Dear Mr. Glassco:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 21st in reference to payments under the Foundation's appropriation toward expenses of the Neurological Institute.

The following is an excerpt from Mrs. Thompson's letter of April 14, 1932, reporting this appropriation to you:

"The Trustees of "The Rockefeller Foundation further voted an appropriation towards the expenses during the year July 1, 1932 to June 30, 1933, of putting the plan outlined into effect, payments not to exceed a total of \$50,000."

As you stated in your letter, payments under this grant total \$46,664.72 . As no appropriation has been made by the Foundation for the period subsequent to June 30, 1933, no further payments are due.
