

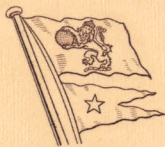

Dear Mr Peuffield:

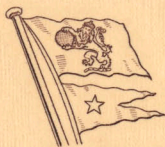
after two

service; thousands

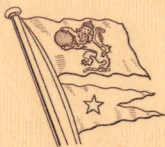

eyes.

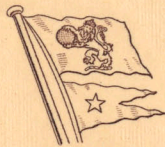
