The Institute will be connected with the main corridor of the Royal Victoria Hospital by an overhead bridge, and with the Pathological Institute by an underground tunnel. It will include eight floors. On the first floor, offices, small laboratories and a lecture amphitheatre with seating capacity of about 120. The second, third and fourth floors will house neurological and neurosurgical patients; the fifth floor operating rooms, X-ray rooms and offices; sixth and seventh floors laboratories, while the eighth, a half floor, will house a few research fellow.
