Who caught his blood? I, said the Fish, With my little dish, I caught his blood.




Who'll be the chief mourner? I, said the Dove, For I mourn for my love, I'll be chief mourner.

Who will carry his coffin? I, said the Kite If it's not in the night, I'll carry the coffin




Who will carry the link? I, said the Linnet, I'll fetch it in a minute, and I'll carry the link.


