Dear Dr. James: I enclose the recommendation which we feel the University might make in regard to operation of these beds to be added to the M.N.I. It seems to us better not to be too much involved in army red tape, and actually the Department of Pensions and National Health will, I am told, finance these men once the building is completed. I am asking Miss Dawson to forward this to you, thinking you should have it as a postscript to my letter of yesterday. I am sorry the letter reached you so late.
