Dear Mr. Principal:

I am enclosing the letter for Col. McKenzie; also a copy of the analysis of figures carried out by Dr. Kershman. We would rather not give McKenzie any further detail regarding arrangements with the D.P. & N.H., and I have left out all mention of what the personal income of individuals may have been. There seems to be a good deal of doubt as to whether the Army will really take over and pay for their own patients or whether they will continue to allow them to be handled by the D.P. & N.H. If the D.P. & N.H. continues to handle the situation, it would be better not to have two sets of arrangements.
