GRANT OF \$50,000. FOR THE NEUROLOGICAL INSTITUTE

Our records show that we have received nothing on account of the above grant since the Foundation sent us a cheque for \$6,664.72 Canadian currency, on July 2nd, 1933, making the total payments on account of this grant \$46,664.72 . This completed the Foundation's undertaking for the twelve months ending May 31st, 1933.

We would, of course, like to have, as soon as possible, the \$50,000. payment for the period from May 31st, 1933 to May 31st 1934, and I would like to ask the Foundation whether it would be willing to add thereto a half year's interest at 5%. This request is made on the ground that the University has paid out of its general funds slightly more than that amount for Dr. Penfield's Department during the above period.
