether the Directors make the “Hay” or whether the “Hay” makes the Directors. However that may be, I know you will join with me as Shareholders in endorsing the following resolution:

That the thanks of the Shareholders be given to the General Manager, the Assistant General Manager, and other officers of the Bank for their attention to the interests of the Bank, and for the efficient performance of their respective

duties. I have the greatest pleasure, Sir, in presenting this resolution.

MR. W. J. McWHINNEY, K.C., seconded the motion.

THE PRESIDENT.—You have heard the motion, Gentlemen, accompanied by the extremely interesting remarks of the mover and seconder. What is your pleasure? (Carried.)

MR. HAY.—I have much pleasure in returning the thanks of the executive officers and staff generally, including the ladies, for the very hearty vote of thanks which you have been so courteous in presenting. Mr. Moffat and other officers present will, I am sure, desire to tender their own thanks, but I cannot resist making reference to the extraordinary conditions under which the staff is now laboring. Not only has the strain arising out of conditions due to the war been greatly increased, but also our ranks have been much depleted owing to the continued response to the call to arms on behalf of the country, no less than 490 members having already responded. (Applause.) Their places have been filled almost entirely by inexperienced recruits, principally ladies, who now number nearly one-half of the entire staff. I am happy to say our lady members are, generally speaking, performing their respective duties in a particularly creditable manner, and are in every way coming up to our expectations and requirements notwithstanding their inexperience and change of environment.

I cannot close without an acknowledgment of the splendid services which are being rendered to the country by our absentees already referred to, and I am sure you will join me in expressions of regret when I refer to the fact that already 42 of our men have paid the supreme sacrifice, while fifty others have been reported on the casualty and missing lists. We are, on the other hand, proud of the honors earned by others in gaining decorations, several having been so recognized.

—As intimated in the Report, I am now occupying the exalted position of a Director as well as an officer, and if I am so favored by a re-election to the Board,

I wish to give you my immediate assurance that I will at all times make it my duty to watch carefully the actions of the General Manager. (Laughter.)

THE PRESIDENT.—We would like to hear a few words from Mr. Moffat.

MR. MOFFAT.—I think Mr. Hay has expressed the thanks of the staff, but probably I can speak for the rank and file better even than he can, seeing I come more closely in contact with it. I think that no words that you can use will be too strong to express what they are entitled to for the work they have done in the past year. The seniors have assumed great responsibility, and they have all worked harder than should be expected of them. They have all worked willingly. We are looking forward now to another year, and probably a worse year than we have had, but with the same willing spirit on the part of the staff, and a little consideration on the part of the customers, we are going to see the thing through. We will do our part, and I think when we come back, those of us who do, next year, we will be qualified for another vote of thanks. I am very glad to see you all here. (Applause.)

THE PRESIDENT.—Mr. Jaffray and Mr. Duncan are here from the West, and perhaps they will say a few words. Mr. Jaffray is our Western Inspector, and Mr. Duncan is from Saskatoon.

MR. JAFFRAY.—I am very glad, Gentlemen, to have the chance to thank you on behalf of the staff. I think probably I might speak more for the Western part of the staff than the Eastern, but I can assure you you have a very fine staff in the West, and while they have been working hard and working under difficulties they are doing it very cheerfully and with the full determination to carry it on. (Applause.)

MR. DUNCAN.—It is a pleasure indeed, Gentlemen, to acknowledge on behalf of the staff the appreciation that has been extended for their loyalty and increased effort. I think they all realize the gravity of the situation, and while our responsibilities have been heavy and we expect even further

responsibilities in the future, I think I can say that they will be borne cheerfully and willingly. (Applause.)

THE PRESIDENT.—I will now ask the Secretary to read the by-law, which it is proposed to submit to you with reference to the Pension Fund.

The Secretary then read By-law No. 33, as follows:—

BY-LAW NO. 33.

WHEREAS by By-law No. 17 the Directors were authorized to establish a Pension Fund for the Officers and Employees of the Bank.

AND WHEREAS various contributions have been made to the said fund from time to time out of the funds of the Bank.

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable to establish the said fund on a more permanent basis and it is estimated a substantial additional sum will be required for this purpose.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted by the Shareholders of Imperial Bank of Canada assembled in Annual General Meeting:

- (1) That the Directors of the Bank are hereby authorized to establish a Pension Fund for the benefit of officers and employees of the Bank and their families upon such terms and conditions as the Directors may deem meet and that all details incidental to the said fund and to the organization, management, operation and continuance thereof are hereby left to the Directors.
- (2) That the Directors be and they are hereby authorized to contribute forthwith to the said fund out of the accrued profits of the Bank the sum of \$100,000 and to contribute annually hereafter a sum as shall be decided upon by the Directors but not exceeding 5% of the amount of the salaries of those who enter into the fund, such annual amount to be in lieu of the annual contribution of \$5,000 heretofore authorized.

MR. JOHN WATT.—Mr. President and Gentlemen, I feel it a special privilege to be permitted to move this resolution to place the Pension Fund on a more permanent and satis-

factory footing. Probably this is the most important and far-reaching act that this meeting will take. It will certainly be so regarded by the many employees of the Bank. The existence of such a fund seems to be a recognition of the fact that the employee will likely not have set aside sufficient for his maintenance after retiring. I would not like to think that the salaries paid are such as to make such a saving impossible with thrift and good fortune, but probably the majority of Canadians can hardly be described as thrifty. Perhaps I ought to make it clear that I had no thought of referring to the Directors in that remark. I think the surroundings in which we meet will make it perfectly clear that they are entitled to an acknowledgment of their undisputed efforts in thrift and frugality. I sometimes think that it is especially difficult for employees of a Bank to be thrifty. The standard of living, especially in the smaller places (and I have had experience of that) makes demands on his purse not always commensurate with his income, and this action of the Directors will assure the faithful employee of a respectable livelihood after retiring, and this will surely be an incentive to increased effort which is being called for at present on the part of especially the older men. This assurance I feel will be specially welcome at this time when increased expense and uncertainty as to the future must be causing no small anxiety to many thoughtful men. I am glad, therefore, the matter is to be disposed of to-day. I have very much pleasure in moving that By-law No. 33, as read, be and the same is hereby approved of and adopted and that the seal of the Bank be attached thereto.

MR. KNOWLTON.—Mr. President, it gives me a great deal of pleasure to second that resolution, particularly as some years ago I had something to do with moving a resolution setting apart a sum as a Pension Fund for employees of the Bank. The prizes of the Bank are few, and fewer still to get them, and the young men who go into a Bank struggle along for a long time on a small salary with nothing to look forward to but what his own efforts bring forth. He has got

a pretty hard row to hoe before him, and I do not think that the Bank, within a reasonable amount, can be any too liberal in setting aside a sufficient sum to take care of those who have served them well and faithfully in their younger days. Those who have had to do with banking know that the work, while it may not be hard, while it may not draw the sweat of the brow as much as our farmer friend here, yet it saps away the brain, and if they have not got enough set aside to keep things up their chances of those few prizes, as I said, are very small indeed. I have noticed particularly that my fellow Shareholders have let this lie dormant for a long time without having any regular organization, but a short time ago they have no doubt observed, as everybody has observed, that they can no longer depend upon honorary titles for their retiring officers. That is now being wiped out, and no longer can the Bank say to its employee, "we are going to retire you from office, and we will make you an honorary Colonel," or something of that kind, "so as to give you some remuneration and recognition for your long service with us." I think the sum we set apart, \$100,000, does not look a very large sum when it is spread over so many officers of the Bank, because they will all be getting there, like myself, getting nearer and nearer day by day, until they at last come in upon this fund. I think the Directors have been very conservative in the amount set apart. However, with the additional 5% it may give them what they want. I have very much pleasure in seconding the resolution, and I hope the Shareholders will agree with me. (Carried.)

MR. HAY.—I now wish to extend thanks on behalf of myself and the staff.

THE PRESIDENT.—Then the only remaining business, I think, is the motion for the ballot.

DR. GRASETT.—I have pleasure in moving this formal resolution: That the ballot box be now opened and remain open until two o'clock this day for the receipt of ballot papers for the election of twelve Directors, the poll to close as soon

as five minutes shall have elapsed without a vote being tendered.

MR. G. W. HOWLAND.—I have pleasure in seconding that.
(Carried.)

The Scrutineers appointed at the Meeting reported the following Shareholders duly elected Directors for the ensuing year:—
