Montreal Neurological Institute. Dear Doctor Penfield: Herewith are the estimates. I have deliberately included alot of detail in the explanatory notes in order to make the financial position clearer to the Principal.

The estimates have been calculated on the basis of 102 beds, with an anticipated occupancy of 85%. As a matter of fact, it matters little what the exact number of beds will be in as much as increasing the number of patients automatically increases the costs, as well as increasing the revenue, and these two factors balance out each other.

From all these calculations it is obvious that the Institute will need an annual sum equal to the cost of Building Maintenance, what ever this may ultimately work out to be.
