
Dear Dr. Penfield;

Mr. Ray spoke to me about the question which has been raised regarding the wind shelter for patients on the Roof of the Temporary Annex.

When the meeting was held in Ottawa and subsequently in Montreal in connection with the cost of this project, everything above the roof was to be left off except the slat floor. I expressed my ideas at the time as to what was essential for the enjoyment of this roof space but there has been no further discussion of it and we are not authorized to build on the roof at the present time.

I do not know what is the best way to take this matter up again so it would receive the most favourable consideration but if you wish us to do so, we will write Lt.-Col. Rooney. The attitude of the Department towards us in connection with this building is that we must do everything possible to keep the costs within their estimates and I am not very optimistic about the authority to do anything extra at the present time.
