Dear Dr. Penfield:


I am bringing with me the prints of the drawings which we made in order to study the use of the present Field House for hospital purposes and a permanent extension to the Neurological Institute.

We have not made any attempt to plan the Field House for the uses discussed as I understood you wished to look into this first of all without any such work on our part.

While the new entrance shown on the plot plan is not ideal, I do not think it is any worse than the present service entrance and if the new location is agreed on, it would undoubtedly free the use of the land suitable for the development for the permanent extension.

You will notice that the new Wing, where extended to the northeast, is stopped at a point which permits spectators to view the whole running track.
