Reference your M. 8-3-2-96(Q) under date of 20 Apr 45 in respect to the m/n subject.

2. In respect to the various questions asked in your memorandum may they be answered seriatim and under the para numbers as appearing therein.

3. "Para 3" In answer to your question as asked may it be advised that in as much as Dr. Penfield is to be called up under G.O. 139 as a Colonel in the R.C.A.M.C. and since he is already Director of the Montreal Neurological Institute the Annex will come under the control of Dr. Penfield in both of his capacities.

4. "Para 4" As regards the staff arrangements have been made in co-operation with the D.M.O. as follows:

5. "Para 5" The question of a per diem rate is now a matter of discussion between the D.M.(R) and the President of McGill University.

6. "Para 6" The usual records will be kept of all Army patients as is routined for Army hospital installations.

7. "Para 7" It is intended that stores issued to the M.N.I. Annex will be on charge to the Montreal Military Hospital which is an accounting Unit.

8. "Para 8" No comments except that it is not believed that this will constitute any real problem over a period of time.

9. "Para 9" The responsibility of equipment and medical stores will be that of the Montreal Military Hospital.

10. It is believed that the foregoing answers the inquiries which have been raised in your memorandum.
