Dear Professor Foerster,

It was so thoughtful of you to send the cablegram on the 27th of September. It arrived in time and I read it at the banquet in the evening. There were many messages and we had the feeling that you had all joined us in spirit. I enclose a copy of the menu for the dinner which will show you who was there.

The picture on the front is a copy of the ceiling in the entrance hall. It is a photograph of the painting on the ceiling of that room. The drawing of the neuroglial cells is from an original by Golgi. You will notice in the border the ventricle and the meninges. The legend "Encephalon" comes from Galen and Francis has interpreted it as "I have seen the severely wounded brain healed." The hieroglyphics represent the

word "brain", being the first appearance of that word in literature; it was taken from the Smith papyrus. The Ram, of course, symbolizes the head or the brain in astrology.
