Dear Dr. Penfield:

I am so glad to know you are pleased with the suggestive motif for the center of ceiling in the Reception Room. We will develop a full size charcoal cartoon of this figure.

We have found in the Boston Museum a particularly fine Greek marble Ram's Head of the 4th Century, B.C. of which we are having photographs made for development of the center motif of our scheme.

To conform as near as possible to your suggestion as to the placement of names and yet keep a proper balance, we would suggest the following changes to our original submission:-

To add the word "and" between "Nissl-Alzheimer", making same read "Nissl and Alzheimer" and locate in position #5.

Change "Const. Von Monakow" to read "Von Monakow" and place in position #4.

This change will place "Nissl and Alzheimer" and "Wilhelm Erb" together, as you wished.

Owing to the limited space for #4, the first name of Von Monakow must be dropped.

It was impossible to put the Germans in location #8 and #10, and retain a balance.

Kindly let me know if this will be satisfactory.
