Many thanks for your letter of August 31st. I am sure that I speak for the Principal of McGill as well as for the staff of the Montreal Neurological Institute when I express our great gratitude to the Board of Management for their willingness to spend the sum of \$1400.00 for special operating room lights for the new service mens' operating room on the 8th floor of the Institute; also for the appropriation of \$2,300.00 to be used in furnishing certain rooms in the Military Annex of the Montreal Neurological Institute.

This allows us to secure certain things that are not available in the ordinary army issue but which are nevertheless essential to the comfort, and to some extent to the efficiency of service to the service man. The Military Annex is partly open and will be completely open in a very short time.
