My dear Penfield:

I have yours of the second.

Sorry that Mrs. Penfield can't come up. I expect to give you a call to come before long now.

I think things are shaping very well. The question of your work at the General Hospital was brought up at a Medical Board meeting of that Hospital on the first and a most favourable reply received. I think they will probably try to get more of you than we at the Royal Victoria will want, ^{to give them} -- putting it in an exaggerated way. I think that Hospital will be wide open to you.

A small Committee of our Medical Board is to interview the Governors very shortly now, and I feel that the necessary money is going to be forthcoming. When you next come up it will be chiefly for the purpose of interviewing the Board of Governors. I am feeling most enthusiastic.

I almost think it would be better for Cone to come up with you for the first year, if at all possible, and go to Europe the next year; but that point would be a subject for discussion.
