Dear Mr. Mason,-

With reference to the endowment of \$1,000,000.00 for Neurology which the Rockefeller Foundation has undertaken to transfer to McGill University on receipt of official notice that the work on the Montreal Neurological Institute has been brought to a conclusion, with acceptance by the University of the completed project.

The laboratory equipment has now been moved from the University and installed in the Institute. On July 15th McGill University formally relinquished to the Neurological Institute all Laboratory activity, and it is expected that patients will be admitted to the Institute for treatment in September.

In effect, it can be properly quoted that the laboratories of the Montreal Neurological Institute are operative, and that research and scientific work is now in progress.
